[Beginning of recording]

UCE: How are you, Pasha?

SUB: Peace be on you.

UCE: Peace be on you, Allah's mercy and blessings. How are you, my dear?

SUB: I'm sorry that--

UCE: Man, sorry what? Do not say that. Do not say that. What is your news?

SUB: By Allah, thank Allah. We thank Allah.

UCE: *Man, this is a big..*

SUB: Yes. I wanted you to come inside to eat--

UCE: I know, but unfortunately, I have information, yes, I do not want--

SUB: Yes.

UCE: --unfortunately, I mean, *it is a big place.*

SUB: *Yeah, it is big.*

UCE: What is your news? How are you?

SUB: By Allah--

UCE: You seem in a good mood.

SUB: May Allah make you safe.

UCE: May Allah keep you. What is your news?

SUB: By Allah, we miss you.

UCE: By Allah, me too, me too. May Allah... You know, I have been driving for--

SUB: Yes.

UCE: --for two days.

SUB: [UI]

UCE: I have been driving for two days, by Allah. How are you? What is your news?

SUB: By Allah, thank Allah.

UCE: Work is good?

SUB: Work is perfect, thank Allah. Er, I finished the *computer*, the sections.

UCE: Yes. I, by the way, let me--

SUB: Yes.

UCE: --let me go *south*. I will go back to *south*.

SUB: To *south*? *Yeah*.

UCE: Yes. [UI] Er... that...er...

SUB: Yes.

UCE: Is work good?

SUB: Work....er, I searched but I could not go to the location because I did not have a car.

UCE: I heard that you have a--

SUB: Er, I found, I mean, I did the research from home, from the *computer*.

UCE: Yes.

SUB: So, there is the same branch in *downtown, in Dallas*. *It is called the Plaza*. I mean, this is mentioned to be the main site for all of them.

UCE: Where is that?

SUB: This is in the *downtown Dallas*. This is in charge for all the city here. It has billions of dollars. And, it was built a long time ago. And it is made of glass, the same thing--

UCE: Yes.

SUB: --and it is a large building, a huge one, you know?

UCE: Do you have... Do you have the address?

SUB: I have the address and pictures.

UCE: Good, good.

SUB: By Allah.

UCE: Fine. Thank Allah. Thank Allah. What I know is that you have... I was told. I did not see... the last... it is like you sent an *e-mail*--

SUB: *Yeah.*

UCE: --and supposedly they are very pleased with this *e-mail*. But, I... I... I do not know anything about it, I mean--

SUB: But--

UCE: --what it is. The... the... what did you tell them?

SUB: It is about this location. Er, I told them that I changed.... I changed the... I mean, that we changed our opinion if, if you want... that this strike happens, it will be better because, like you say, we were going to strike a branch among the branches--

UCE: Yes.

SUB: --but if we strike the main one, I mean, it will be the stronger blow.

UCE: Good, good.

SUB: It will be, I mean, the shaking of the economy will be more than if we strike the branch because, like you say, this one is for all of Dallas.

UCE: Thank Allah. Thank Allah.

SUB: And it is responsible for the *credit card*, I mean, it is like a main location for the *credit cards* and like American service, like you gave it money, especially this year, I mean, it got money over billions because the...

UCE: Yes.

SUB: [UI]

UCE: By Allah, it is good.

SUB: [UI]. It received support from the American Federal Bank. I read its history.

UCE: Thank Allah. In the name of Allah. What Allah desires. Thank Allah, Lord of the Worlds.

SUB: And the location also, I mean, the place... the bank, like you say, is located, I mean, it is one of the buildings which are visible in the city.

UCE: Hmm.

SUB: How was 11 September when they destroyed it? It left like a vacuum. The same thing.

UCE: Thank Allah. Er, where is this location? Where is the--?

SUB: In *downtown Dallas*.

UCE: It is in the center, I mean.

SUB: In the center. And it is large. It is visible.

UCE: But it is very good that it is *down*, I mean, it is in the center *if you--*

SUB: *Downtown*.

UCE: And this, how far is it from the... er--

SUB: There are buildings around it, you see?

UCE: Yes.

SUB: There are lots of buildings.

UCE: Do you remember the... the one we saw, the black one, the bank, this one... do you remember when we were going to the...er--

SUB: *Wells Fargo?*

UCE: Yes.

SUB: *Yeah*.

UCE: Is that the same one also?

SUB: It is the same one, it is the same...er, the one that is affiliated with them. This is their main one.

UCE: This is what they call--

SUB: The *Plaza* is *Wells Fargo*. Like you say, in every city, there is... there is the main one. There is one in Houston, there is one in Dallas.

UCE: Yes.

SUB: The one in Dallas is called the *Plaza*. [Noise] [UI] Each one that is main, they give it a big name, I mean, I mean, a distinct name--

UCE: Yes.

SUB: --on the basis of it is one that... that *process*--

UCE: But... er, why did you choose, I mean, why did you choose this one? Why did you like this one more than the other one, I mean? What is...what is the difference?

SUB: Because, it is like you say...er, like you say, there is a body and organs--

UCE: Yes.

SUB: --this is the head. I mean, if you hit it... you see how?

UCE: Yes. I mean, this is the... I mean, this is what they name, like *headquarters*, I mean, it is the main one--

SUB: The main one.

UCE: --the branch, er...

SUB: It is not the branch. It is the one in charge.

UCE: It is the one in charge. I mean, the one we saw was a branch of it.

SUB: Just a branch.

UCE: In the name of Allah. What Allah desires. In the name of Allah. What Allah desires.

SUB: So, this location I am telling you about is even-- I mean, it used to be a bank long time ago of a different kind--

UCE: Yes.

SUB: --and this bank, *Wells Fargo*, bought it especially to be a main one for it. It used to be *nineteen fifty something*... I mean, some 100 years, 100 years.

UCE: In the name of Allah. What Allah desires.

SUB: I mean, it has a great *history*. It is a very big bank and now they made it bigger and fixed it up, they made it main and *Wells Fargo* bought it and made it with *Wells Fargo*.

UCE: And you...er, how did you know this bank? I mean, what made you... what made you choose it other than--? I mean, how did you know this bank?

SUB: Er--

UCE: You did not go... er--?

SUB: I did not go to it.

UCE: Yes.

SUB: I did not enter it. But, like you say, on the *computer*.

UCE: Yes.

SUB: I got all the information and such. I did a strategic research on all the banks here in Dallas.

UCE: But you did not go to the bank?

SUB: I did not go to it.

UCE: You did not enter it. Hmm. By Allah, it is a great idea.

SUB: I will show you the pictures.

UCE: It is close to *downtown*, is not it?

SUB: *Yeah*. It is close to *downtown*. Anyway, you will come to my house, by Allah.

UCE: I know. But, I wanted to... You know I do not want to... and this is very important, I do not want to bother you or feel that you are feeling anything wrong.

SUB: Who? Me?

UCE: But, I mean... yes. It is because the house... I am telling you--

SUB: Rely on Allah.

UCE: --the orders I have is that I reduce... for you and me, not to be what? Not to meet a lot so that the... the... the--

[OV]

SUB: I even wanted--

UCE: --the operation is not...

SUB: --to tell you we can go park... er, *park* the car in a place--

UCE: Yes.

SUB: --and we walk to our house and I will not open the door, I mean, and nobody will know that I--

UCE: I know, I know. *It's just... er*, the problem is that I do not want to do anything now because we are--

SUB: *Yeah.*

UCE: --very close. Let us continue. I mean, thank Allah.

SUB: Yes.

UCE: We made... there is no... I do not want anybody to think that I am, I mean, that you are not paying attention, because I did not know anything about... er, I heard that they were pleased with the *e-mail*, you see?

SUB: Yes.

UCE: Yes and...er--

SUB: Good.

UCE: --you see? I say--

SUB: Because it took me a while reading and researching and looking and stuff until I sent him the *e-mail*, I mean, I specified for him with pictures and, I mean, I drew for him how... I specified the building and I sent him the picture of the city--

UCE: Yes.

SUB: --at night and at day--

UCE: Yes.

SUB: --how is the building... er, I specified it among the buildings, I mean, it was visible. But it is going to be...er, like you say, when we were checking the

building, how was the *security*, how, for example, how do I enter it, exit it, make sure that, like you say, there will not be searching when they see a briefcase with me--

UCE: Of course.

SUB: --so, I will be-- I will be walking to the bank, for example, more than once, you know?

UCE: Yes.

SUB: --so that suspicion will go away and be like, yes, this one came more than once. So, I will go, for instance, inside and go buy *change*, for instance.

UCE: Yes.

SUB: --on the basis that, for instance, I have a *business... business* or that I work in a store. For example, if I go one day and get *25 dollars in pennies in a box--*

UCE: Yes.

SUB: --so, I will go on the basis that I am buying *25 dollars in pennies... [noise]*, I will take the briefcase with me to see how is the road, how is their *security--*

UCE: Yes.

SUB: --I will go to the bathroom, for instance. I want to use the bathroom before I go [UI] It will be a *computer* case or something like that.

UCE: Er... do you want to enter as if you are opening an account, for instance, or something or...?

SUB: Er, I will not open an account because I do not want to draw the eye to us.

UCE: [OV] I know. Of course, of course. But, I mean--

SUB: But, I will go, for instance, because like you say every bank has... er, it has, like you say, how do I explain it? It has a special corner for *change*, to sell you *change*.

UCE: Yes.

SUB: --*business* owners, those *restaurants around the bank--*

UCE: Yes.

SUB: --in the *downtown*. Er... we used to do it over here for the store.

UCE: *Sure.*

SUB: So, you go and buy the... er, *box for 25 dollars*. You tell him, "I want *pennies, a box of pennies...*"

UCE: For example, yes.

SUB: --*change*. I will buy the pennies and I will go to the bathroom and inspect it and see if there is a suitable place where I can hide in it the... er, the stuff which will be with me in the briefcase.

UCE: Yes.

SUB: You see?

UCE: And then you leave.

SUB: And I will leave. There will be, for instance, we will have...er, something explosive that can operate by telephone.

UCE: Yes.

SUB: You see?

UCE: But--

SUB: --by the mobile.

UCE: And--

SUB: --you dial the number on the mobile... the... and the bomb will explode.

UCE: And did you see anything inside?

SUB: I--

UCE: [OV] I mean, in the pictures? Did you see anything inside? Did you see the bank?

SUB: I looked... I looked for anything to be on the inside.

UCE: There are no pictures--?

SUB: There are no pictures--

UCE: --inside.

SUB: --because, like you say, they consider it... er, *security*... they do not put pictures of the inside. It is not...it is just for robberies.

UCE: True, true, true. What you say is correct. In the name of Allah, what Allah desired. Thank Allah. By Allah, it is a great idea.

SUB: This is secret information because they are a lot of robbers and such--

UCE: Robbery, you mean.

SUB: Robbery. So, there is no information about inside the bank. He who wants... er, I mean, if you want something, I have to do it alone, I mean, I have to do it alone, do the research inside and go inside, go to the bathroom, go up and down and make myself lost.

UCE: But, what do you think... er, where is the...er, what is the... er, do you have the...

SUB: Yes. I will get it out from... [UI]

UCE: Let us go find, er.... What do you think? Should we go by and see now or what do you think?

SUB: Go to Dallas now?

UCE: Yes. We go to Dallas.

SUB: Fine. Go.

UCE: It is... it is. I mean, what are you... it is... it is according to your convenience, I mean, what do you think --?

SUB: I...er--

UCE: --so that--

SUB: If you want to go, we will go.

UCE: And is the period... the distance between them... Do you remember the first one that we went to, the first one which is *Wells Fargo*?

SUB: *Er, Wells Fargo* which is... *yeah*.

UCE: It was very close to the place... to the other place.

SUB: Yes. I do not know. The problem is that I do not know how is this one. But, I can bring it, I mean, I can find out, the distance from *downtown* to the bank we were in.

UCE: No, not the bank. I am not talking about the bank. I mean, is it close to the bank? Do you remember when we went... er, went to the other place?

SUB: Yes, the other place.

UCE: Yes. It was close to the bank. Is it very far or is it... er, or is it...?

SUB: I do not know. I do not want to give you wrong information.

UCE: Let us go see it. Fine. We are... er, [sighs] What I was told is that... er, that they were very pleased with... with what you sent even though I do not know anything. And--

SUB: It was just an idea that was presented, you know? I mean, I was even waiting the reply from them, they inform us, or from you until I see you, until I tell you, for instance, instead of doing this, we can do that which is the bigger fish--

UCE: Of course, of course.

SUB: --you know how? But, it remains that the *security* of this one is stronger, this one, you see?

UCE: But... but it is a normal bank.

SUB: A normal bank.

UCE: I mean, you go get *change* like you say. Do I go to... do I go to *Fort Worth*...? Do I go *north* to *Fort Worth* or should I go to--?

SUB: By Allah--

UCE: No.

SUB: --if we go back to the *north*, we will turn right to *Dallas*, like this.

UCE: We are... we are here, what do you think if we go to see the--

SUB: Fine. We will go. We were going to go to *Hillsboro*--

UCE: Yes.

SUB: --we will go now to *Hillsboro* from the *north* we will go onto to *35* again *south*.

UCE: Ah-um. Did I come to you *south* or did I come to you *north*?

SUB: You came to me *south*. We will now go back to *north* to *Dallas*

UCE: Okay.

SUB: *Dallas* is *north*.

UCE: Yes. And I... We go right, correct?

SUB: It is *south*, *yeah*.

UCE: We are *south* and we want to go *north* to *Dallas*.

SUB: We want to go *north*. We want... we want to go to the other *side*.

UCE: Is there another car or...?

SUB: Yes, go ahead. Rely on Allah.

UCE: Okay. Rely on Allah. Do you have the bank's address?

SUB: *Yeah*. I got it [UI].

UCE: Give me the bank's address.

SUB: I had pictures and... and all the *addresses* and everything, but I deleted them... I mean, I did not want to leave them on the *computer*. I said I will bring them up again later.

UCE: It is *south*, it is as if I am coming to you. I am supposed to go *north*.

SUB: *Yeah*. We will now... we will now go *north*. *It is the wrong way*.

UCE: We will turn around now. Okay, what brought us here? There is no god but Allah. [Noise] Er, this *Dallas*, this is correct.

SUB: There is *Dallas*.

UCE: Here is *Dallas/Fort Worth*, correct, correct. Thank Allah. Do you know how to do it with the telephone you have? [OV]

SUB: *Yeah*. A moment. I will check the *computer*. I will show you the pictures.

UCE: Is it... it is a big building?

SUB: *Oh, yeah.* It is a very big building. It is a big building and you can say it has glass.

UCE: Yes. Here is *Dallas*. [Sighs] Thank Allah, the weather is good today, huh?

SUB: The weather?

UCE: Yes. The weather is beautiful. Thank Allah. [OV]

SUB: [UI]

UCE: Did you put it on your telephone?

SUB: *Yeah.*

UCE: By Allah, this is a good idea.

SUB: Like you say, when you are in an area where the sun is--

UCE: Yes, you can not see well?

SUB: --sun like our country's.

UCE: Put on the... er.

SUB: *Yeah.* I will put them on.

UCE: It is okay, I am not going fast or anything. I do not want anyone to stop us at all [UI] or anything--

SUB: No. Normal. Go at your pace.

UCE: Yes.

SUB: But, I want to...er, that we sit down somewhere now--

UCE: Yes, Allah willing.

SUB: --in order for me to show you, for instance, you know.

UCE: Of course.

SUB: Did you hear what happened in... er, in Egypt?

UCE: I hope it is good.

SUB: About two weeks ago, they caught 20 people. They say they belong to the organization.

UCE: Er, you are talking about the Muslim Brotherhood?

SUB: The Muslim Brotherhood.

UCE: Yes, yes. I read the news, yes. But, they released them.

SUB: They released them?

UCE: Yes.

SUB: Thank Allah.

UCE: The judge. Thank Allah.

[Pause]

SUB: I will show you the *e-mail* I sent.

UCE: Yes.

SUB: Allah willing, I will bring up the pictures now. Do you want me to bring up the *address* or do you want to see it.

UCE: If you want... do you want to go to the... the hotel at first and then go, that is fine. It makes no difference with me. I mean, at your convenience, I mean.

[Pause]

SUB: Do you want to put it on the *GPS*?

UCE: Do you have... Did you know how to get the address?

SUB: *Yeah*.

UCE: Do you have *GPS* or not?

SUB: Er, by Allah, I did not bring it with me.

UCE: And this one is not working. I do not know. Hmm. Wait, what is the address?

SUB: The address, sir--

UCE: I have a pen. I always bring one with me.

SUB: Keep it. It is not a problem. I will [UI]

UCE: Tell me.

[Pause]

SUB: You told me that they were very pleased with the *e-mail*.

UCE: I am telling you, I mean, they were very proud. This is what was told to me. Do you know I... I...? Read it for me when finish, read it. But, what I was told is that... I mean, they were very pleased and... er, and I want to tell you that this news reaches people, and people, and people. So, it is not... it is not... it is not me. I mean, I am telling you I did not read it. I do not know what you told them even.

SUB: The problem is that there are 20 banks. It is a problem because banks over there in *Wells Fargo* are many, in the... in *Dallas downtown*--

UCE: Yes.

SUB: --but this is supposed to be the main location. I got more than one *location*. I am trying to determine the exact location.

UCE: Do you have the...er, the pictures or the--

SUB: *Yeah*. I am bringing the pictures up.

UCE: --or the *e-mail* and we will see if... By Allah, it is a good idea to have this *telephone* and the *computer*, it is a great idea. [Pause] You do not have the *main office* or something?

SUB: This is the problem, *yeah*. They are not specifying whether it is the main location or not. But, I mean, I will get it but--

UCE: Get it, we still have... We are still on the road.

SUB: By Allah, I should have brought my *GPS*. It skipped my mind.

