2 The following is a transcript of a telephone  
3 conversation between DARREN REAGAN, ALLAN MCGILL, and  
4 GAIL TERRELL on March 4, 2005.  
5 (UI) UNIDENTIFIABLE  
6 (PH) PHONETIC  
7 (Phone Ringing)  
8 GAIL TERRELL (TERRELL): Hello.  
9 DARREN REAGAN (REAGAN): Hey, sister.  
10 TERRELL: Hey, brother, how you doing?  
11 REAGAN: Alright. You okay?  
12 TERRELL: Yeah, I'm doing good.  
13 REAGAN: Good. I was telling brother, you know, the  
14 ahh, have you, ahh, sent everybody a little e-mail  
15 out? Telling 'em we wanta have a little pow-wow, a  
16 status update briefing.  
17 TERRELL: Okay.  
18 REAGAN: On, ahh, Monday afternoon.  
19 TERRELL: Ahem, okay.  
20 REAGAN: Yeah.  
21 TERRELL: Alright.  
22 REAGAN: And if, if they have, put it, put it at  
23 about 4:30.  
24 TERRELL: Okay.  
25 REAGAN: Monday afternoon, and if anybody have problem

1 with it, just, you know.

2 TERRELL: So, it's Staubach and Tom?

3 REAGAN: Staubach and Tom, uh-huh.

4 TERRELL: Okay. Okay.

5 REAGAN: Yeah.

6 TERRELL: I'll do that.

7 REAGAN: Alright. Brother still around there?

8 TERRELL: Yeah, hold a second.

9 REAGAN: Okay.

10 PAUSE

11 TERRELL: Hold on, he's coming.

12 REAGAN: Okay.

13 PAUSE

14 Conversation away from telephone

15 ALLEN MCGILL (MCGILL): Huh?

16 TERRELL: That's DARREN.

17 MCGILL: Oh, okay.

18 TERRELL: I put it right on (UI).

19 PAUSE

20 Back to telephone

21 MCGILL: Hello.

22 REAGAN: Brother, I know I need to tell you before I

23 forgot, ahh, but I talked to DON...

24 MCGILL: Uh-huh.

25 REAGAN: ...HILL, and ahh, I told him what these guys

1 are up to, he said, what? I said, no progress. I  
2 don't have a single contract in hand. And I told him  
3 about how they tried to, how they tried to play this  
4 game with PRINTICE. And I said, and these, what these  
5 guys are hoping, is that once this thing get passed,  
6 they gonna, ahh, if it get passed, ahh, they gonna  
7 just, I mean, take off like...

8 MCGILL: (Laughing)

9 REAGAN: ...the thieves they are. They gonna be gone.  
10 And, so he said well, that, naw, that's not gonna  
11 happen. Said, well, I tell you what, I said, you can  
12 pull that thing on Wednesday, can't you? He said, I  
13 sure can. I said, well, just do it Wednesday morning.

14 MCGILL: Mm-hmmm. (Laugh)

15 REAGAN: Just table it. Let's just table it  
16 indefinitely, until we can all get together.

17 (Laughing) So I, I said, what they doing, they  
18 watching the, the net, and the Council's stuff that's  
19 on the net. And, so just, just pull it that morning,  
20 and we'll just, just let it go for now.

21 MCGILL: Mm-hmmmm.

22 REAGAN: I said, because he, he wanted to meet me  
23 Monday to bring something.

24 MCGILL: Okay.

25 REAGAN: And I don't know what he's gonna bring.

1 MCGILL: Mm-hmmm.

2 REAGAN: But I, I...

3 MCGILL: (UI) he timing it. Yeah, I mean, you got 'em  
4 scoped.

5 REAGAN: Mm-hmmm, that's what it is, man, you know?  
6 And said he's talking checks, and this, that and  
7 other, and I'm, I'm saying that, you know, thinking  
8 well, that's fine, but, you know, this thing ain't  
9 gonna get done 'til I have contracts. That's all it  
10 is to it. You know?

11 MCGILL: Well,...

12 REAGAN: And he gonna...

13 MCGILL: ...well, he done already found out that the,  
14 that the, the miracle can't happen, because obviously  
15 they were able to get an extension...

16 REAGAN: There you go.

17 MCGILL: ...on the property.

18 REAGAN: Oh yeah, they got an extension.

19 MCGILL: Mm-hmmm.

20 REAGAN: I'm not even concerned about that.

21 MCGILL: Mm-hmmm.

22 REAGAN: They do, I mean, and they don't get 'em for  
23 no, no less than 60, ahh, 180 days, or whatever they  
24 need.

25 MCGILL: Yeah, and well, you know, they didn't go in

1 there and ask for 30.

