8 whatever you, whatever you need, just tell your lawyer
9 what you need.

10 FARRINGTON: Ah. Yeah, it wasn't for my lawyer.
11 I didn't do it for my lawyer.

12 HILL: All right, then.

13 FARRINGTON: I did for my man. I didn't do it for my
14 lawyer. Somebody else may have but I didn't.

15 HILL: Listen. You did it for your lawyer cause if
16 you got...

17 FARRINGTON: Oh okay. All right.

18 HILL: Under oath, you'll have to say that.

19 FARRINGTON: All right then. Laughs I'll be like
20 I did for my man, I mean my lawyer.

21 HILL: Laughs

22 FARRINGTON: Laughs My man, I mean my lawyer.

23 HILL: Oh man, that's funny.

24 FARRINGTON: But I figured, you didn't, you didn't, I

1 knew you didn't know that. It blinks...

2 HILL: No I, no I did.

3 FARRINGTON: It blinks like that. No it blinks (UI).

4 HILL: Oh, when it blinks. No, I missed that, man.

5 FARRINGTON: (UI) Yeah.

6 HILL: A few other things.

7 FARRINGTON(UI)

8 HILL: This thing has solid (UI) It's really good.

9 FARRINGTON: What are we going to have for desserts.

10 I got to have me some dessert tonight.

11 HILL: I don't know. As long as I got my nuts and my

12 raisins. I mean, my (UI) I'm in good shape.

13 FARRINGTON: Oh, I guess that would be enough of a

14 dessert, wouldn't it?

15 HILL: For me. And then I had a piece of cheesecake

16 today, so I'm trying to, you know.

17 FARRINGTON: Uh huh. I would think you would be.

18 HILL: Yep, I'm kind of, kind of. I don't know (UI)

19 know what I'm saying.

20 FARRINGTON: Well, anyway, it looks nice. I like that.

21 HILL: Oh, good. Thank you, honey.

22 FARRINGTON: I'm, I'm just saying it's, it's neat.

23 That's, that's an indication that it's a modern, some

24 modern ride you rolling in, dude.

1 HILL: Yeah, man. Roll on, roll on, roll on.
2 FARRINGTON: Not everybody got it like that.
3 HILL: Yeah, I know that's right.
4 FARRINGTON: You goin' to go there and, and get
5 into the ambiance and forget all about what you're
6 suppose to be doing.
7 HILL: Man I got fifteen dollars. I ain't going to
8 have, I ain't going, I ain't going to have no trouble
9 remembering what I'm suppose to be doing. My, my
10 money is low.
11 FARRINGTON: Laughs
12 HILL: And so it ain't going to be no confusion on
13 my part.
14 FARRINGTON: Laughs You like make no mistake.
15 HILL: No, there ain't no confusion. Ain't going to
16 be no confusion. I got it together. My, my...
17 FARRINGTON: You know you ought to get some of
18 that good salsa we had that night.
19 HILL: I don't have the money.
20 FARRINGTON: Oh.