UCE: It is not a problem. You just bring me the address, Allah willing, Allah permitting. Allah is to bestow mercy on us [sighs].

[Pause]

SUB: When we arrive at *downtown Dallas*--

UCE: Hmm.

SUB: --I mean, we will see it.

UCE: We will see it, okay, fine.

SUB: The problem is that I have [UI]-- [OV]

UCE: Do you know how to reach *downtown*?

SUB: I never went to *Dallas*. This is the problem.

UCE: I have the hotel in *Dallas*. Should we go...do you think...er--?

SUB: When my car broke down, I stopped going or coming.

UCE: Okay, do you have in the *e-mail*? Do you think it will be in the...? By the way, read the *e-mail* to me, let me see what you say in it.

SUB: I will show you the *e-mail*. I will.

UCE: Yes, yes. I know. Read it to me, maybe when I am driving. May Allah-- [Pause]  
Did I not take that *exit*?

SUB: *Yeah*, exit now. We are not going *north*, to *Dallas*.

UCE: Ah! Right.

SUB: You see? I thought that you are going *somewhere* that you know or something.  
But, that is why--

UCE: But, are we going to *Dallas* now, the *downtown*, do you have the *address* or...?

SUB: *Yeah*. I got it. Here.

[Pause]

UCE: Here is *Dallas*, 41 miles.

SUB: I got the pictures.

UCE: Is this your *e-mail* or what?

SUB: Er, this is an image--

UCE: Pictures?

SUB: A picture.

UCE: Hmm.

SUB: I am trying to bring up the *location*... They have it in the *locator*, how to reach it.

UCE: Tell me.

SUB: The *locator* says it is... it is in *downtown Dallas*--

UCE: Fine.

SUB: --*south of Mor--*, *Morrow... er, site area...* they put something like steps. *But, it is off State Highway 364...er, North Griffin Street and Field Street.*

UCE: Okay. So, we are going right?

SUB: We are going right in the *downtown Dallas*, yes. Do you know how to reach the *downtown*?

UCE: No, I am... I am with you. You... you are the one who is going to tell me... I do not...er. But, we are going right in *Dallas*.

SUB: We are going right in *Dallas*.

UCE: Okay.

SUB: By Allah [UI].

UCE: You just have the *address*, right?

SUB: *Yeah*. [Pause] They call it *The Motor Bank*.

UCE: *The Motor Bank*?

SUB: *Yeah*.

UCE: Okay, by Allah, it is good.

SUB: *The Motor Bank of Dallas*.

UCE: Fine. [Pause] Do you have my *address* or not? You have the *address*, right?

SUB: Yes.

UCE: Let me... I always have this small thing.

SUB: I want to be sure because more than one *address* has come up for me. I mean,  
[UI].

UCE: It is not a problem.

SUB: By Allah, had I known that we will be going, I would have brought up the *address*  
before anything when I was at home. [Beeps]

[Pause]

UCE: Did you not tell me... er, *street*?

SUB: *Yeah*, it... it gave me *north this street*, but it did not give me the name of the *street*  
it is on.

UCE: *North* which *street*?

SUB: It is... *north Griffin street*. You mean you want to put *Griffin street*?

UCE: Wait. Let me see.

SUB: *G, R, I--*

UCE: Wait till I see... *Texas, Dallas...* [beeps] *Griffin...* er, spell... er, spell it for me.

SUB: Er, *G, R, I--*

UCE: Yes.

SUB: *--F, F--*

UCE: Wait. Hang on with me.

SUB: *--I, N--*

UCE: Fine. *Street*, is not it?

SUB: *Street*.

UCE: *Street*.

SUB: Did it bring it up for you?

UCE: There is *100 North Griffin Street, 100 Griffin Street North* or... er--

SUB: *Yeah, north*.

UCE: *North? Okay, what is its zip code?*

SUB: *Zip code? They... they do not have it. [beeps]*

UCE: *But, it is north, huh?*

SUB: *Yes. I can give you the name of another street.*

UCE: *I have no... 100 north Griffin...er, street, 75202, this is the zip.*

SUB: *It does not show the zip code.*

UCE: *Did you see its pictures?*

SUB: *Yeah.*

UCE: *Ok, see if you have in your e-mail its pictures or you do not have it?*

SUB: *Yeah. It is in my e-mail.*

UCE: *Okay, why do not you... er, see in the...er--*

SUB: *The address?*

UCE: *Yes. In the e-mail.*

SUB: *It will not show the address with the pictures. But once we reach the street, the downtown--*

UCE: *We will see it.*

SUB: *--we will see it. I mean, we do not want to--*

UCE: *Fine.*

*[GPS giving directions].*

UCE: *Allah willing. Yes, in 27 miles, you will reach... er, Griffin street. Let us do...[UI] because I-- [OV]*

SUB: *I was trying...er, I wanted to buy a car--*

UCE: *Yes.*

SUB: *--a cheap car like that, just to manage with. By Allah, yesterday, a guy, a Jordanian young man--*

UCE: Yes.

SUB: --I know him, but, like you say, he did not reply to me so that I take it from him today. He lied to me like they say.

UCE: Did he want to sell it to you or he was--?

SUB: *Yeah*. He wanted to sell it to me on the basis that he would give it to me yesterday but there was no destiny.

[Pause]

UCE: [Yawn] There is no god but Allah.

SUB: But, what do you think about... er, do you want to tell me something or...?

UCE: Let us just see the place. I mean, will this be... I mean, we are together, Allah willing, this will be... I mean, I will let you take the... I mean, I am telling you, what you see... what I know and what they tell me I will tell you, like I am telling you, when you sent them the... the message, they were very pleased. So... er, I am here for you, I am here for you, whatever you see, I am here... of course, I will go back to assure them and tell them everything. But, at the same time, whatever you see, I mean...

SUB: *Yeah*. But, it is not going to be just my decision, you know--

UCE: No, of course.

SUB: --their decision too.

UCE: Of course. But, do you see... I mean, do you see, I mean, you see that this will be better from the one we saw.

SUB: Allah willing, *yeah*, of course.

UCE: Er, when we see it... we will see it, Allah willing, and we will do... and we will see... er, I mean--

SUB: [OV] I will not--

UCE: --we will study it, I mean.

SUB: *Yeah*, right, of course. I will not... I do not want to make a decision alone, you know?

UCE: No. Consulting, consulting.

SUB: The consulting is consulting, like you say.

UCE: Of course, there must be consulting with our brothers and everything. But, I mean, you are the first person, you are the one who knows... er, the location, you know how to study it good, I mean, I am not like you over there everyday. The... the problem is that you do not have a car, right. Were you going to buy it from him or was he was going to just give it to you?

SUB: No, I was going to buy it, because... like you say, Allah willing, my papers are about to come. According to what the lawyer said, everything is in the *immigration*, but we are sitting waiting for the *immigration* to send it to me in the *mailbox or whatever*.

UCE: Yes.

SUB: But, as soon as the papers arrive, Allah willing I will buy a car right away, you see? I will buy me any car, anyone will sell me a car because I will have papers so that I can move.

UCE: And now you can not buy a car?

SUB: Er, I can, but like you say, it is because--

UCE: Right, right.

SUB: --so that I am not stopped by any police or anybody. Like you say, I am driving, they will give a *ticket* right away and they will take the car.

UCE: So, the building that you are telling me about is bigger than the one we saw.

SUB: Very much.

UCE: Very much?

SUB: Very much because that one is in the middle of the *downtown*, everybody... everybody is seeing. I mean, you can say it is very big. I mean, like the one... like those of 11 September... the towers, I mean, it towers above the city.

UCE: [OV] Oh, really!

SUB: I mean, at night, everybody sees it, you see? The *Dallas downtown*. It is all glass and, like you say, they finished the *building* in 2007.

UCE: It means it is new.

SUB: It means it is new, you see?

UCE: And you want to... Okay, by Allah, in the name of Allah, what Allah desired. In the name of Allah, what Allah desired.

SUB: By Allah, I was--

UCE: [OV] That is why they were happy with the... er.

SUB: Yes.

UCE: --you told me... er, let Allah make us happy and open it for us. Read me the... er--

SUB: I will show you a quick picture.

UCE: I cannot see.

SUB: It is not showing, *Wells Fargo*--

UCE: Yes.

SUB: --it is here with these buildings--

UCE: Yes.

SUB: --in *Dallas*.

UCE: I see it. Okay.

SUB: And here is *Dallas* picture wherever you go, correct?

UCE: It is here, yes, correct.

SUB: It is with it.

UCE: Okay, it is big, I mean, it looks big.

SUB: [OV] It is a building... it will be a fatal strike.

[Pause].

UCE: Man, one's eyes are... that's it. One is getting old.

SUB: Do you sleep good?

UCE: No, no. By the time I came back yesterday, by the time I arrived, it was about morning--

SUB: By Allah.

UCE: --but, I am telling you, we are working, I mean--

SUB: On many fronts.

UCE: --in many... *yeah*, Allah willing, Allah permitting, this will go well, it will be a good operation, Allah willing.

SUB: I was... er, I wanted to get my papers quickly so that I can go out with you. I mean, I want to be, like you say, like you told me once to go with you to a place nobody knows, because this will be easier.

UCE: Of course.

SUB: There will not be movement around us, we would not be going or coming or... I mean, be disguised [UI] to go somewhere else.

UCE: We are... Allah willing, Allah willing, Allah permitting.

SUB: That is why, I can not, I mean, like you say, if we did it and went somewhere else and I do not have papers, it will be, like you say, my movement will be, like they say, the eye will be on me like this or that because I would leave *Texas* suddenly, and I do not have... I would have left my papers behind me, and married... and I am married and my wife will keep asking about me and the people I know will be somewhat pressuring.

UCE: What you say is correct. You need--

SUB: When I have papers, I... I find work in this place and I have papers with me, I will go to another place.

UCE: But, I want to tell you something and I want you to... regarding this issue, we might not... not let you leave immediately. If, for instance, you want to stay... it depends on... I mean--

SUB: Yes.

UCE: --I know you say that you will leave *Texas* and then they will ask, "Where did he go?"

SUB: Yes, correct.

UCE: --what you say is correct--

SUB: I know this will happen.

UCE: --so, but, I mean, when I receive a call that they want something to happen within... er, 48 hours, 72... I will... I will be coming to you. I mean, I will not... I will not... So, I want you to be ready. So... er, you have to see what you want to do, I mean... er. I understand what you say about the... er, the issue of the papers, but, I mean, do you want to do something to stay here, or do you want to leave, or what do you want to do? For instance--

SUB: That is why I wanted to ask you from the start, I am puzzled.

UCE: Er,... er, this depends on... what you say is right about... if something happens and you are not around and your papers are around, so, for example, you might be--

SUB: You know, there will be... there will be a search, for instance, for Arabs, you see? This one disappeared, for instance. They will bring his name. So, I am what? I will do it in, I mean, like you say, a clever way so that, for instance, after the operation, I will be at... for instance, I have an absence excuse, I will immediately go *somewhere*, I will be somewhere else, you see--?

UCE: Correct.

SUB: --so that this is my absence excuse that I was *somewhere*--

UCE: Correct.

SUB: --in that place.

UCE: Correct. What you say is correct.

SUB: At the same time, I wanted... I mean, if it is difficult for me to go with our brothers, for instance, like I told you once--

UCE: Correct.

SUB: --for instance, you told me, "Go to Mexico and we leave from Mexico, it is possible that, when I have my papers, I can go to Jordan and, from Jordan, I can go there. It would be easier.

UCE: What you say is correct.

SUB: It would be legal. See what laws they are coming up with, you see?

UCE: You are returning, I mean, it is as if you are returning to the homeland.

SUB: As if I am returning to the homeland. And from the homeland, nobody will ask me where I am going.

UCE: But, I do not know when exactly is the time--

SUB: Yes.

UCE: --and the date and stuff.

SUB: Of course.

UCE: You know, I mean, there is... I do not know, and I will not know unless [GPS giving directions] So, I will not know until I get a telephone.

SUB: *Yeah.*

UCE: Also, you know that Ramadan will come, Allah willing, thank Allah, next month, Allah permitting--

SUB: [UI]

UCE: --so, it is possible that any day... I mean, I will not be able to tell you exactly when. So, this is a decision that you must make yourself. Er, if you want to do something... if you want to stay over here for a while as if you are... I mean, you do not have--

SUB: I do not have patience.

UCE: --if you do not have patience... er, you do not... you do not... I mean, and I will be with you. I mean, I will be with you. Should anything happens, we can rel- rely on Allah, but I will be with you. So, may Allah facilitate it. I mean, you perform a prayer of guidance and see what else--

SUB: I... I also do not want to bother... to bother you. You might have something to do or--

UCE: I... er, I am over here for this operation.

SUB: May Allah keep you.

UCE: I am telling you the truth. I mean... er. I mean, you are the knight and I am the horse. Whatever... whatever--

SUB: No. May Allah--

UCE: No, I am telling you something, I mean, because I can not find--

SUB: You are truthful.

UCE: May Allah keep you, may Allah keep you.

SUB: I mean, if...er, I am happy to find someone to go along with me to be of the same--

UCE: Thank Allah.

SUB: --idea. Thank Allah I am happy. These days it is difficult to find... er. Like you say, all people are blindfolded.

UCE: If you just know, if you know, if you know, there are many people like us, thank Allah--

SUB: There are many people.

UCE: --thank Allah, thank Allah, there are many people like us.

SUB: But, they are in a locations that do not help them.

UCE: Exactly. We are...er, 11... 10... 11 more miles, Allah willing. I just do not want now... er, because the car we are riding in is... I will tell you later, this is very important. [Pause] And when you sent the pictures in the... with the message, there was no address or nothing? You just sent... sent...?

SUB: Yeah. I got the pictures, like you say, for locations... locations that just do the research and, like you say, publish ads, you know--?

UCE: Yes.

SUB: --it is nothing specific, I mean. I did, like you say, a *copy* of the pictures--

UCE: Oh.

SUB: --I downloaded them to my *computer*, the *copy*, I mean.

UCE: But, this location is the one that you liked. It is the best one, it is the one that is--

SUB: Yeah. I mean, the location, it is... er, I expect that it is, I mean, this will be the best one.

UCE: Thank Allah.

SUB: And I consulted, I mean, and I will continue to study to see whether I am right or not--

UCE: Allah willing, we will finish it.

SUB: --and, if right, Allah willing, we will continue to proceed with it.

UCE: Allah permitting.

SUB: If you want after the... Allah willing, after that... after this operation, we can go to a place, to another area, and do it another time--

UCE: But, oh, yeah, of course, this... this is very important. It depends on the... and we wanted... and you told me the last time we were talking together--

SUB: Yes.

UCE: --you were telling me, I mean, like I am telling you, I am here for you, I mean, there was supposed to be two locations, you remember? The location, the locations... er, what do you think? Do you want to change it or is it the same one, or do you want to do something else or--?

SUB: By Allah, if we do... if we do this operation, and if you want to do another operation at another location, I will go with you.

UCE: It depends. It is--

SUB: Like this, or, if you want something better, I am with you in it.

UCE: Tsk, no, no, no, no, no. It is not better, no.

SUB: [OV] There is nothing? Or something, I mean, something [UI] But, like I told you, I can not move like you but my problem is the papers problem. I mean, if I want to go from one state to state, I will have to drive.

UCE: It is not a state, no, it is not a state. I am talking about that one. You remember we were saying, you remember the last time when you came, we spoke about two-two locations that we can do together at the same time--

SUB: Yeah.

UCE: --like this one and one--

SUB: Yes.

UCE: --and we went to the bank and we went to the...er, to the bank and we went to the-

SUB: Correct.

UCE: --to the airport. Is this one going to be different or do you want to do something different or what do you want to do? Would you like to do the two at the same time because I have to go back and tel l... tell them if you want to do the--

SUB: But, I wanted to consult with you, that is why.

UCE: Er...

SUB: What do you think in the... in the large building, that big bank that will, for instance, is it going to shake their economy? Or shall we do this branch with the airport and it is only... I mean, for me, it will be just to scare them and it is not going to impact them much like the other one will do?

UCE: And the... it is that... er--

SUB: But, the other one will be more difficult because it is possible, like you say, the location, its size, its strategy is bigger, you know?

UCE: You are talking about the bank.

SUB: About the big bank--

UCE: Yes.

SUB: --in *Dallas*. Of course, it is not the only one there. There are several locations, there are several large banks and building... large buildings over there.

UCE: But, by Allah, you liked it. I mean, this is one... this is the one you saw--

SUB: *Yeah*.

UCE: --the best building.

SUB: The best building.

UCE: We will go see it and we rely on Allah, Allah willing.

SUB: There is a large *Bank of America* over there. It is considered one of the biggest banks, you know?

UCE: It is different from that bank.

SUB: It is completely different, yes. I mean, there are several locations over there and these locations, you can say, they are the *international* over there.

UCE: Yes.

SUB: You see?

UCE: Yes.

SUB: I mean, the location I liked because it is the *international for Wells Fargo for Dallas*.

UCE: Tsk. May Allah--

SUB: They call it *Motor*, they call it *Dallas... er, Wells Fargo Motor*, which means it is like the *engine*.

UCE: Right, right, right. No, Allah willing, we will... we will destroy the...er, destroy the *engine*, Allah willing.

SUB: I will now... er, Allah willing, I will enter it and see it now. I want to use the bathroom or something.

UCE: Er...

SUB: We will see how it works.

UCE: But, it is still a bank like any other bank.

SUB: Like any other bank.

[Pause]

SUB: *Downtown* is over there.

UCE: Meaning I should--

SUB: [UI] the buildings.

UCE: Ah. Let me see so that... so that I do not lose it. Here is *Dallas*. Are you cold, hot? Or are you...er--?

SUB: No. Fine.

UCE: I mean, you have the...er.

SUB: Sir, it is good.

UCE: Thank Allah, thank Allah.

[Pause]

SUB: Do you see which building I expect? I am not sure one hundred percent. I can show you from here.