2 REAGAN: Naw,...

3 MCGILL: (UI).

4 REAGAN: ...so we just, we just leave it out, we just,  
5 as long as, or until we get contracts, you know?

6 MCGILL: There, there you go.

7 REAGAN: Mm-hmmm.

8 MCGILL: Yeah, but, but waiting until Wednesday  
9 morning is a nice way to really...

10 REAGAN: Yeah.

11 MCGILL: ...run that piece.

12 REAGAN: Well, whatever he bring Monday, you know...

13 MCGILL: You could just send him back...

14 REAGAN: (UI).

15 MCGILL: ...to the well.

16 REAGAN: Yeah, well, I'm, (stuttering) I'm gonna take  
17 whatever he have Monday.

18 MCGILL: That's what I mean, and send him, and send  
19 him right back.

20 REAGAN: Send 'em on back. Yeah.

21 MCGILL: So, okay, well, this,...

22 REAGAN: What he, what he gonna...

23 MCGILL: ...this is a start.

24 REAGAN: ...do, he gonna, what he gonna do, is bring  
25 something, ahh...

1 MCGILL: You know, with you and DON.

2 REAGAN: Well, no, not necessarily to me, but to deal  
3 with D'ANGELO, then.

4 MCGILL: Ahhhh.

5 REAGAN: Mm-hmmm.

6 MCGILL: Ah, ahh, aw yeah. Oh yeah.

7 REAGAN: That's what he do.

8 MCGILL: Yeah.

9 REAGAN: Yeah, so I just told him, I said you need to,  
10 I said you need to enlarge, you need to enlarge your  
11 territory.

12 (Laughter)

13 MCGILL: Well, you, well you remember that was my  
14 first reaction, man,...

15 REAGAN: Mm-hmmm.

16 MCGILL: ...I thought he was kinda low down in the  
17 hole, really. I mean, (laugh) for a deal this size.

18 REAGAN: Well, I say, you, you need to really enlarge  
19 your territory, so. I (UI), and I left a message  
20 yesterday. I say, you got, you got a couple of  
21 invoices out there that need to be taken care of.

22 MCGILL: Well, good. DARREN, you want the 50 number  
23 for Monday?

24 REAGAN: Say what now?

25 MCGILL: You want your 50 number...

1 REAGAN: Ahh, it'll be, it'll be 0848, it'll be 48.  
2 MCGILL: 48? Mm-hmmm.  
3 REAGAN: Yeah. Now, yeah, putting it late in the  
4 afternoon going to give Staubach plenty time to run,  
5 and hustle, and do what they ain't been doing.  
6 MCGILL: (Laughing)  
7 REAGAN: 'Cause we know they ain't done nothing,  
8 'cause...  
9 MCGILL: (UI)  
10 REAGAN: ...they'd done called by now.  
11 MCGILL: Oh, yeah.  
12 REAGAN: You know, with a...  
13 MCGILL: Well, yeah.  
14 REAGAN: ...victory in hand.  
15 MCGILL: This is, you know, this is 'bout their, they  
16 call about 10 minutes to 5.  
17 REAGAN: Mm-hmmmm.  
18 MCGILL: Mm-hmmm. But, yeah, you, you told him right.  
19 He got some, he got some business, this other boy,  
20 that  
21 FISHER. He got some business out here that need to be  
22 taken care of.  
23 REAGAN: Yeah, yeah.  
24 MCGILL: Hmmm.  
25 REAGAN: Well, I'm gonna get 'em. And I'm gonna, I

1 need to call him, and tell him to bring certified  
2 funds with him. (Laughing)  
3 MCGILL: Yeah, 'cause we don't want no funny looking  
4 business.  
5 REAGAN: Yeah. Yeah, you go and get certified funds  
6 and bring it with you Monday.  
7 MCGILL: Well.  
8 REAGAN: That way, that way I know everything's...  
9 MCGILL: You ain't gonna have a problem.  
10 REAGAN: ...(UI) yeah.  
11 MCGILL: Mm-hmmm.  
12 REAGAN: Well, he, I'm gonna, I'm gonna let him think,  
13 brother, that he done made it to the, he done made it  
14 to the finish line.  
15 MCGILL: Yeah. Well.  
16 REAGAN: He gonna (UI), he, yeah, 'cause he ain't  
17 gonna see no change on the agenda.  
18 MCGILL: Mm-hmmm.  
19 REAGAN: And that's what they watching.  
20 MCGILL: Yeah, and, and playing it this way, is just  
21 really, really a nice stroke, because this way you can  
22 kinda really see it, it, it cuts down some of that  
23 wiggle room that they got. And been using in the  
24 past.  
25 REAGAN: We gonna cut that out.

1 MCGILL: Mm-hmmm. This is gonna bring 'em straight  
2 down front and center.  
3 REAGAN: Well, where they need to be.  
4 MCGILL: Mm-hmmm.  
5 PAUSE  
6 REAGAN: Well, brother, I'll see you there directly.  
7 MCGILL: Okay, take care now.  
8 REAGAN: Alright.