UCE: I am not...er. Let us get close to it, Allah permitting.

SUB: I do not know how to [UI] My problem is that... I mean, when I was in California, I knew everything in California.

UCE: Yes.

SUB: I know street by street, even without... without *GPS* or anything.

UCE: Ok, by Allah--

SUB: But, I have been here for only over a year and, like you say, I stayed all of it in the *south* [UI].

[GPS giving directions]

UCE: Allah willing, *3 point whenever, we will be fine.*

[Pause]

SUB: Did you see the last building like this one here?

UCE: By Allah, I am not... when we go to *Griffin*, we will... like you say, it is a big building so it is supposed to be seen easily, I mean, it is not going to be difficult to be seen. *Dallas* is a big city, huh?

SUB: Yes, *yeah.*

UCE: You see.

SUB: I entered it maybe twice.

UCE: Just twice.

SUB: That is it.

UCE: How long have you been here? You told me you have been here for several years, right?

SUB: Yes. About a year and half, a year and few months. [Pause] Have you seen the first sign?

UCE: Where is it? Which sign?

SUB: The drying up...er, which the Prophet, Allah's prayers and peace be upon him, spoke about, the drying up of the Euphrates--

UCE: Right, right.

SUB: --it happened yesterday [GPS giving directions] there was drying up of Tigris and Euphrates and they announced it [OV].

UCE: O protecting... O protecting Allah.

SUB: So, like you say, they announced it in the news yesterday, the Turkish dams over the... over the rivers in Iraq--

UCE: There is no god but Allah.

SUB: So...er, like you say, it is possible that now is the time for the two mountains of...

SUB: ... of gold reported by the--

UCE: [Sighs]

SUB: --by the Prophet.

UCE: [Sighs] You know the best thing in the world now, I mean, the Day of Resurrection, thank Allah, is near.

SUB: *Yeah* It is a sign, I mean.

UCE: I am telling you it is near--

SUB: [UI]

UCE: --it is near, near. [GPS giving directions]

SUB: The first thing that happened in the Land of the Two Rivers and then the drying up of... of Tigris and Euphrates and the appearing of two mountains of gold, the fighting of the Muslims--

UCE: You know, I want to tell you, do you know the 5000 today... they said today that 5000 died. [GPS giving directions] I mean, it is over 5000, you know [UI]--

SUB: Among the Americans in--

UCE: --Iraq and Afghanistan.

SUB: Thank Allah. They do not put that out in the news.

UCE: Thank Allah.

SUB: They put out about four soldiers and a *helicopter* that crashed and all of that is lies.

UCE: Those are 5000, thank Allah, it is because it is aggressing, thank Allah.

SUB: That is why they started to withdraw--

UCE: Hmm.

SUB: --they started to feel the defeat.

UCE: They die. Thank Allah.

SUB: I have a closed *Wells Fargo bank account*.

UCE: Why is it closed?

SUB: *Yeah*. I have its *card*. It is because I did not use it, like you say when I came from California.

UCE: Yes.

SUB: I can, like... go inside now, for instance, and say I want to check on my *account*. I will say, "Why have you closed it?" for instance, and pretend that I do not know anything. I will take a look at the place and ask, "*Where is the restroom?*" I will go there.

UCE: Allah willing.

SUB: Allah willing.

UCE: For sure it will be busy. There is going to be a lot of people in the bank.

SUB: It is possible, yes. And if you see, for instance, that the other one is better, fine, let us rely on Allah.

UCE: No, no, no, no, no, no, no, I mean--

SUB: I see this *Bank of America*. Now we started to enter.

UCE: This is the one you are telling me about.

SUB: No, this is the American Bank, the bank that is coming.

UCE: Yes.

SUB: That is a different one. Not *Wells Fargo*, this is *Bank of America* if you hear about it.

UCE: Yes, I hear about *Bank of America*, I hear, but...

SUB: Now, this is a big... a big building also. But, the building we chose is bigger than it.

UCE: There is also a zoo over here, a *zoo*, here it is.

SUB: What is it? Ah, *Dallas Zoo*. [OV]

UCE: The *Dallas Zoo*. By Allah, the entire country is a *zoo*.

SUB: The other day I saw a *film* that they are recently showing in the *cinema*. So, I went to see, I thought it is a *film*, you know--

UCE: Ah-um.

SUB: --the sons of bitches, I mean, the Anti-Christ, we know all about him, right?

UCE: Of course.

SUB: Thank Allah. They are showing a *film* about him. So, it turned out that the *film*, at the end, that the whole story is a story about the Anti-Christ and stuff--

UCE: Ah-um.

SUB: --and how... they made a *film* about him.

UCE: Yes.

SUB: I said, praise Allah, I mean, they are... they are the ones planning for his rise now. I mean, like you say, it is a Zionist revolution that no one... I mean, like you say, it is hidden and no one is seeing it.

UCE: Of course. There is no god but Allah. What is the *film*? What was it called?

SUB: I mean, by Allah, I can not remember exactly but, I expect it is there in the [UI] It was just a *film*, a myth, you see, it turned out to be about the Anti-Christ. I said let me get it. I expect that this is it, this is the location which is... the glass building.

UCE: I see... I see a building... yes, the one which is--

SUB: The one whose three quarters is behind the other building.

UCE: We will enter... [GPS giving directions] With Allah's permission, with Allah's permission. May He open it for us, with Allah's permission, with Allah's permission. [Pause] [GPS giving directions] Here it is, here it is. [GPS giving directions]

SUB: Are you not going to take it?

UCE: [GPS giving directions] I see what you are talking about, yes. But, it is a little bit far.

SUB: Driving on these roads-- [OV]

UCE: Okay, which way should I enter? I entered the wrong way or what?

SUB: You entered the right way.

UCE: *Downtown next right*, but we are here in... [GPS giving directions] If we made a mistake, it is not a problem. [GPS giving directions] Ah, we made a mistake, it is not a problem. [GPS giving directions] Okay, Allah willing [GPS giving directions] *Keep left, huh?*

SUB: Yes.

[GPS giving directions]

UCE: Allah willing. [GPS giving directions] *Left... here is Elm Street?* Allah willing.

SUB: Are you going to cross *Bryan Street*?

UCE: No. *Elm... here... here... here is Elm.* We are now on *Elm Street*. [GPS giving directions] Allah willing.

SUB: Allah willing, we will enter [UI]

UCE: Do you see the building because I can not see it from here.

SUB: It is... it is in the middle of the city.

[GPS giving directions]

UCE: *Right*. Allah willing.

SUB: All of the Arabs' money is here.

UCE: All of the world's money?  
[GPS giving directions]

SUB: All of the... all of the Arabs' money--

UCE: Yes.

SUB: --the blood they stole.

UCE: Of course. Wait, wait. We are in *downtown*, are we not?

SUB: In *downtown*.

UCE: I mean, it is supposed to be close to here, Allah willing.

SUB: It should be... maybe straight ahead.

UCE: Allah willing. [GPS giving directions] [beeps] What is that? This one in front of us? Wait, there is a police car so that...[beeps].

SUB: We should not make a move... [beep] We must be [UI].

UCE: Allah willing.

SUB: Because the buildings are so big, you cannot see them.

UCE: I see in front of, right there--

SUB: This one, yes.

UCE: --do you see it?

SUB: *Yeah*, I see it.

UCE: Okay, should I turn around?

SUB: No, you will go... go to the *right* and then you go to the street.

UCE: Allah willing. [Beep]

SUB: I never came to the area over here.

UCE: How do you spell *Wells Fargo*? *Er, Well* like--

SUB: *W, E, L, L*--

UCE: There are a lot of people in *downtown*.

SUB: Oh, wow! I expect it to be this building. Many people, by Allah. I never--  
[Beeps]

UCE: Should I enter here?

SUB: Yes.

UCE: Allah willing.

SUB: This building is [UI]

UCE: That one?

SUB: *Yeah*. This building is new like... like gold.  
[Beeps]

UCE: Spell the... *Far*... *Fargo*, what?

SUB: *W, E--*

UCE: *F, U?*

SUB: *No, W, E--*

UCE: Yes, I know, but *Fargo*.

SUB: Yes, *Fargo, F, A--*

UCE: Aha.

SUB: *--R--*

UCE: Allah willing.

SUB: *--G, O.*

UCE: *G, O.* [Beeps] Anyway, in the name of Allah. Where is the--?

SUB: [UI]

UCE: Meaning I should go straight.

SUB: You go straight and then you turn *left*.

[Beeps]

UCE: Is it on the right or the left?

SUB: On the left.

UCE: Allah willing, Allah willing. [Beeps] Oh, in the name of Allah, what Allah desires, in the name of Allah, what Allah desires.

SUB: *Wells Fargo*.

UCE: Can I turn left from here or I can not? Can I enter here?

SUB: No. *This is one-way*. Let us go straight.

UCE: No, I am talking about over here.

SUB: Yes, you can.

UCE: Take two pictures of it, by the Prophet. Take two pictures so that I can send them to them. Do you remember that you told me something about *Field, Field... er, street*, right?

SUB: *Yeah*.

UCE: Here it is, *Field Street 600*. Here it is, *Field Street 600... er, north, north* [beeps] *Current location*. Let me do a *save* for it, put the *coordination, Okay*. Allah willing, Allah permitting. [Beeps] Let me... I am turning right.

SUB: No, over here.

UCE: I am turning left, I mean, I am turning left. We relied on Allah, we relied on Allah, O Allah. O Allah, let it be this one.

SUB: Yes. This is it.

UCE: Are you sure?

SUB: *Yeah*, 100 percent.

UCE: Is anything written on it? Yes, here it is.

SUB: I see it.

UCE: I see it, *Well... Well Fargo.*

SUB: Allah willing.

UCE: In the name of Allah, what Allah desired. It is good that it is big. I mean, you are not--

SUB: Yes. It is in the city center, I mean. [OV]

UCE: Exactly.

SUB: I mean, it will be such a commotion.

UCE: Here it is.

SUB: *Yeah, yeah.*

UCE: Do you want to enter?

SUB: *Yeah.* I will enter [UI].

UCE: Okay, I will... I tell you something--

SUB: Do you also want to enter?

UCE: No, I can not because... I tell you something, if you want me to drop you off over here--

SUB: Aha.

UCE: --and I will return to you over here exactly. Give me...er, is ten minutes enough?

SUB: Ten minutes, *ten minutes.*

UCE: If someone says something to you, you deal with it. I mean, I am only--

SUB: I will deal with it. Rely.

UCE: Fine.

SUB: Ok, peace be on you.

UCE: Peace be on you. I will be over here, Allah willing.

SUB: *Yes.*

UCE: Peace be on you.

UCE: [Beeps] *I am in downtown Dallas, and I dropped him off in front of Wells Fargo. Okay, just wanted you to be... Correct, correct, he is inside. Thank you.*

*Subject went inside, he is walking around. I just see him right now just walking around the building, backpack, looking around, he did not enter yet. [Pause]*  
*I cannot see him right now, it appears that he went inside. Here is SOG. [Pause]*  
[Beeps] [GPS giving directions] [Pause]

UCE: Peace be on you.

SUB: Peace and Allah's mercy and His blessings.

UCE: Good news, Allah willing.

SUB: What is the news? What is this?

UCE: Er, juice. [chime]

SUB: Ok, by Allah, that is good.

UCE: I went down to the *cafeteria*. Of course, there *security, high security--*

SUB: Yes.

UCE: *--everywhere*. My appearance, I mean, did make them-- No, you are... you are...

SUB: *--you see?*

UCE: Thank you, may Allah keep you. May Allah keep you. Okay, drink, drink, drink.

SUB: I... I went downstairs--

UCE: Yes.

SUB: *--so, to the cafeteria, under the... in the ground level.*

UCE: Yes. And then?

SUB: Er, I went inside the bathroom over there. An Indian guy even saw me, he kept talking with me and telling me, "*Where are you from?*" I told him, "*From Jordan.*" So, he was--

UCE: What kind of guy?

SUB: An Indian guy.

UCE: Yes.

SUB: In the *cafeteria*.

UCE: Yes.

SUB: He thought I was Indian or something. So... he was telling me, "*Ok, nice to meet you, peace be on you,*" stuff like that. I told him, "On you." I made myself look like I do not know how to speak even Arabic. So, he asked me, "*Where you work? Why you are here?*" He kept asking me something like *weird questions*. So, I told him, "*I was just coming to get some change for our place.*"

UCE: Does he work in the *cafeteria*?

SUB: *Yeah*.

UCE: But, what do you think about the location?

SUB: Er, the location is... perfect. So, I went downstairs using the elevator--

UCE: Is there a lot of people?

SUB: --the ground level. *Yeah*, there is a lot of people. Er, my dear sir...er, I went to the bathroom--

UCE: Ah-um.

SUB: --the bathroom is, like you say, is like what I imagined. I mean, do you know how the... the humidity thing--?

UCE: Yes.

SUB: --the... the tiles--

UCE: Yes.

SUB: --the ones that you left and you can... er--

UCE: Yes, yes, yes.

SUB: You know how?

UCE: Yes.

SUB: I left them. I stood on the seat. The door, *you can lock it, it is just one room.*  
You open it and you see that it is underground. I mean, when... when I lifted it--

UCE: Um-hum.

SUB: --everything, I saw everything. [GPS giving directions] I saw the *air condition*  
[GPS giving directions] There is a good place over there to plant a bomb. I  
mean-- [OV]

UCE: Do you think it is just--?

SUB: --I can plant it there and then leave.

UCE: Ok, by Allah... by Allah, that is good. I just want to...er, I tell you something, it is  
a big building, huh?

SUB: It is a very big building.

UCE: Okay, and where is the bathroom exactly?

SUB: The bathroom is under it, under it in the ground.

UCE: Er [sighs] Er, [GPS giving directions]

SUB: I mean, it is underground, under the building.

UCE: Yes.

SUB: You see?

UCE: I see, I see. [GPS giving directions]

SUB: But, I mean-- [OV]

UCE: Do you think... I mean, is there a lot of people who are--

SUB: A lot of people.

UCE: So, this one can really be... do you think this one would be good? I mean, do you  
think... I mean, tell me what do you think.

SUB: By Allah--

UCE: [OV] Tell me why... tell me why this one would be... I mean, this one is the one--

SUB: I was... I was a little not sure... like you say, there are a lot of people... er, there are a lot of people who are coming to get money, you see?

UCE: Yes.

SUB: So, I do not know. There are some children in the *cafeteria*, there are cafeterias, restaurants *they are under... under the bank*. [GPS giving directions]

UCE: Yes.

SUB: So, I do not know, by Allah.

UCE: Did you enter the bank itself, or you were just in the *cafeteria*?

SUB: Er, I went underground but I did not enter the bank itself because there are elevators which take you upstairs, to the higher stories--

UCE: Yes.

SUB: --er, I could not... I did not go upstairs. [GPS giving directions] I went downstairs.

UCE: Okay.

SUB: You see?

UCE: Yes. I can turn right here. But...er, do you think that this is a good location?

SUB: *Yeah*, Allah willing.

UCE: Allah permitting.

SUB: But, we must do some research about it too in order to be sure.

UCE: [Sighs] What do you think? [GPS giving directions]

SUB: And the bathroom, I want to... I want to be sure that the center of the bathroom is *exactly* under the building--

UCE: Yes.

SUB: --you see?

UCE: You mean in order... I mean--

SUB: In order to bring it down.

UCE: Er--

SUB: Of course... er [GPS giving directions] What is good about it, if you enter... er, in the car parking beneath it--

UCE: Yes.

SUB: --you see?

UCE: Yes.

SUB: Er, you enter from the parking lot to... to the building's lower level.

UCE: Yes.

SUB: I mean, if I have a car, I will enter, a briefcase with me, and with the briefcase there will be the goods, the... er, the stuff that we want, I will enter the bathroom [GPS giving directions] I will enter the bathroom and then I will leave. [GPS giving directions].

UCE: Er... [GPS giving directions] Okay, by Allah, that is good. Let me... er, I will tell you something.

SUB: Yes.

UCE: Did you take pictures or something or you did not?

SUB: I did take pictures, *yeah*.

UCE: You took pictures from inside?

SUB: Er... just from the outside.

UCE: Fine.

SUB: Because, I can not from the outside.

UCE: Right, right, right. And what did this one ask you, I mean, what do you work? I mean, why did he ask you like that? [GPS giving directions]

SUB: He said to me, "What do you work?", I told him, "*Gas station... er, "I told him, "Gas stations... er, stores..."*

UCE: Yes.

SUB: *He said, "Oh, I want to buy a gas station." I told him, "Yeah, I got a cousin, he got a 150 gas stations around Dallas, man!"*

UCE: [Laughs]

SUB: *He said, "Oh, write the location here." I told him, "Our location is the one in Midlothian, [GPS giving directions] not the gas station." But, I gave him the wrong phone number--*

UCE: Yes.

SUB: --the wrong telephone number.

UCE: Why do you think this guy came to you? I mean, was he just trying to do... I mean, chat with you anything? [OV]

SUB: He is trying to chat with me.

UCE: Okay, that is good. But, it is a big building, there is a lot of people in it, I mean, it can be... er. By Allah, that is good, the *casualties* will be good. Thank Allah, thank Allah, Lord of the Worlds.

SUB: If you want to go to another building, we will go.

UCE: No, I--

SUB: One of these bigger buildings.

UCE: No, this one... I... I very much like this one because the--

SUB: The *downtown*.

UCE: --its location is right, its location is good, its location is... er. Thank Allah.

SUB: They finished building it in 2007. [GPS giving directions] I will show that written on it.

UCE: Allah willing. Let us go to the hotel.

SUB: But, I mean, what Allah desired, I did not find trouble. I mean, like what I expected, like what I wanted--

UCE: Hmm.

SUB: --I mean, the *sink* and the *toilet*-- [GPS giving directions]

UCE: Yes.

SUB: --I stood on it, I raised my hand to that and it opened for me.

UCE: Right away?

SUB: So, I looked and everything... everything is *stone*, because it is under the building over here.

UCE: Right.

SUB: I said, praised be Allah, I mean, that it opened.

UCE: I mean, you can put something without any problem. [GPS giving directions]

SUB: No one... no one will know.

UCE: And no one will know.  
[GPS giving directions]

UCE: Thank Allah.

SUB: Of course, like I said, I will fix up how I look that day, put on a suit and stuff.

UCE: No, I am not... do not worry too much. [GPS giving directions] What you say is correct. But, this is the only person who spoke to you and said anything to you?

SUB: Yes, yes, this is the only guy. I tried not to talk to him, but he is, like you say, the persistent type. [GPS giving directions]

UCE: Thank Allah.

SUB: Next time I will change my looks more so that he will not recognize me.

UCE: And is this the only location that you can enter to? Or...er, I mean, this location or there is... er, another door that you can... er--

SUB: I can go up in the elevator to the upper levels [beeps] But, they will tell you they look like... those working at the bank only go upstairs. You see what I mean?

UCE: Yes.

SUB: I mean, if you work on that bank, the *computers* are upstairs because, my dear sir, the bank is downstairs.

UCE: Yes.

SUB: I mean, when I entered, it is all elevators in the bank, it is all made of elevators, I mean, there must be about 25 elevators inside--

UCE: Oh, really!

SUB: --and they are also made out of glass. I mean, you would see, you would see the people while you are ascending, you see?

UCE: Okay, by Allah, it is good.

SUB: All those ascending, like you say, *they are working in there.*

UCE: Ok, by Allah, that is good, good, good.

SUB: And the *customer service* is downstairs, in a small glass location. [beeps]  
[GPS giving directions]

UCE: Okay, by Allah, that is good.

SUB: There are approximately 5 *counters* there [GPS giving directions]

UCE: No, we did...[GPS giving directions] We... we entered the wrong way. [GPS giving directions] Do you have anything else, any other location or this is the one that you like? [GPS giving directions]

SUB: At the present time? Allah willing, I will--  
[GPS giving directions]

UCE: There is no god but Allah. Let us see-- [GPS giving directions] No, but, I like the building. I like the building, it looks good.

SUB: Yes.

UCE: And, like you say, what I like more about it is that it is new, it is a new building.  
[GPS giving directions]

SUB: *Yeah.*

UCE: Thank Allah.

SUB: But, this...er, I did not like that man.

UCE: But, it is one person out of millions. But he was a Pakistani and not an Arab?

SUB: He was Pakistani [OV] or Indian.

UCE: Not an American?

SUB: No. But, I mean, I did not like the way he talked when he said, "*What are you doing here,*" you see?

UCE: And what was he working? *Security* or he was working-- [OV]

SUB: No, *he is working for the cafeteria.*

UCE: Right.

SUB: I expect that he is Muslim because... "Peace be on you" when I entered and "Peace be on you" when I left.

UCE: He said, "Peace be on you"?

SUB: Yes.

UCE: Ah. [GPS giving directions] *Dallas* is big, by the way, it is good, it is a good city. It can really do... er, a big commotion. [GPS giving directions] O Allah! [GPS giving directions]

SUB: I also played games on the man, the poor guy. [Laughs] I told him...er, he wanted... "*Write the address for me,*" I wrote *the address* for him--

UCE: Yes.

SUB: --he said, "I want to buy a *gas station* over here in Dallas." [GPS giving directions] I told him, "Buying is expensive over here. You should go over there a little bit." He told me, "*Yeah, I will go over there.*" He told me, "[UI] I told him, "*If you return, if I come back here, I'll let you know--*"

UCE: Hmm.

SUB: "--*if I find anything.*"

UCE: Okay, by Allah, it is good. [GPS giving directions] Hmm... here is *north*. Fine, we are doing good, thank Allah. [GPS giving directions] Did you have breakfast today or not?

SUB: *Yeah, I had breakfast, I had a sandwich.* But, by Allah, I wanted us to have lunch together at my place.

UCE: I know, I know and...er, let us just see... let us just go to the...er [GPS giving directions] my room, let me see my place [GPS giving directions] and let me... er, you know, I will return... I will travel today, I will return--

SUB: Yes.

UCE: --travel...er, I mean, over 1000 miles, over 1000 miles. But, everything is for... er, everything is by Allah's permission, everything is by Allah's permission, everything is by Allah's permission and everything is for... so that Allah may render us victorious over the infidels, Allah willing.

SUB: You will be happy, of course, after the--

UCE: Of course, of course.

SUB: --the success.

UCE: Of course. Er, it is very important and Allah... thank Allah, may Allah open it for us, provide us and make us victorious, Allah permitting.

SUB: *Yeah.* I mean, I was thinking that, if this is how it is going to be like that, underground, that... Now, what are the factors that we will have. I mean, for instance, if we have something that can operate by telephone, the *service* will be underground.

UCE: Er... this is not... I mean, I do not know what is the...er, I mean, I can not tell you exactly because I do not have the--

SUB: *Yeah.*

UCE: --the experience in this, how is exactly done. Er, this is not for me, I mean, there are other people, Allah permitting. I mean, it is a wonderful building, I really like it. [GPS giving directions] With Allah's permission. [Pause] [GPS giving directions] What is that building on the left?

SUB: Which one? Over there?

UCE: That one.

SUB: By Allah, I do not know.

UCE: It looks like a mall or am I wrong? I am talking about the big building, yes.

SUB: That building?

UCE: Yes, I am just asking, I mean.

SUB: By Allah--

UCE: But, I mean, your idea... this is in the middle... the location... in the *down*... I mean, in the heart, *Dallas*--

SUB: [OV] In the heart, yes.

UCE: --in the heart of *Dallas*.

SUB: And it is a bank, you know?

UCE: Ah, yes, a large bank.

SUB: Money, people's money and *credit cards*--

UCE: Of course, of course.

SUB: --and with ranking jobs, I mean, it will be a strike, like... like they killed the children of Iraq, it will be a strike to them. [GPS giving directions]

UCE: Yes.

SUB: All the economy, it is a war against Iraq, war in Afghanistan and war against people.

UCE: But, may Allah make it easy, thank Allah.

SUB: Those who work with them or--

UCE: But, see, I mean--

SUB: [OV] [UI]

UCE: Of course.

SUB: Thank Allah.

UCE: I have to pay money here, huh? Five thousand died over there. Who knows, maybe Allah will open it for us and people here also will--

SUB: Allah willing.

UCE: --will end.

[Pause]

SUB: It is a nice car to drive.

UCE: Yes.

SUB: It is new. Do you like *trucks* or cars more?

UCE: I, by Allah, if they bring me a camel, I will ride a camel, Allah permitting. Er--

SUB: Allah willing, you will ride [UI].

UCE: Allah permitting. It does not make a difference, it does not make a difference with me anything--

SUB: Whatever will do.

UCE: --whatever is told. I will ride whatever I am told to. Thank Allah. This is *Mocking-er*, yes, this is--

SUB: I, by Allah, praised be Allah, I mean, it is like I imagined in my head how the bathroom would be--

UCE: Yes.

SUB: --it turned to be exactly, praised be Allah. I mean, it is a coincidence.

UCE: It is underneath?

SUB: It turned out to be underneath the building, I mean, you know? But, I want to be sure, just to be sure, that it is in the center of the building from underneath, that it is not on one side, inclining to the right too much or inclining to the left, this is so that it impact the building, you know--?

UCE: Yes.

SUB: --when it brings it down. But, er, I mean, *how it looks like to me*, I mean, how I imagined that... because I walked in the building, when I took the elevator down and the *cafeteria* was in front of me--

UCE: Yeah.

SUB: --and there was a car garage. I also walked inside the building more to go to the *restroom*--

UCE: Yes.

SUB: --there are still two *cafeteria* [sic], there is a *store for groceries*, and the *cafeteria* attached to the *restroom* had some Chinese people working in it [UI] and there were employees down there--

UCE: Oh, really!

SUB: --bank employees, *yeah*.

UCE: Okay, good.

SUB: So, this... er, I mean, it will be a strong strike to bring it down.

UCE: Allah permitting.

SUB: Allah willing. Ramadan...er, was the commemoration of the Night Journey and Ascension yesterday?

UCE: I believe so. By Allah, I am not er--

SUB: Because there was a guy-- [OV].

UCE: --I was on the road. But, I mean--, I did not stop at a mosque or anything. I was er, told, "Drive the car from here to there." I am telling you I stopped only to put gas. When I called you--

SUB: [UI]

UCE: --I was driving, I only put gas. Allah willing, Ramadan will be, Allah permitting, will be on the 16th or the 17th according to the crescent.

SUB: Yes.

UCE: You know every year in Saudi Arabia, ah, yes, in Saudi Arabia, it appears--

SUB: Yes.

UCE: --on such a day and in Egypt, I mean, we want it to be even according to the crescent. There is no god other than Allah.

SUB: They are not in agreement even over the crescent, this is it.

UCE: It is one crescent, it is [laughs].

SUB: [OV] Crescent. This goes to show you there is hypocrisy.

UCE: Of course, of course. There is hypocrisy in all of these countries.

SUB: It is now, like you say, this stage is a very advanced stage in the world. Like you say, Iran is emerging as a new one on the picture. Israel, like you say, this president, this new coming minister, is bothering everyone. He does not give deference to America, nor to the Arabs nor to anything. He wants to do what is in his head. That's it, he will declare it Israel Israel.

UCE: Oh, yes, that's it.

SUB: You know? So, he even came to Jordan, our place, they are still signing peace treaties—

UCE: Do you know, I feel--

SUB: --like dogs.

UCE: --there will never be peace between--

SUB: There is no peace--

UCE: --Muslims, I mean--

SUB: --they are, they are the ones who robbed.

UCE: The one who starts is more unjust.

SUB: Those people [UI].

UCE: Allah permitting. In the name of Allah. [Pause] How is your family back home?

SUB: By Allah, everybody is well. Thank Allah.

UCE: Thank Allah.

SUB: Some people got married, some people have children and some people got divorced. Thank Allah. My father was just talking with me two days ago. He told me, "If America is not working for you, go back home." I told him, "Rely on Allah. Allah willing, everything will be alright." Thank Allah.

UCE: Thank Allah.

[Pause]

[GPS giving directions]

UCE: O Allah. O Allah.

[Pause]

SUB: What do you think? The old one or this new one?

[GPS giving directions]

UCE: By Allah, let us sit and... and talk together. I, I mean...er, where is *Dallas*?

SUB: Correct. Continue.

[Pause]

UCE: What is that? Are we going to put money in that or what?

SUB: No one will put... You must, see all the people are going

UCE: Okay. Should I enter... we will go... let us see.

[GPS giving directions]

SUB: It seems that they're not operating it.

[GPS giving directions]

UCE: Over here, you put money everywhere, sir.

SUB: Yes, of course.

UCE: [Sighs] By Allah, the building is wonderful. I mean, the...er, the...er, the location--

SUB: Yes.

UCE: --I mean, what Allah desired, I mean, in a location--

SUB: A suitable one.

UCE: Exactly. Er, what do you think? I mean, you are like my brother. You are not like my brother, you are my brother--

SUB: [Laughs] May Allah--

UCE: --exactly, I mean. You are exactly my brother. What... what... what do you think?

SUB: By Allah, my opinion is, Allah willing, I mean, this one, like you say, I brought it up without me planning or nothing. I mean, it is just *pick- pick it up*, you see how?

UCE: I mean, what were you doing? Were you doing--

SUB: I was doing a research--

UCE: Yes.

SUB: --I was looking and stuff, and seeing like a normal search--

UCE: Yes.

SUB: --I found this location, what Allah desired, I mean, like you say, it came, I mean, I found it by coincidence, you see?

UCE: Yes.

SUB: It is not like I researched to find it. And the... I mean, when I researched the location, the location turned out to be big and it has money and stuff and--

UCE: Yes, of course, I mean.

SUB: --of course, the other bank has more money. I thought, I mean, instead of doing, for instance, two operations which will be stressed out a lot, for instance, you see--

UCE: Yes.

SUB: --you can do it one big operation like this one, it would be a strike in the middle of *downtown* for them.

UCE: It is a strike in all the--

SUB: In all the... I mean, they will shut down the entire *downtown*, you see?

UCE: Exactly, I mean, you are...er.

SUB: But, for instance, there is a risk [GPS giving directions] when you do a first operation, such as bombing, for instance, you see and the second operation will be in the airport, it can happen, we will also be in danger because we are still in the *area*.

UCE: I understand.

SUB: You understand me? [GPS giving directions] It is possible... it is possible that they see--

UCE: I did not enter, there is no god but Allah.

SUB: --they might, you remember that... [GPS giving directions] When we do an operation at the bank, right?

UCE: Right.

SUB: When we go to the airport, if they hear about the bank, what happened to it, there will be *high security*. [GPS giving directions]

UCE: What you say... what you say is correct, what you say is correct.

SUB: because... because at the airport, they will say, "*High security any airport*," in the first place.

UCE: And this one, like I am telling you, it is in the center of the city, I mean--

SUB: [OV] [UI]

UCE: --in the middle of... in the middle of the--

SUB: There will be *alarm* in the entire city, all the police cars and everybody [GPS giving directions] all kinds of intelligence, I mean, you need to take that into account because, for instance, after the operation which... the last operations which took place, they became... they now have a different type of *security*, you know?

UCE: Right, what you say is right.

SUB: --there will be an *alarm*.

UCE: But, no one will anything about that one. [GPS giving directions]

SUB: No one will know anything at all. But, anyway, always, like you say, someone will know.

UCE: [Coughs]

SUB: Just as a precaution.

UCE: But, its location is very good. Its location is... I mean, and no one will know...er--

SUB: No one will know that it is a bank [GPS giving directions] From *New York* to *Texas*, you know? It will be a very strong strike, the *Texas* strike.

UCE: For your knowledge, no one... it never happened. So--

SUB: Yes.

UCE: --it is a good idea, it is a good idea.

SUB: I must answer this telephone and see what.

UCE: Answer it. Do not tell anyone.

SUB: [Speaking on the phone] *Hello. Hey. Er, at my lawyer. Troy, I think, I am not sure. I think he went er, to the dentist, to fix his teeth. Yeah. For who? Troy er, I do not have his new phone number [GPS giving directions] but you can call [OV] old cell phone. Well, probably, he is like inside the office or-- [GPS giving directions] [OV] Okay? Alright, bye. The store.*

UCE: Where is the hotel [UI]? Tsk.

SUB: What do you need?

UCE: The hotel, I am staying at the *Embassy Suite*, but I do not remember where. I do not know where is the... Hold on, there is a hotel over here?

SUB: You want the *Suite* itself or--?

UCE: The *Embassy Suite* that I stayed in last time.

SUB: Yes. I expect that you went too far.

UCE: No, I did not...er, yes.

SUB: Because--

UCE: Wait, wait.

SUB: We should have gone from behind the bridge, something like that. Correct?

UCE: There is no god but Allah. Did you see the hotel... from where you are... you are not? Did you find a hotel or not?

SUB: *Spring Valley*. I remember *Spring Valley*, this street. [beeps] But, is the *hotel* over there?

UCE: *Embassy Suite*, here it is. Here it is.

SUB: Are you turning right?

UCE: Here we are. [GPS giving directions]

SUB: By Allah, should I go straight? Okay. Here it is, right in front of us. There is no god but Allah. You know, I did not pay attention. [GPS giving directions]

SUB: By Allah, I am like you.

UCE: Do you want to eat? I... I am not... do you want to eat something? Do you want us to go eat something or do you want to stay over her?

SUB: By Allah, whatever is convenient for you.

UCE: Whatever you want. Is there anything Arabic here or not?

SUB: Uh-um, there is in *Dallas*, I expect, but, by Allah, I do not know exactly.

UCE: Wait until we find out.

SUB: If you want--

UCE: I need to go to the bathroom.

SUB: --I can check on the telephone, on the *computer*, I will find it.

UCE: No, it is here. Wait, let us see. Come on, let me... let me go to the bathroom. I am not-- [noise] [beeps] Wait, let me see the... [noise] And this one is also not working. Do you have the *computer*? Do you have the *computer*?

SUB: Yes, I have it.

UCE: You have the *computer*? Rely on Allah. Let us go. Leave all of that nonsense. [Noise]

SUB: I wanted to ask you, every time you come over here, you stay--

UCE: This is the best thing.

SUB: *Yeah--*

UCE: Because the rooms, its rooms are good.

SUB: Aha.

UCE: --and er--

SUB: Do you stay under your name?

UCE: What?

SUB: You stay under your name?

UCE: It depends. They either get me the hotel under someone's name and I go do it, or either such and such. It depends.

SUB: Okay, I want to er, in our area, like you say, the *gas station* has a *motel*, a good place, I mean.

UCE: Where?

SUB: It might be cheaper.

UCE: But, you have the problem...er, the problem you have, sir, the problem you have is that... let us go in, let us go in. The problem is with [UI] [Noise] The problem you have--, come here, come here, the *gas station* you have, *man*, your area--

SUB: Yes.

UCE: --it has something like...er--

SUB: It is tribal.

UCE: --very small.

SUB: --it is very tribal and very small.

UCE: Yes.

SUB: --you see? So, for me--

UCE: If a stranger comes--

SUB: Exactly.

UCE: *Yeah*. [Noise] Come in, come in, please come in, my dear [sighs].

SUB: I understand what you are saying.

UCE: You see? I mean, it will be very difficult for me [noise] see the--

SUB: Yes.

UCE: For me, I can not be in an area like that because most of the people, you told me there are some Arabs and Jordanians or I do not know what.

SUB: Yes, right.

UCE: Er, er, er, nobody, I can not let anyone see me at all.

SUB: No, of course. Yes, right.

UCE: Come in. [noise] Enter to your left, sir. To your left, sir. In the name of Allah, the Most Gracious, the Most Merciful. Come, come. Let us not let anyone see you. Come in, Pasha.

SUB: In the name of Allah. Allah willing, it is good.

UCE: Sit down. Sit down. Let me go to the... I have been wanting to go to the bathroom for-- [noise] [water running]. Also, the hotel here is good because it is far and also each person has his room--

SUB: *Yeah.*

UCE: --so, it is good that it is separate. Also--

SUB: No, I hear, I understand.

UCE: --I say that--, I know, I know, but I am afraid that your... what, your place is... its name is *Italy* but it is that size. If anyone sees me over there... and that is why I did not go to you over there, because you were telling me you want to cook and stuff. If anyone sees me over there... er. How many people live there? Four. You and others, you see? [Laughs]

SUB: [UI]

UCE: But, over here, *Embassy Suite*, I do not know what, people do not know what other do, exactly.

SUB: [UI] So, do you want me to show you the pictures or something?

UCE: Yes.

[Pause]

UCE: You can show it to me.

SUB: I will open the *e-mail*, Allah willing, and I will see if I received anything from them.

UCE: The *e-mail* that you sent to them?

SUB: The one I sent and I will see, I might have received something from them.

UCE: Do they send you... I... I... I do not know. That is why...er, I can not answer this question.

SUB: There is nothing new. But, like you say--

UCE: Let me adjust the eye-glasses [sighs] Show me. In the name of Allah, the Most Gracious, the Most Merciful.

SUB: [UI] [OV]

UCE: Peace be on you, Allah's mercy and blessings. My dear brother Rafiq, there is no might or strength except by Allah, the Great. Can you not enlarge these words a little bit?

SUB: Yes, it is possible.

UCE: Read it for me. If you can read, read it for me or just... just read it for me. Or enlarge it. Or read it... Read it for me and tell me what it says. [Coughs]

SUB: [Reading] "My dear brother Rafiq, may Almighty Allah protect you from all evil. There is no strength or power except by Almighty Great Allah. In the beginning, we pray Almighty Allah for the blessing of these actions and to protect them from all evil, Allah willing, praise and thanks be to Allah. We are people who do not accept humiliation, even if the whole world was humiliated--

UCE: Of course.

SUB: --as Allah has facilitated for us the path of jihad in order for it to be mercy for us. We are the people of Muhammad, Allah's peace and mercy be on him.

UCE: Peace and mercy be on him. Peace and mercy be on him.

SUB: [Static] This is a mercy of Him. There are many rewards that humans can not imagine. Let us keep fear out of our hearts. My brothers, I assure you that, Allah willing, we will carry out a successful operation. After a long patience, success will come. We will draw a smile on the faces... on the faces of our brothers in their prisons in Guantanamo, the prisons of the Arab tyrants, Palestine, Iraq, Afghanistan, Pakistan, Morocco, Egypt, Jordan, Lebanon, Syria, Algeria, Sudan, Somalia and the Muslims of China who are oppressed--

UCE: Allah is Great.

SUB: --because they recognize the only and only Allah and His Messenger, Muhammad, Allah's prayers and peace be upon him.

UCE: Peace and mercy be on him. Peace and mercy be on him.

SUB: My greeting to all the brothers over there in... er, we are all bound in one heart which is not- not broken except by the command of Almighty Allah. The final moments of this world have started to appear. Woe for our nation and our tyrant government--

UCE: [Coughs]

SUB: --we will change the world, arouse the people against them and draw one line, er, draw one line--

UCE: [Coughs].

SUB: --one line--

UCE: Yes.

SUB: --for one army under the banner of "There is no god except Allah, Muhammad is Allah's Messenger", in the name of al-Qa'ida Organization--

UCE: Allah is Great.

SUB: --under the command of Emir Shaykh Usama Bin Laden, may Allah bless his life, wealth and relatives. I do not want to long on you as there is a lot things that we are looking for, I want to er-, I want er-, Allah willing, that I want to do. But, may Allah help us, after this operation, with bigger operations, Allah willing.

UCE: Allah permitting.

SUB: The pictures are here and the strike will be certain and strong, Allah willing. It will shake the economy in the state as the economy is shaky right now." And here I put the bank's information. I think that they er-, that they took the pictures. The pictures are not there.

UCE: Did you send- send the pictures to this person?

SUB: *Yeah.* I put them with the *message*, but it seems that they pulled the pictures, they pulled-, they pulled the pictures, like you say. They pulled the pictures. They took them out of the *message*. I expect, because they are not there. But, I have other pictures, I mean.

UCE: Are these the pictures?

SUB: Er-, no. These are, like you say, the writings.

UCE: Yes.

SUB: The *internet* is a bit slow.

UCE: But your *internet* is good, by the way--

SUB: Ah, *yeah*.

UCE: --through this phone. There is nothing better than that.

SUB: In any place.

UCE: So, this is with that.

SUB: There is this with that through the *bluetooth*.

UCE: Do you think this brother took the pictures?

SUB: I expect that he took the pictures because I downloaded them, I mean, 100%.

UCE: Ah, it is not working.

SUB: It is frozen.

UCE: May Allah facilitate, may Allah protect. What do you request? [UI] I will remind you of the best... in order...

SUB: By Allah, Allah willing, Almighty Allah permitting. I mean, I will show the pictures, I will open it so that we make sure, you know?

UCE: It is a beautiful location. It is an excellent location and... There is no god except Allah. [Pause] By the way, there is also something that I want-, and I have a surprise for you, by the way. I will tell you, but first let us take a look at that.

SUB: Yes. I will open the picture here first. They might have liked when I drew the pictures for them, I entered it in a *program*. I got a picture for the location at night--

UCE: Yes.

SUB: --at night while the tower is illuminated, how it looked, I drew a circle on it and I specified for them that this is the location. I got in the day time as well and I also

specified for them that this is the location, you know? I mean, it was two different pictures and I brought for them a picture for the entire location along with the waterfalls around it.

UCE: The waterfalls which are—, yes.

SUB: The waterfalls which are around it. And a picture by itself for just the main entrance. I told them that I have not entered inside and did research, I mean, to see inside. But, I did the outside research for them--

UCE: And--

SUB: --in general terms.

UCE: And when you entered, did you enter from the main entrance or... I saw that when I dropped you off, that you walked and--

SUB: I walked inside. I entered inside as if-, as if I work over there. I took a look at the elevators and stuff. So, when I looked at the *menu*, it is almost seven stories, you know? So, like you say, the-, the-, the one which is the *parking lot* for the cars underground, the *cafeteria* and the locations up there are all official work locations for the bank. And the main location for the bank, when you enter, which is the *regis counter*--

UCE: Yes.

SUB: --the place where you can get money, open an *account* and stuff is located in the-, in the corner.

UCE: [Coughs] How many people were there?

SUB: Those who work at the *counter* are almost five.

UCE: No, I am talking about the people, about the--

SUB: The people inside?

UCE: Yes.

SUB: There were maybe... just the people inside who are going and coming and who passed by during the minute I was there, maybe 40 people, just going up and down and stuff--

UCE: [UI]

SUB: Yes.

UCE: Thank Allah.

SUB: Yes, those who are up--

UCE: Thank Allah.

SUB: --at the cars' *park*, when I looked down to those who were parked--

UCE: [OV] Yes, when you saw them.

SUB: --there were maybe, I mean, I expect *maybe*--, I expect that I can find out how many people who work there, you know? After research, if I continue to research and research.

UCE: Allah is the best protector. Is this is it or it is different?

SUB: Am-hum.

UCE: [Coughs] In the name of Allah, the Most Gracious, the Most Merciful. Yes, here is the [UI] [Coughs]. But--

SUB: This is *Houston, Dallas*. [Noise - chime]

UCE: I am telling you this location is-, marvelous.

SUB: [OV] It is a great location, aha.

UCE: I am not--, what do you think? So, you see, from your experience since you live here, that-er, that this location is better than any other location, that this is the location you want to, Allah willing, er... are you ready?

SUB: Ready, Allah willing.

UCE: Okay, I want to-er, I mean, when I return I want to know, I mean, so that I can say--, when I deliver the message, the message will be... I mean, because they told me about your message and they... I mean, they were proud of you. At the same time, when I return, I must know to tell them, that... that we are ready. They might tell you at any time, "You have that many hours for the operation." I will get-, I want to say--, this is why I told you--, it is possible that they will bring you the vehicle that you will use. So, I want to tell you, this is... this is the vehicle that you will use. They use... they are the ones who put what... I mean, I do not know what--

SUB: The script.

UCE: --I mean, I do not know. [coughs] When you see me in the vehicle, coming to pick you, Allah willing, we will be-, we will be...er. The location... I am thinking, how many floors is it? Did you see how many floors on the--

SUB: About seven or six. It might be seven or six floors.

UCE: [Coughs] No, there is more than seven or six floors, much more than that. Are you talking about the entire building?

SUB: No, I am talking about the elevator. Maybe er-, *Okay*, no, it is possible... it is possible that it is bigger than that. You know why? Because when I went up, I went up in the glass elevator. I did not go up in the regular elevator.

UCE: Is there, is there--

SUB: There is an elevator... because they are *different*... er, different.

UCE: Yes.

SUB: You know. There is a glass one which is the one in the corner, the one which I took up and down, there are the regular ones. I expect that... that it is bigger than that but I am not sure. I wanted to stay longer inside also but I was--

UCE: Thank Allah. [Coughs]

SUB: I did not want to draw an eye to me or anything while I am looking around.

UCE: But, you went inside the bathroom.

SUB: The bathroom is in a location...er, I expect that it is the suitable location.

UCE: You did not find any other locations... I mean, the bathroom is the site which you... And when... can you put the goods in it, the explosives?

SUB: [OV] It is as if... the location of the bathroom is almost... I should have taken pictures of the bathroom.

UCE: Did you take pictures?

SUB: No, I did not take them. I did not--

UCE: You did not take them, it is not a problem, right.

SUB: Like you say, the sink is here--

UCE: Yes.

SUB: --the door is there, and here is the *toilet*.

UCE: Yes.

SUB: You see? It is a small bathroom, almost from here to there, its dimension. This is the thing for the humidity, the... you know the square thing.

UCE: Yes, yes, yes.

SUB: You see what I mean?

UCE: Yes.

SUB: I stood on the *toilet*, I lifted it up and looked, I put my head inside and looked. So, like you say, it is an underground building and there is the *air conditions* all that stuff, you see?

UCE: How many? How many of this thing, the *toilet* were there? How many... how many were there in the bathroom? I mean, is the bathroom small or--?

SUB: One.

UCE: Just a single bathroom?

SUB: Yes.

UCE: I mean, for one person.

SUB: It is a bathroom for one person. He goes inside, locks the door, *that's it*.

UCE: You are alone.

SUB: I am alone. I lock the door, I plant it inside, I put it, I hide it, I go out as if there is nothing.

UCE: There is nobody else in the bathroom or--?

SUB: There is nobody.

UCE: [Coughs] And when you... Okay, by Allah, this is good. It is a great idea.

SUB: You see?

UCE: This way nobody will be there or something.

SUB: Nobody will be there.

UCE: And how far is it from the... from the *cafeteria*?

SUB: About--

UCE: [UI]

SUB: --let us say, maybe about 15 seconds [noise].

UCE: Fifteen?

SUB: Fifteen seconds until you reach the [UI]

UCE: *It is a goo--*, I mean--

SUB: You walk in a curved way, to the elevator--

UCE: Yes.

SUB: --the bathroom, *I mean*, the elevator, the *cafeteria*, the *parking lot* for the cars and you walk in a... in a *loop* in the building, you see? There is another *cafeteria*, the bathroom, *women's and men's restroom*.

UCE: Do you have a pen or not? Here is the pen, it fell. There is no god except Allah. Give me the pen. Draw for me... I mean, you entered inside.

SUB: I-, I-, I entered inside the... you mean underground?

UCE: Yes. When you entered... when you entered the bathroom, I mean, the bathroom, draw the bathroom for me, where it is, tell me, explain to me.

SUB: Okay, I-, I-, I went down by the elevator to the *cafeteria*. This is the building, over here this the car *parking lot*, you can see it from under, the bathroom, the cars are underground--

UCE: Yes.

SUB: I went down by the elevator. The *cafeteria* is over there, the elevators opens to the *cafeteria* door. There is a *Chinese cafeteria* on the other side--

UCE: Ah-um.

SUB: --and there are locations, like glass places where people work inside, all of them, you see? All of them work inside and the bathroom from the back, continuing with the *loop* on the inside--

UCE: Yes.

SUB: There is the *women* and there is the *men*.

UCE: By itself, standing alone.

SUB: Stand alone. There is a door here and a door there. Over there also, there are offices--

UCE: Okay.

SUB: --the rest of the *loop* on the inside. And it is closed inside. I mean, there is no way. I mean, if you go from here, you leave from there. There is no way to go out of here.

UCE: And this is the er--

SUB: Hmm.

UCE: --a place to park the cars, the *garage*.

SUB: The *garage*.

UCE: And this... and this is offices.

SUB: Offices.

UCE: And this is the *cafeteria*?

SUB: This is the *cafeteria*.

UCE: Ok, it is very close. And the-, the-, the-, the men's bathroom is cl-, close to it more than the women's bathroom.

SUB: Like you say, see, I will explain the picture to you exactly. Let us say this the *right*--

UCE: Yes.

SUB: --this is... this is a complete *loop*. The *cafeteria* is one way. The bathroom, like you say, are over here, you see?

UCE: Right, right, I got it, I understand you.

SUB: So, over here is closed, all of that is closed here, you just walk in the *loop*, the bathrooms are just opened from this side. I walk this way, I pass by the bathrooms this way, I return this way, and see the *cafeteria* this way.

UCE: So, the *cafeteria* is close-, very close to the bathroom, you are telling me--

SUB: Yes. *Yeah*, close.

UCE: --and there are people who eat, do stuff and lunch and everything.

SUB: The Chinese *cafeteria* was vacant and this one, like you say, is a *cafe--*, *grocery stores*, I mean, *chips*, chocolate, smoke.

UCE: And does it have a lot of people or--

SUB: [UI]

UCE: --or not a lot of people?

SUB: There is not a lot of people, but there is lot of people in the offices--

UCE: Okay.

SUB: --in the offices themselves.

UCE: Are you ready for the surprise?

SUB: Allah willing. O Protector!

UCE: [Laughs] Er--

SUB: Surprises, I mean--

UCE: It is a surprise that you will like, Allah willing, Allah willing. Er... it is a good building, I am happy, er--

SUB: Allah willing, you will--

UCE: [OV] I am proud of you, Allah willing. I mean--

SUB: May Allah keep you.

UCE: May Allah keep you. Hold on with me for a second.

SUB: Take your time.

UCE: No, no, stay. [Sighs] [clears throat] [Pause] I will ask you a question.

SUB: Yes.

UCE: If you want to send, er-, a message to the Shaykh and our Commander.

SUB: I will send to him.

UCE: Would you send him a message?

SUB: Right away, video message?

UCE: A video message which will take a while to reach him.

SUB: Yes.

UCE: That is why I say I want you to send him a message today. By the time it gets to him, it will take weeks. By the time it is delivered, we would have done what we have done, Allah willing.

SUB: Alright.

UCE: Er... this will be a private message--

SUB: To the Commander.

UCE: --from you to the Commander. I can not tell you what to tell him, or what you will... I will not-er, I mean, will not-er, I will not advise you, it will be from you to him. Er, I will leave you alone. I want you to- to think about it. I will show you how to do this thing and, Allah willing, I say it will two to three weeks to be with him, Allah willing. But, it is very important that no one see your face at all.

SUB: My face.

UCE: So, you-, yes, just you. I mean, do you know how to wrap or not?

SUB: No, I do not know how to wrap [laughs].

UCE: What? Wrap it so that no one will see-- would see-- nobody will see you at all and the bathroom is over there--

SUB: I do not-, I do not know what to say.

UCE: Whatever you want. Take--take your time. I want you to think about it, and I tell you that this is a surprise because this will reach him. He will-- he will see it himself.

SUB: Alright, Allah willing.

UCE: But it will take, like I told you--

SUB: It will take time.

UCE: --yes, because it is... it is not easily that I will send it--

SUB: It takes a long time.

UCE: --yes. So, I want you to think, you at your ease. And, I will come back when you are ready. I will set it up for you. Whatever you want to say, say it to the Commander and the broth--, all of our brothers and all--

SUB: Alright, Allah willing.

UCE: Allah willing. So, you take you time. Say whatever you want to say and--, I will be back in a little bit. Do you- do you know how to do a *video* or not?

SUB: Er, by Allah, it depends on what type.

UCE: I will-, I will help on this one.

SUB: [UI]

UCE: Hold on, hold on. In the name of Allah, the Most Gracious-- [Chime] Exactly, Alright. All you do-- I will-- I will press the button-- I will press on it if you want, I mean, it is not a problem. But, I mean, before you do it, I want you to take your time because this--

SUB: [OV] On the camera.

UCE: --it is--I want to tell you something, this is one message.

SUB: One message.

UCE: --it is not-- you see?

SUB: It is one message.

UCE: --so, you take--you take your time and... think about what you want to do. If you want to write it, write it. If you want to--to think about it, take your time. I do not want to bother you. I will be with you here for whatever you need.

SUB: *Okay.*

UCE: What do you think?

SUB: It is a very nice idea. What came--

UCE: It is not--

SUB: --it occurred to me that it might be like that. But--I mean, it is one of the most beautiful... but I am not ready for it.

UCE: Take time. That is why I am telling you to take your time. If you want to take an hour, take your time. It is one message and, Allah willing, it will reach him--

SUB: [OV] But, you know, it is not an opportunity for anyone.

UCE: This is your opportunity now. I mean, I am telling you now--er, you are--

SUB: This is a great opportunity.

UCE: And I want to tell you, may Allah... take your time, take your time. [UI] Do you want tea? Do you want something?

SUB: Nothing. I am good.

UCE: Take your time, take your time. I know that I surprised you.

SUB: You surprised me [laughs].

UCE: Huh? But, I am telling you--er, I mean, this is the truth, Allah willing, it will be with him in two to three weeks, Allah willing. [Coughs]

[Pause] [Noise]

UCE: In the name of Allah, the Most Gracious, Most Merciful. There is no god except Allah. [Pause] Ah, there is no god except Allah. I do not trouble you or anything. I just want to tell you that it is not going to be more than--er between five and ten minutes--er, I mean, [UI], yes because--

SUB: The best message will be--

UCE: I am telling you--

SUB: --after the success, you see?

UCE: I will give you-- Allah willing, by the time it reaches him, we will be successful, Allah permitting, Allah permitting. But, I just-- because of the time and because of the-- it will leave from here and it will go places, it will not reach him directly. It will take time [beeps] I am telling you two to three weeks but it could be--

SUB: More.

UCE: --more. So--, because it is all different depending on the--

SUB: Normal.

UCE: --exactly and depending on the... if there are any problems or there anything, if there are spies or something. So... er, Allah willing.

SUB: So, this one will be delivered after the success, Allah willing.

UCE: Allah willing, Allah permitting.

SUB: So, I mean, it will be, the message will be after the success.

UCE: Allah permitting. It will be the success and-- and-- it will reach him and I am not-- I mean, it is not my decision. I am telling you, it will reach him in a time when he sees it, it will be successful.

SUB: Yes.

UCE: I mean, it will not--, it will not reach him before, it will be--

SUB: yes.

UCE: --will be almost at the same time.

SUB: Alright, Allah willing.

UCE: Allah permitting. Allah permitting.

[Pause]

UCE: In the name of Allah, Most Gracious, Most Merciful. There is no god but Allah. [Noise] [coughing] There is no god but Allah, there is no god but Allah. [Computer noise] O Allah. [Sneezing] Thank Allah.

SUB: I am preparing a work, Allah willing.

UCE: Prepare what you-- I am-- you are here at your ease. [chime]

SUB: What do you think the start should be? Er--

UCE: I tell you something.

SUB: Yes.

UCE: If I try to tell you anything-- this is between you and him.

SUB: Hmm.

UCE: This is between you and him. Whatever you find in your heart and your mind, tell him. I can not tell you what to tell him.

SUB: Yes. I understand you.

UCE: You--you yourself, but, the most important thing is be careful not to let anyone see any part of--of your face at all. I mean, this is--this is--

SUB: No mentioning of names or nothing. Just a message--

UCE: A message of what you want to do, what you see-- I will leave you at your ease. I mean, you--you, I mean-er.

SUB: I mean, should--should the message be regarding the operation, for instance, or just [UI], I mean--

UCE: What you--, what--er, I will not--I mean, like I am telling you, it is... it is... I can not, I mean, I can not tell you. You--you-- whatever you want to do. If you want to-speak, *I mean*, it is going to him, the Commander only. Allah permitting, Allah permitting.' [Coughing] There is no god but Allah.[Pause] [noise] There is no god but Allah. There is no god but Allah. There is no god but Allah.

[Pause] [Phone noise]

UF: [UI]

UCE: *Yes Ma'am. Do you all deliver food?*

UF: [UI]

UCE: *Yeah.*

UF: *No.*

UCE: *Okay, thank you. There is no god but Allah. [Noise] [Sighs] [Sneezes] There is no god but Allah.*

[Television noise]

UCE: Do you need anything? Coffee, tea?

SUB: I am writing the... letter.

UCE: I am telling you, I am here, do you want tea, coffee?

SUB: Ah, no. May Allah keep you.

UCE: Just tell me. I will...[UI] Allah willing, we will go to eat in a little bit.

SUB: [UI] but I did not expect it to be that soon.

UCE: Soon, I mean--

SUB: Allah willing, I will not--

UCE: No, take your time, take your time, as much as you like. Er...

SUB: I wrote a good speech [UI]

UCE: Between five and ten minutes like I told you so that... so that... er.

[Pause] [Background/television noise].

SUB: I am almost finished.

UCE: What?

SUB: I am almost finished.

UCE: No, no, no. Take your time.

[Background noise] [Water running] [vacuuming sound]

UCE: Ah, yes. She is... [Pause] [Background/television noise].

[Subject practices speech in whisper]

UCE: How are you doing?

SUB: I think I am ready.

UCE: Are you ready? That belt-- yes, do not--

SUB: I will [UI]--

UCE: Yeah, take all the-- You will wrap the...

SUB: I will wrap it.

UCE: You want the... what happened to the lights here?

SUB: I am going to wrap the red with the white.

UCE: What? Wrap- wrap-- or er, or I will tell you something-- You want--

SUB: You have a way?

UCE: [UI] the best. Whatever you want. [UI] I just do not want anything [UI]

SUB: Okay, Alright. I have never wrapped, I mean... good before. I do not know. But... [UI]

UCE: [UI] I will tell you, I will tell you--

SUB: Do you know how to wrap?

UCE: What? Yes, but I do not want to.. You put it...I mean, put it on and...exactly like this [UI]

SUB: Like this?

UCE: Wait a little, like this, exactly...yeah, from the right side and the left, yeah, so that nobody knows. Exactly. Leave it. Do you want to see? [noise] What is she doing? Wait here.

SUB: Yes.

UCE: Oh, she is vacuuming outside.

SUB: It's not a problem.

UCE: She is vacuuming outside.

SUB: Okay.

UCE: In the name of Allah, Most Gracious, Most Merciful. In the name of Allah, Most Gracious, Most Merciful. [Chime] In the name of Allah, Most Gracious, Most Merciful. What? You do not know how to wrap it?

SUB: I am putting them on top of each other.

UCE: Whatever you want, but it is not the--the--the--the-- I mean the most important thing...as I am telling you, I am just trying to--

SUB: Yeah...because the white is for the Palestinians and the red is for the Jordanians, so I will put both of them, so that there will be...there won't be any discrimination, by the way.

UCE: No there isn't. The most important is that nobody will know you--

SUB: Okay.

UCE: --are you paying attention? He will know who you are, but nobody else will know.

SUB: Fine. Allah willing.

UCE: It's nice this way, very nice. What you did is good so that nothing of what you are wearing or anything will show. It is good. Truly it is good.

SUB: It is possible that one is dressed with white and it is possible that someone...

UCE: Exactly.

SUB: What to say...I mean all will be the same.

UCE: With Allah's permission. I'll go lock up the door. Stand up a little...yeah, stand up a little. Do you see anything? Take a look.

SUB: Yeah.

UCE: Exactly. Let me see... so that [UI].yes. Just sit down to see at first if it is correct or not. Then I will leave every- everything so that nobody... [Noise] [UI] somewhere else. This is it. In the name of Allah, Most Gracious, Most Merciful. In the name of Allah, Most Gracious, Most Merciful.

SUB: [UI] I do not know what happened here.

UCE: When you are ready, and I will do it... I will leave you, I will leave the... I will leave the room with Allah's permission.

SUB: But the problem is... not, er, I do not know what happened here... the, er, has shut down.

UCE: But, it is... No problem. Do not, er, do not become nervous, do not tire out your nerves, shut down the device, shut down the device.

SUB: Allah willing, but I do not know what happened.

UCE: About what?

SUB: The, er, has shut down... the screen was shut down.

UCE: Do you think it is the battery?

SUB: I did not bring the *charger*.

UCE: Didn't you bring the *charger*?

SUB: No, by Allah.

UCE: Wait, let us see the *charger* I have... I have the, the.... But I do not know--

SUB: But it is not possible that the battery have run out because I was monitoring it.

UCE: Is the battery new or what?

SUB: *Yeah*. There is no power but in Allah--

UCE: [UI] Is it a different number?

SUB: *Yeah*.

UCE: [UI]

SUB: It has never happened to me.

UCE: Shaykh, take it easy.

SUB: I want to turn it off and on again... everything will be deleted.

UCE: Do not you know how? [UI] Show it to me, let me see it. May Allah facilitate it.

SUB: I do not know, but--

UCE: Do you have it on now?

SUB: *Yeah*.

UCE: I hear it well, I hear it. In the name of Allah, Most Gracious, Most Merciful. It is on.

SUB: The noise from here--

[OV]

UCE: I hear it, I hear it, now, but--

SUB: But I do not know what happened.

UCE: I hear it. Maybe you need to put your prints on it or something?

SUB: *Yeah*, but, er...when it is running, you know?

UCE: It is running, leave it, leave it. May Allah facilitate it, [UI]

SUB: I mean, I left it and went... it did that by itself.

[Noise] [Pause]

UCE: This is a problem, my son, and you, do you need it or...?

SUB: Huh?

UCE: This is a problem, my son, and you, do you need it or...?

SUB: The problem... *yeah*, because of this... I wrote the speech on it.

UCE: You do not have the... It is not a problem or something, we'll go bring the *charger*. We'll go bring the *charger* and return, with Allah's permission.

SUB: Let's see, may be it saved it, Allah willing.

UCE: What?

SUB: Here, it has turned on.

UCE: Has it turned on?

SUB: *Yeah*.

UCE: Then wait, one moment then open it.

SUB: But, Allah willing, it made a *save*, saving.

UCE: Look, I, I...do not... do not worry, do not worry at all about these things. It is working, Thank Allah.

SUB: I mean, praise be to Allah, I did not, did not touch it or anything. I finished, I stood up--

UCE: May Allah facilitate things, with Allah's permission. [UI] run, with Allah's permission. Thank Allah.

SUB: Here, it is turning on, it is not a problem.

UCE: Just do not take too long in the speech because you are, er--  
[OV] [UI]

SUB: It's saving.

UCE: I do not want... yeah. There is no god but Allah, and Muhammad is the Messenger of Allah, O Allah [UI] It is here.

SUB: [UI]

UCE: So that you do not, er... it does not mess up again or something, er--

SUB: I just want to make sure that the speech is there, only, because I did not do.... You can say that all that I wrote has been deleted.

UCE: Deleted? It's not a problem--

SUB: [OV] but I should--

UCE: --we have a long time, it is not a problem.

SUB: --I should have saved it.

UCE: It's not a problem. Allah willing, if you want to go bring the *cord*, we will go bring the *cord*...if you want to stay and write it again, you [UI] If you want to write it with a pen on paper, write it with a pen on paper... it is not a big problem.

SUB: We want... but...if... I want to say if we do it again, you know? [OV] I do not want--

UCE: I have to--

SUB: --take your time also.

UCE: It is not... my time is not a problem, I am traveling at night, [UI] it is not a problem for traveling, but, er--

SUB: Is it better on paper?

UCE: If you like to write it with a pen on paper, you have the paper.

SUB: But the Quranic verses that I had written and things... all of it.

UCE: I know, but not... Allah willing. Er, I want... yeah. You just want to get rid of the guilt.

SUB: I am, like upset [laughs].

UCE: Do not be upset, just sit down, sit down and relax. Er, I will give you a paper, do you have a pen? There is no god but Allah.

SUB: [UI] Uff!

UCE: The pen I have [UI] write down whatever you want to write. It is up to you, take your time [UI]. If you want to, er... Take the time that you need.

SUB: Allah willing, that is it. This time I will write a quick one.

UCE: I am telling you, take five minutes... whatever you want, I mean do not... do not stress yourself out. But, I mean, the message is very important, [UI] I mean, it will reach it with Allah's permission, so, er--

SUB: [OV] But I wrote--

UCE: --take your time.

SUB: --a short and nice message, but--

UCE: Take your time.

[Pause]

[Door knocking]

UF: *Housekeeping.*

[Door knocking]

UCE: *Can I help you?*

UF: *Er, clean the room?*

UCE: *No, thank you.*

UF: *No, nothing?*

UCE: *No.*

[Pause]

SUB: [Mumbles] [Clears throat] My brother Hussein.

UCE: Yes, my dear.

SUB: I- I have an idea.

UCE: Go ahead.

SUB: I, Allah willing, I mean, I will use the verses, I wrote them.

UCE: [UI][OV]

SUB: I will do, [UI], I have not decided but that I would just say-- talk quickly to the Commander.

UCE: It--

SUB: I expect that-- [OV]

UCE: --it is a message from you to him, so what you-

SUB: *Yeah.*

UCE: --what you-- like I told you--

SUB: So--

UCE: --it will get to him, Allah willing--

SUB: *Yeah.*

UCE: --and... exactly what... I can not tell you the- the- the day exactly [UI], but it will get to him, Allah willing, soon. I mean, I say it will take a few... weeks, and because-- So... what- whatever you-- whatever you--

SUB: Yes.

UCE: Whatever you like.

SUB: I do not want now to write a speech and such, So I am telling you--

UCE: Say what you want to say, whatever you want to say, say it. What you-- Whatever you want to say-- But er, and, er, even remove the belt, if you want. That's it, exactly. Whatever you want.

SUB: That is it, *okay.*

UCE: We do not want anything to show... Wait let me do the phone.  
[Noise]

SUB: You will do... yeah.

UCE: The... is not working at all, er--?

SUB: Yes--

UCE: --the *computer*.

SUB: --no, it is working.

UCE: But, it is not- not- [OV][UI]

SUB: I shut it down.

UCE: Right. Right. Right.  
[Noise]

UCE: This is a message from you to him, my- my brother, I mean, so I will not stay--  
[OV]

SUB: Of course, *yeah*.  
[Noise]

UCE: --so it will be, I mean, er.

SUB: And if you want to stay, it is alright, I mean, [noise], I do not mind.

UCE: I know, but... this is your day and this is your message. Allah willing, with Allah's permission. Eh... may Allah facilitate [clears throat].

SUB: [UI] like this.

UCE: Let me turn off the television.

SUB: In the name of Allah, Most Gracious, Most Merciful. Peace be upon you, and Allah's mercy and blessing. I seek refuge in Allah from the cursed devil. "Those who believe fight in the cause of Evil...in the cause of Allah and those who reject Faith Fight in the cause of Evil: So they fought. So fight ye against the friends of

Satan: feeble indeed is the cunning of Satan." Brother Hussein! My brother Hussein. Can we redo it?

UCE: Yeah.

SUB: Because...

UCE: Of course.

SUB: I messed up in the line because I did not see.

UCE: Er- er- [noise] It is very important [UI] do not worry, er, calm down, this is, I mean, your beloved--

SUB: Allah willing.

UCE: --your beloved. Take your time, and take.... Are you ready?

SUB: Yeah.

UCE: In the name of Allah, Most Gracious, Most Merciful. [beep] In the name of Allah, Most Gracious, Most Merciful.

SUB: Peace be upon you, and Allah's mercy and blessing. I take refuge in Allah from the cursed devil. In the name of Allah, Most Gracious, Most Merciful. "Those who believe fight in the cause of Allah, and those who disbelieve fight in the cause of the Evil One. Fight ye therefore, against the friends of Satan; surely Satan's strategy is weak." Allah says the truth. So from here, O the Commander Shaykh, my master. Usama Bin Laden. [pause] We, here-- I am from the sons of Jordan, from the countries of the Levant. I declare to you the loyalty, and I apologize for my nation, the nation of Jordan. For- for evil has spread... Tsk. I seek the forgiveness of Allah. Brother Hussein. [Noise] By Allah, I do not know.

UCE: What happened? What is going on?

SUB: I do not know, er... [noise]

UCE: Take it easy, take it easy.

SUB: You do not want to make it another time, or... in which I can be ready--

UCE: Do you want to stop by and bring the--

SUB: I am unable to read because, like you say, I get distracted. Because after I wrote the speech, I was upset. Like, er, it was deleted.

UCE: I know. Do you want to... I take- I take you to the house and you rewrite it, and- and you want to return, as you like. I mean, as you like. If you like for me to take you, you rest for a little bit, and write it, and I would stop by at night.

SUB: If you want such...

UCE: What- what do you think?

SUB: By Allah, it would be better, but I do not want to--

UCE: I- I-

SUB: [OV][UI]

UCE: I am coming, I am telling you, for you. I am- I am your horse and do not worry at all. What do you think? If I take you now to... to the house, you write what you... what you want to write. I would return after... you will take an hour, for example.

SUB: Alright.

UCE: What do you think? [noise] An hour, take an hour to prepare, and I come to you, and after that... we go ahead, with Allah's permission. What do you think?

SUB: Allah willing.

[Noise]

UCE: An hour would be good for you?

SUB: [Noise] *Yeah*. Allah willing.

UCE: Come, let us go [UI] now.

SUB: Like you say, my brother, I do not know... I became upset.

UCE: Do not worry, and do not worry, do not worry. You put the... you can not... do the... take it now, and after that make the video, Allah willing.

SUB: Alright.

UCE: I will throw away all this, do not worry about this place whatsoever. I will- will- burn it.

SUB: Allah willing.

[Noise]

SUB: Because it is full of Quran, do you have a way to--?

UCE: I will burn- I will burn it. Give it to me. [noise] What do you think?

[OV]

SUB: Yeah, it is better.

UCE: By the time we go back home, it will be 5:30. I will stop by you at 7:00.

SUB: Yeah, that is good.

UCE: This is good for you?

SUB: *Yeah.*

UCE: Thanks to Allah. Thanks to Allah. [UI]

SUB: Er, say I do not want... I do not want the message to be like--

UCE: I know.

SUB: ...it has--

UCE: I understand, I understand you, from the- I understand. [noise] [UI] the cigarette box, where is the cigarette box? There it is...and we will rely on Allah. I will tell you what I am going to do. I will go, drop you off at the house--

SUB: *Yeah.*

UCE: --and go back to get some... something, food or something. And when I stop by you, you eat, and then, with Allah's permission, we--

SUB: What do you want?

UCE: Get you food so that you eat, also.

SUB: No, I have--

[OV][UI]

UCE: --so that no one... I know but because... [UI] Let me have this so that--

SUB: [UI] Well, what do you think about, for instance, we do it, and that's it, you eat at my place, or...

UCE: You fini- You-- I want to- I want you to-- I want to leave you free--

SUB: [OV][UI]

UCE: I-- what do you think, I will tell you something. I will drop you off in the house, and call you an hour later. And see--

SUB: Alright.

UCE: And see how it is going. An hour, an hour and a half, you would have finished, and I will come back.

SUB: Alright. Allah willing.

UCE: Let's go my dear.

[Noise]

UCE: Would like-- do you want me to bring with me-- do you want--?

SUB: Nothing.

UCE: Are you sure?

[Noise] [UI]

[UCE and Subject exit the room - no audio from the hotel room to the car.]

UCE: Come on Pasha. I know that you are--

SUB: In the name of God [UI]. By God, my brother I did not [UI].

UCE: That you are, er, er, you are a little flustered [noise - car starting], but, do not worry, do not worry. It is all by the will of Allah, it is all by the will of Allah. [Pause] [UI] Do you know how we are going?

SUB: Yes, on *35 south*. [Pause] Now go this way, here.

UCE: Now we go this way, but I do not know [UI].

SUB: [UI]

UCE: Let me tell you, er... What do you think, is your English good?

SUB: English, er, I mean, somewhat.

UCE: I mean, can you, er? I am speaking like this so that, I mean, if [entering GPS address]... Wait here let me see... In the name of Allah. *Italy, Texas, Italia* [PH]. I mean, if, a little--a little... Can you speak English--can you speak English?

SUB: Yes. [UI] [GPS giving directions]. Do you want that I do something in English?

UCE: Basically.... No, I mean, if you want--want to say it...do you want... do you think it will be... but of course he wants it in Arabic, I mean.

SUB: Of course, not, er--

UCE: [UI]

SUB: --I will not send the letter in English [Laughs].

UCE: No, not possible, not possible, no--no--no--no, I am talking basically that the message which... is not for... not to [UI]. to the... [GPS giving direction], to the...

SUB: After the...

UCE: If you want to send something, for example, something to the *news* or something.

SUB: *Yeah*, I am telling you, [OV] yeah to the *news*, I understand you. [UI]

[GPS gives directions]

UCE: Can you write to the news? [UI] I will tell you something, let us go [UI]--.

SUB: *Yeah*.

UCE: --[UI] Is your computer working normally now?

SUB: Yes, almost, somewhat.

UCE: Do you like to--to go back to the hotel. Or do you what to go back home for a little bit? Whatever you want.

SUB: Er....

UCE: Or do you want me to leave the *charger* and everything with you?

SUB: By God, whatever makes you comfortable; it does not make a difference to me.

UCE: No--no, it makes no difference with me. Whatever you want.

SUB: Er, what is the story, are we going back to, er...?

UCE: Yes, because I do not want anybody to know [UI] I do not want to stay long at your place.

SUB: Yes, correct.

UCE: Of course. So, whatever you want.

SUB: I do not want you to go and come back again and go [OV] and come back again.

UCE: I will go and wait for you, and after that, you call me or I will call you in an hour.

SUB: That's it.

UCE: What do you think, so that you take your time. And I was supposed to say...I mean that I, I did not like to tell you, I thought to surprise you. [UI]

SUB: It is a very nice surprise, by God.

UCE: Yes, yes, are you paying attention? On the basis that it is... on the basis that I surprise you with the, er --

SUB: But I did not expect it to be voice and picture, so, er, because it is like you say, one does not know what he wants to... from where he wants to s- start.

UCE: Be comfortable and take your time and Allah willing He will ease for us, for you, Allah permitting. [pause] [GPS giving directions]. Er, [UI] it will be half an hour before we arrive. [UI] [pause] [GPS giving directions] Do not worry, I know that the time is near, and I know that you are, er, a little worried, but I mean....

SUB: No, I am not worried, but like you say, because I did not prepare for this...

UCE: And that is why I am going to take you to your home to be at your comfort and such, but I mean waiting for the message, [UI] go to someone else message [UI] someone [UI] country [UI] and you know...

SUB: Yes I understand.

UCE: So be comfortable, take your time. I will ride my vehicle and go. Do not worry. With Allah's permission it will reach him, with Allah's permission it will reach him.

SUB: [UI] We must also prepare another one in, er, prepare another one in English after the operation.

UCE: But English after the operation is not -- is not [UI].

SUB: For the American people.

UCE [UI] At the same time, I do not want you to do anything I want to tell you, I mean, as I told you the first time I met you and until today. I am willing and happy to do it--

SUB: May you be safe.

UCE: --I am at your service for anything, don't worry, do whatever you want to do.

SUB: [UI]

UCE: Rely on Allah.

[Pause]

UCE: It is ten till five, we get up at night, and we drive at night better than driving [UI].

SUB: Did you sleep good or-?

UCE: Okay, I, I will... I just I do not want you to be anxious.

SUB: It is because of you.

UCE: What?

SUB: It is because of you.

UCE: I- thank Allah, I am--

SUB: It is just that I feel that I troubled you.

UCE: And you did not do, on the contrary, I am happy, I, I am comfortable and I will tell you why.... Thank Allah, thank Allah, thank Allah. For your information, I am happy and comfortable--

SUB: [UI]

UCE: --I mean if you were not a little anxious and feel the pressure on you, that it will reach him, the Shaykh- So, I want you, I want you to know that our Lord- Allah, blessed His name, knows what is hidden, and knows- On the contrary, I am very comfortable that I got to know you. I mean, if you just say two or three words and that is, I will feel that your heart, your heart is in it, your heart is in this thing and that is why you want to succeed. I just want you to calm down in Allah. In English they say, "*relax*" and nothing will happen, Allah willing.

SUB: Allah willing, when I prepare it I will try to prepare it by myself?

UCE: Whatever- I mean, whatever you feel. If you can read English good, it is up to you. If you want to-- We just want to--, because it will take time. That is it. What time are you working tomorrow?

SUB: Allah willing, at 2 o'clock.

UCE: [UI] I am telling you, if you rely on Allah, Allah willing. [UI] Rely on Allah and [UI] and if I have to leave at night, I will leave at night, because it is better for me, for my work.

SUB: Why don't you sleep in until the morning?

UCE: I must like you say... I must be at, be at... at a specific day.

SUB: Do you have many appointments?

UCE: Not appointments, no. And I know, I mean [UI], I mean, it could be at anytime, like when the operation is going to happen, and it is possible that one will be [UI] and that's why...

SUB: Correct, I understand.

UCE: Now I do not have any, how do I tell you exactly, I mean, my time is not at all my time. My time is for you, that I, whatever you want, you need, so we can do it safely Allah permitting. So, I do not own myself. Therefore, do not worry at all and do not trouble yourself, that you are depending on me, that you will travel and stuff. There is nothing to that.

SUB: [UI]

UCE: Because [GPS giving direction] I mean, I must be at a completely different, specified state, in a different time. When I arrive, I will give them what I have and I will tell them--

SUB: Allah willing.

UCE: Allah willing, I will give them the whole speech. Afterwards, I will--, afterwards, I will-- [GPS giving direction] Afterwards [UI], I will sleep in Paradise, Allah willing.

SUB: Allah willing, all of us.

UCE: Allah permitting.

[Pause]

UCE: There is the building.

SUB: There is the building.

UCE: And it looks new also.

SUB: It is still, like you say, the most beautiful one of them.

UCE: Exactly... and it... because of its *decor*.

SUB: Yeah. Truly I think I might be wrong, it is not possible to be seven stories. It possibly has more than 20 stories.

UCE: Yes, yes, not.

SUB: But, it is, the place I entered is not--is not, the elevators, like, not, they were *transit*, [pause] these pictures, shall I send them to the group? During this period?

UCE: By God, I am not able to... I mean, whatever you want to... according to your arrangement with them, er, I, I mean, my mission is different, as you know, [GPS giving directions] my orders are different. So, er, that he... what they told you, whatever you see [UI] do it. The important question... I know that you said a little while ago, and I know that you were, I am telling you I am comfortable and happy that you said that. This comforts me--

SUB: [UI]

[GPS giving directions]

UCE: --it s-s-says that you are truly, er, this is very important to you, and you do not want to... But the important question- are you ready, mister?

SUB: By Allah, thank Allah, Allah willing

UCE: Are you ready? Thanks to Allah.

SUB: Ready, thank Allah.

UCE: Thank Allah. *Keep left* [UI] That is it, Allah permitting, if you just... [GPS giving directions]

SUB: Like you say, time it is not in one's hand, but when someone does something in the path of Allah, there is no time.

UCE: No, no. [UI]

SUB: Everyday, there are people dying... children; does anyone know about their time? Nobody knows.

UCE: Your talk is correct.

SUB: Like you say, the time, as far as the- all the world are concerned, is not important.

UCE: You are working tomorrow... from 2 till when? 10 at night?

SUB: Till 10 at night.

UCE: I want to talk to you about [UI], but you can not answer the phone? Or are you...

SUB: Yeah. Sometimes I can answer the phone...

UCE: Sometimes

SUB: But, like you say, I go outside--

UCE: Correct.

SUB: --so that [GPS giving directions] [UI] Sometimes, for instance, I have someone, do a cover for me, like you say, a *cover*.

UCE: Right, right.

SUB: But sometimes I am alone, when I am *busy*; I cannot leave and go out. But if you call me and I do not answer, I will call you, I mean, within 15 minutes later.

UCE: And I understand, and do not wo-wor-wo. I mean, I do not want you to... especially now, I mean...we now...we are now in a [UI] time, I do not want you to feel, that you are suffocated and that it is your duty, an it is not your duty. I understand what you said and you are my brother, but, er, the most important thing now... Do not worry at all...the issue of sleeping and traveling. All is in its due time Allah permitting. [Pause] We are going the right way, correct?

SUB: Yes, but it looks like there is a lot of traffic.

UCE: It is nothing. [GPS giving directions]

[Pause]

SUB: Do you want to hear something nice?

UCE: Let me hear something nice. [Pause] I am going the right way, right?

SUB: Yes. [GPS giving directions]

[SUB opens laptop and types] [Pause]

UCE: What are you going to show me, Allah willing? What do you have going on?

SUB: I do not have anything going on, by Allah.

UCE: It is as the only thing I have going on, is you.

SUB: By Allah, I am troubled only for you honestly.

UCE: By Allah, I am not troubled, by Allah, but, er, by Allah, by the mercy of my father.

SUB: I know may Allah keep you.

UCE: I am telling you the truth.

SUB: But like you say, one stays troubled within himself.

UCE: Allah willing. [UI]

SUB: [UI] Allah willing, we will fast while we are happy.

UCE: Allah permitting. [Pause] What will you have me listen to?

SUB: I will have you listen to, like, Islamic chants.

UCE: [UI]

SUB: But, they very beautiful chants.

[Noise - traffic]

UCE: [UI] [GPS giving directions]

[Music - chant playing]

UCE: [UI]

SUB: [UI]

UCE: [Pause] [Noise - background music] Now as you know, in Palestine now, the streets are named in the...

SUB: Uh-uh. There are no Arabic.

UCE: There is no god but Allah.

SUB: Even they want to hide the names because they want to isolate... whoever wants to come, so they wouldn't know what the name of the city was, hide the history. But this is the end, I mean, it does not remain--

UCE: Yes.

SUB: I mean, it is close. Israel will no longer be. I mean, something will happen which will change everything.

[Pause] [Noise - chant playing]

UCE: [UI] This operation [UI] is safe and [UI].

SUB: Allah willing.

UCE: [UI] about one hour.

SUB: [UI]

UCE: [UI] The police is stopping everybody.

[Noise - chant playing]

UCE: That's why this more comfortable for you, so you would stay at home. [UI] would be more comfortable for you.

SUB: Allah willing.

UCE: Because I don't want you [UI] I mean, what is this? The police is everywhere.

SUB: [UI]

UCE: Yes, so that they go and kill us.

SUB: But, I believe they withdrew the soldiers from Iraq. Or is it merely advertisements?

UCE: It is all the same, that is it.

SUB: [UI] The same thing.

UCE: Yes, it is possible that three hundred here or two hundred here. Once the Al-Jazeera was doing [UI].

SUB: Yes, they shut down-- they shut down Al-Jazeera in the Bank.

UCE: They shut it down over there?

SUB: Yes. The dog, Abbas because it is--, because it is, Al-Jazeera had a program with one of the Palestinian officials saying that Abbas and his aides they were... trying to assassinate the previous president who is... 'Arafat.

UCE: Yes.

SUB: They were trying to assassinate him for the benefit of Israel. And they shut down Al-Jazeera for the benefit of Israel because Israel, like you say, had problems with Al-Jazeera because Al-Jazeera is [UI].

UCE: Hmm.

SUB: So, I mean, an order came from Israel to Abbas to shut Al-Jazeera down.

UCE: [UI]

SUB: Now, Fatah and Hamas, Allah willing, they will unite.

UCE: Abbas, he is a Jew, I mean.

SUB: A Jew. But, I mean, a regular Jew might be a little more merciful. It is like he sold his country.

UCE: Sold it.

SUB: A Jew does not sell his country.

UCE: Pay attention that he is not--

SUB: [UI]

UCE: What?

SUB: I mean, I am telling you that, for a Jew, he is robbed his homeland and is not selling it.

UCE: And he himself is, like you say, he does not know how to walk around without having--what you call it, the *checkpoints*. He is supposed to [UI].

SUB: He is merely a dog. Merely a dog. He found someone to listen to him. Watch the television stations that air.

UCE: True.

SUB: You will find that Hamas marches [UI] Hamas [UI].

UCE: Did you rest a little bit now? Are your nerves? Calm down a bit.

SUB: Ah, yes. I rested a bit.

UCE: Yes, yes.

SUB: Because it is like you say, after I wrote it down, I do not know what happened.

UCE: What happened to it that...

SUB: By Allah, I do not know, it did like *shut down for the screen*. It is like it did like, *screen-screen saver*. I do not know what it did not work again-now it worked again, you know, it is destiny.

UCE: Do you know how to do a *save* or not?

SUB: Yes, I do.

UCE: [UI] We are very close now by the way. Do you want a cigarette?

SUB: No, I do not want.

UCE: You have it?

SUB: Yes.

UCE: If you want to smoke one, go ahead. If you want to smoke a cigarette.

SUB: It is okay to smoke?

UCE: I do smoke.

SUB: I did not use to smoke but now, like you say, I smoke lightly.

UCE: Do you have... do you have a lighter?

SUB: [UI]

UCE: [UI] Here you go. Smoke a cigarette and clear your mind a bit.

SUB: [UI] I would have liked to invite you for lunch or dinner or... [UI]

UCE: By Allah, I know. [UI]

SUB: [UI]

UCE: By Allah, I know, but I will tell you now, and very unfortunately, my time is not mine.

SUB: I understand, by Allah.

UCE: So...

SUB: Every...

UCE: All my time is... and our concentration is on the operation. But you think that this bathroom is the best place?

SUB: This bathroom will be, I mean, a very suitable one. The most suitable one, I mean. [UI] Praised be Allah, it is not--[UI] Allah willing, if you want to go back to Dallas?

UCE: I will go- I will [UI] I just want you to smoke this [UI], [UI] your thoughts, [UI] I want to tell you that this message is very important. One day, it might be in front of the...

SUB: In front of all the people.

UCE: The world yes. So, take your time, and I will [UI] I am at your service. I mean, calm down, drink a cup of tea or something like that and I will try to-- [UI] We should arrive around 5:30.

SUB: If you do not want to return to Dallas, I can [UI]

UCE: As you please, as you please. Do not worry about me at all, do not worry about me at all. You are [UI].

SUB: There is nothing anymore at my end, thank Allah.

UCE: No!

SUB: But, er... to be on the safe side, caution is always a must.

UCE: [UI]

SUB: Like you say [UI].

UCE: [UI]

SUB: Everybody's safety is [UI].

UCE: What is it? Three, eight... three, eight, six? This *exit*?

SUB: Three, eight, six.

UCE: Allah willing, you prefer me to drop you at the store? Or at the house?

SUB: Allah willing at the house.

UCE: [UI]

SUB: At the store [UI] likes to take me home.

UCE: I will drop you a little further and [UI] not a problem, I will walk a little.

SUB: I walked yesterday [UI].

UCE: Yes [UI].

UCE: The weather [UI] 97 [UI].

SUB: Is it 97?

UCE: Yes [UI].

SUB: By Allah, the group told me to do a message or something? So I said, Allah willing, that the message will be after the operation. But, like you said it will take time until it reaches and the operation will be--

UCE: This message will be sent to him, Allah permitting--

SUB: In the time of--

UCE: --on the day of the operation.

SUB: On the day of the operation.

UCE: After that--

SUB: He will be--

UCE: --it will be up to his wisdom. He is the commander; if he wants to release it, he'll release it, if he wants -- He- he- it is his decision, it is his decision. It is the decision which is--

SUB: Of course, it will be okay if I said in the *message*, for instance, "we are al-Qa'ida soldiers from America" and stuff like that.

UCE: He is the commander.

[Pause]

SUB: I mean, the opportunities that I imagined that I will do but like you say, it is the first time I do it. Therefore--

UCE: I know, that's why I was--

SUB: [UI]

UCE: I know. And I am saying I am at your service. If you did not become anxious, it will be, I mean, er--

SUB: I see what you are saying.

UCE: --you must be. Exactly. I mean, in the operation and everything. But, he is the commander. Therefore, I mean, you must be a little bit *nervous*. And it is your right and I will be with you in order to--

SUB: I mean, between you and me, if I were sending it to our king, 'Abdallah, it will not, it will not, it will not, I mean, I will not be like what I am.

UCE: Exactly.

SUB: But, it is because his status is higher, while this guy, this dog, has no status, the guy who is asleep in the [UI]. Just a human being [UI].

[Pause]

UCE: [UI]

SUB: You keep going at your pace. [Pause] You might even notice that I have a new problem.

UCE: Yes.

SUB: I work among Americans all the time. Like you say, my language, the language I used to speak long time ago when I left the homeland...

UCE: Yes.

SUB: --it was, like you say, they call it, I do not know how to speak, they call it stammering?

UCE: Yes.

SUB: I stop and then. Like you say, the English has an impact.

UCE: The English has an impact.

SUB: I have been doing it for two years.

UCE: When you are here for a while, it has an impact. But, I mean--

SUB: Because I do not mingle with Arabs. I do not mingle with anyone. It is just a matter of using my Arabic. I go home and they are like, "Come over. Come with us and stuff." I do not have friends, relationships and stuff. There is no mingling. I do have but I do not mingle with them.

UCE: I also felt that you were a little bit nervous and that is why [UI].

[Pause]

SUB: I found something good, something which the Shaykh had said, my beloved one. The one which says, er... [UI], the meaning is, "I will make you kneel down on the knees, and will let you taste what Hamza Ibn-'Abd-al-Muttalib tasted." When the Shaykh hears it, he will be very happy.

UCE: He will get it with Allah's permission. [UI] The road is not bad, I mean.

SUB: No, it is not bad. *Straight* directly.

[Pause] [GPS gives directions]

UCE: The person who chose this *truck* is smart. The one who selected this *truck* [UI] in Texas.

SUB: Yes, of course.

UCE: All of these are trucks. There is not going to be a problem. No one will notice it. There is a million *truck* like that one.

SUB: Right, *cowboys, yeah*.

UCE: Exactly. [UI]

SUB: [UI]  
[GPS gives directions]

UCE: [UI]  
[GPS gives direction] [Pause]

SUB: After you drop me off--

UCE: I will go straight, right?

SUB: *Yeah.*

UCE: *Go straight.*

SUB: You will go, you will drop me off-- [GPS gives directions] But, er... when you are returning, you will come out from here.

UCE: Allah willing, I er-er-I mean, I will leave you, I don't know--don't worry about me at all-- I don't want you to worry. Allah willing, now it is 5:45 [UI]. What do you think? Should I stop by, Allah willing, should I call you after an hour? Do you think an hour will be good. [UI] Fine, Allah willing.

SUB: Over there, by the *stop sign*. On the right, at the *stop sign*.

UCE: Allah willing. Do I enter from here?

SUB: Ah, yes, you enter. You see the--

UCE: I will not enter, no, I will not enter.

SUB: No. I will not let you enter. You do not know--

UCE: I am sorry but--

SUB: Yes, of course. [Pause]

UCE: [UI] Allah willing. [UI] [Noise - beeping] Rest a little bit.

SUB: Ok, drop me off anywhere here.

UCE: Where?

SUB: Over here. I will go [UI]

UCE: Let me go from here. Peace be upon you.

SUB: That's it.

UCE: Do you need anything?

SUB: I will see you.

UCE: May Allah bless you, peace be upon you. [Noise - beeping]

[SUB exits car at 5:40 p.m.]

[UCE makes telephone call to SUB at 6:49 p.m.]

UCE: Peace be upon you.

SUB: [UI]

UCE: What is the news?

SUB: [UI]

UCE: Ready? Okay, Allah willing I'll be, er, I'll be over there after... I am at... I went, er, filled gas and I'll be over there in... allow me five minutes but, the same system, I will not go in, huh?

SUB: [UI]

UCE: Okay, my dear. Peace be upon you, peace be upon you.

[Call ends.]

[SUB enters car at 5:55 p.m.]

SUB: Peace be upon you.

UCE: Peace be upon you, Allah's mercy and His blessings. Did you calm down a bit?

SUB: *Yeah*, Thank Allah.

UCE: Thank Allah, thank Allah. Thank our Lord.

SUB: I found out what was the problem.

UCE: What is the problem? [noise - beeps] Did you bring the... did you bring the *cords*?

SUB: *Yeah. Yeah, I brought them.*

UCE: You brought it. Thank Allah so that-

SUB: It became [UI]. I wrote, I write in Arabic on it?

UCE: Yes.

SUB: *Windows* is English.

UCE: Aah!

SUB: That is why it did not do save.

UCE: But, thank Allah.

SUB: I now wrote another new thing.

UCE: Never mind, thank Allah. And that is why I was always telling you when you asked, I want it to be from you heart, this one, it is from you to him [OV]--

SUB: [UI]

UCE: --I do not want to, this is something, I mean, something *pure*, I mean--

SUB: Yes.

UCE: --Exactly. You want to... I mean, for sure he wants to find out from you why are you--

SUB: [UI]

UCE: --you--you, I mean, why are you sending him the message. Are you paying attention? Who are you, not your name and stuff, but who are you or what are going to do, or what is going to happen. What makes you different from all the people that you were [UI]. So, you... this is better. The road is, Allah willing, we will arrive soon, Allah permitting.

SUB: Did you eat something?

UCE: I ate-- *a piece of chicken*. Are you hungry or not?

SUB: No, I am not. Thank Allah.

UCE: Just tell me.

SUB: It is not a problem. I am asking for your sake.

UCE: No, I, see, I told you, I am here, I, my mission, I, is like, I mean, my mission is like what they call the soldier. I am here for you. Whatever you want from me, I am at your command. When I arrive, Allah willing, I want to, when I arrive, Allah willing, I want to, I mean, I want to be pleased and happy and people are pleased and happy.

SUB: [UI]

UCE: I go left, correct?

SUB: Yes.

UCE: Allah willing. I found a police car passing me two or three times.

SUB: In Italy?

UCE: Ah, yes. It was a car over here like--it has on it, er.

SUB: See, Italy police, they love me a lot.

UCE: Thank Allah. That is good.

SUB: I mean, it is like you say, er, it a store friendship.

UCE: Thank Allah.

SUB: The police is almost tribal. Like you say, they are from the same region over here, its police is from within it.

UCE: Of course.

SUB: So--

UCE: I put some gas. Thank Allah, smoke a cigarette and I called you. [Pause] I just want you to be calm. I do not want you to be... shall I enter... Am I going *north* or *south*?

SUB: Yes, you will go to the *north*.

UCE: I am going to the *north*? Fine, my dear. Er, you calm down in Allah and say in the name of Allah, the Gracious, the Merciful and do not--do not, I mean, focus, I mean, I want to tell you, it is a beautiful thing and it is a wonderful thing. So, do not, do not, do not worry of I will say that, I might say a word here or there, that I

will not be able to--No, my dear, the, your work is more important, are you paying attention? I mean, yes, the message is good. But, your work is the one which...

SUB: [UI]

UCE: Is it working now?

SUB: Yes, it is working, thank Allah.

UCE: Thank Allah.

SUB: [UI]

UCE: Ok, tell me what. I will not tell you to do what. Just tell me.

SUB: Here I am going to read.

UCE: In the name of Allah, the Gracious, the Merciful. [Pause] We will drive this way about 20 miles, right?

SUB: Yes.

UCE: [UI] Fine. Tell me Pasha. Do you want to say [UI].

SUB: No.

UCE: Fine.

SUB: [UI] [Pause] Peace, Allah's mercy and blessings be upon you. I take refuge in Allah from the cursed devil. "Say, if your fathers and sons and your brethren and your wives and your kinsfolk and the wealth you have acquired and the trade whose dullness you fear and the dwellings which you love are dearer to you than Allah and His Messenger and striving in His cause, then wait until Allah brings about His judgment; and Allah guides not the disobedient people." To proceed, from the midst of the tyrant, the American apostate, we are here, the soldiers of the blessed al-Qa'ida Organization, I declare my belonging to you, my master the Commander, O honorable Shaykh, I swear by Allah Almighty-- I swear by Allah Almighty to defend our faith, our Messenger, may Allah's blessings and peace be upon Him, our unity and our security and our religion and our women and our children, and we will not forget the forcefully seized land. O Commander, this is my oath to you and it is an honor for me to be granted this opportunity to send to send to your honor this quick message, which is a glad tidings and joy and happy celebration of our victory over the international Zionist and American union. And I give you good news, my beloved, of "Gardens with rivers flowing beneath; therein are they to dwell (for ever)." Allah has facilitated it for me to join your organization from inside the enemy's midst, and it is not a coincidence; but Allah

is the facilitator of affairs, "He knoweth the unseen as well as that which is open..." He is Lord of the Great Throne. Therefore I tell you, you people of steadfastness, under your leadership, O our honorable Commander, Usama Bin-Laden. Be patient for the generations are coming and I am, Allah willing, of these promised generations under your leadership, O Commander Usama. I hope that you are delighted by what you see now, and the greatest joy will be after the success of the upcoming operation. Let the smile be on your faces, my brothers, my brothers now along with my beloved and my Shaykh, Commander Usama, may Allah protect him and prolong his life. I take refuge in Allah from the cursed devil. "Fighting is prescribed for you, and ye dislike it. But it is possible that ye dislike a thing which is good for you, and that ye love a thing which is bad for you. But Allah knoweth, and ye know not." My sole dream was to join--was to join your brave organization, and this has been achieved. Oh, how delighted I am for what I gained in my earthly life, thanks be to Allah, and thank Allah, and Allah is the Greatest, Allah is the Greatest, so let the word of Allah be the most exalted. So I promise you, O my Shaykh and my Commander when I vowed, and I will make this vow this, here in our hearts to the whole world. I repeat the vow, I the vow and say: "By Allah, we will support--we will support you even if crawling on the knees, so we get a taste of what Hamza Ibn 'Abd al-Muttalib has tasted." So, pray for us, O my beloved the Commander and Shaykh, for success and prosperity, from here, from the enemy's midst, may Allah bless those good deeds that you do for the sake of Allah Almighty's face, and the Gardens of Paradise will be yours. We are all on the same path; I am with you and you are with us, on the path to Paradise. And I thank you from my heart, and you are more beloved to me than my father and mother, second to my Lord and Messenger, may blessings and peace be upon Him. I will not accept humiliation as it was accepted by the dogs in our nations; they sold our land on account of our religion. I seek Allah's forgiveness because of them. But there is still a truthful nation and it has gone out; it is your nation; behind you, O Commander, it fears not death. We are the people of Muhammad, you are our Commander. I now declare to you my loyalty and my blood and--and I declare to you our blood, our loyalty, yes, our loyalty, our blood and sons... our revolutionary sons, and our swords to a near appointment in Gardens of Eden beneath which rivers flow--flow. The Messenger of Allah, may Allah's blessings and peace be upon Him, was truthful when he said, "Nations are about to fall upon you like the beasts which fall on their bowl." And he said, "My nation will be faced with years of deception where one--where one who utters the truth will be labeled as a liar, and one who tells lies will be called an honest person, and the traitor will be trusted and the truthful will be held traitor-- traitor, the traitor will be trusted and held traitor." O Commander, hold up your head, smile, rejoice about what you ask, because victory is coming and it is near. The day of the blessed strikes on September 11 was a celebration. So, let us make another history that history mentions now. Now, the moment has come. We relied on Allah always and forever. I do not want to talk for long for there is much that I want to say it; talk is nothing except talk but actions are actions. Let this Ramadan be a blessed Ramadan for all of you, my brothers. I cannot wait to be with you in this war on the land--on the same land and it is close, Allah

willing. My blood is with you after these blessed operations. Be waiting for me. Your beloved and brother Abu al-Ayyubi from land of the Levant, the land of Jordan.

We pray to Allah to have mercy on our deceased and relatives everywhere, and may He help us in liberating Palestine, Iraq, and in breaking the American backbone in their own homes, and help us against the apostate agents, the tyrant Arab kings, who sold our land, our souls and our blood on account of their souls. May Allah's curse be on all of them. May Allah bless you, my Commander. Until the time I meet you, I send you greetings from the people of The Levant. We apologize; do not hold it against us for our kings are oppressors. And Allah is--is the King, Lord of the Great Throne. And al-Fatihah is upon the nation of the Muslim. [UI]

UCE: It is as Allah has pleased.

UCE: O Lord, O Lord, Allah is the Greatest, Allah is the Greatest. You... did you write all of that now?

SUB: Aha!

UCE: By yourself?

SUB: By myself. [UI]

UCE: You wrote this yourself?

SUB: I wrote it myself.

UCE: I, praise Allah, you are going to make me, there is no god but Allah, there is no god but Allah, there is no god but Allah. A beast! No, by Allah Almighty, and you...I cannot write words like this. A beast! It will get to him and then it will appear on *CNN*.

SUB: [UI]

UCE: Yes, yes, yes.

SUB: [UI] 16 years!

UCE: I want to tell you again, you know, my brother, I do not want to put you in any place, in anything that you feel that you are not--you are not sure of.

SUB: Thanks be to Allah.

UCE: Soon... the operation will be soon. I am telling you, I mean, may Allah make us victorious over the unjust. But, I do not want you to feel at any time that I am pressuring you or that you [OV]--

SUB: No, you are not pressuring.

UCE: --because the most important thing, Allah willing--

SUB: There is no pressure. On the contrary, by Allah, I mean, like you say, who gets the right opportunity? People all over the world are searching, like you say, for the true organization to enroll in.

UCE: And, for your knowledge, Dallas is better than New York, by Almighty Allah, it is better than New York and better than any--

SUB: It is easier.

UCE: And it is a place.

SUB: They went up in airplanes. They remained planning for years, I mean, danger, [UI], and planning.

UCE: [Clears throat] Planning now then. I will--I will--I will--when I march, I will march, I mean, normally [UI]. But, when I drop you off, I will return to take the bag and rely on Allah. But, there is something that is very important--

SUB: [UI]

UCE: --er, planning, when this operation is carried out, Allah willing, Allah permitting, we must know exactly the appointed time by the minute, by the second, when I will be parked in the car waiting for you. It will be this car.

SUB: Allah willing.

UCE: This car. This one...I mean, they selected this one for this operation. So--

SUB: Allah willing.

UCE: --the place which--which I want to tell you about, the door from which you will enter...and I, Allah willing, will be [UI], I want you to find out...I mean, can you go two or three times during one or two weeks? Is it possible [UI] in order to know exactly how you are going to exit. What minute, what time exactly so that I must go and tell them, "At one o'clock, we need, for instance--"

SUB: Yes.

UCE: "--we need, for instance, fifteen minutes in order to get to the *highway*, for instance." It is true that--that--that when I-, when I brought you, we went out in order to return to the hotel, it took us sometime, we will need specific time. And, for them-- [OV]

SUB: [OV] [UI]

UCE: --this is going to be their mission; how to do the...or how they will give us...the goods that would work and which will be good enough for this.

SUB: [UI] So, like you say, we will be, after this operation, we must disappear, like you say, we should not remain driving around, outside or here or there; for your information there will be inspection *points*. There must be [UI]

UCE: There is nothing... inspection where?

SUB: I mean, [UI].

UCE: Inspection in the street or where?

SUB: In the streets and--

UCE: You mean, when it happens?

SUB: [OV] [UI]

UCE: Yes.

SUB: When it happens, you know.

UCE: Meaning they will shut down the city, meaning.

SUB: Yeah, there will be [UI], do you know how, all the police will be moving about, on all the *freeways*, and surveillance, and things like that, I mean. And there will be many cars. So, it is better that we do it in the *busy*, because there will be times, if we do it in the *busy time*, in the *traffic*... I do not know, it needs thinking which-which time is better and which day is better.

UCE: What day do you think is better? It seems to be always crowded. I mean, it seems that there is--

SUB: Yes, of course.

UCE: --there is, I mean, er--

SUB: Of course, it is, in the heavy traffic is better.

UCE: --its location, yes, but...

SUB: Allah willing, I will try to get information about the *bank*, and when I get the, er... the best thing is at the beginning of the month, the strike will be. You know why? Because they bring money, I expect at the beginning of the month when people [OV][UI]--

UCE: See, we do, er, I say the *bank* with this, er, I mean, the *bank* [UI].

SUB: [OV] [UI]

UCE: I am telling you, it does the, the money it has goes and comes every day.

SUB: Every day, correct.

UCE: Pay attention. So, er, I mean, I do not think that it is just--

SUB: Yes.

UCE: --er, the beginning of the month. It is not a bank like... it is a monstrous *bank*.

SUB: Yes.

UCE: I do not believe--I mean, you--you see, of course--

SUB: Yes.

UCE: --but I do not think that the day... I will probably go. Er, [pause] but, I mean, in the name of Allah, it is as Allah has pleased, in the name of Allah, it is as Allah has pleased, it is as Allah has pleased. [pause] Allah willing, you will go home at 10 o'clock. You will go to sleep and rest a little bit. And after that, Allah willing, when you get up in the morning. What time do you start work?

SUB: [UI]

UCE: You work from 2 o'clock until what time?

SUB: Until 10 o'clock. [UI]

UCE: [UI] But, it is good, it is not bad. At least you will have people, thank Allah.

SUB: [UI] But, I make good money, huh, I mean, thank Allah.

UCE: Thank Allah.

SUB: Because, like you say, one, sometimes happens to have circumstances, I mean, like you say, sometimes, things happen that one does not--remember--does not remember. I mean, I bought about, when I was in Texas, I bought four cars. The four cars that I bought, I lost in all of them. All of them turn out to be, er... They were not destined for me.

UCE: [UI]

SUB: *Yeah*, praised be Allah, I mean, one car's *engine* is...one car--er, the *transmission*, one car...I leave behind, one car, I mean, each one has a different thing.

UCE: Er, I tell you something, I also want to know something important for me...

SUB: Yes.

UCE: ...what do you think about this *truck*? Is it good? I see that it is...they were the ones who chose it. Therefore, I will not be able to--er, change, er, I see that it will run fine.

SUB: No, perfect, thank Allah. The *truck* is good, I mean, like you said, *Texas is cowboy--*

UCE: Everything, everything is *trucks*.

SUB: All of it is *trucks*, you see?

UCE: When I return as well, the question that I will be asked is that, I mean, is, do you want... don't you want to go anywhere? You want to remain over here for a while.

SUB: I want to stay for a while. The goal is that, in the future, following the operation and everything--

UCE: Yes.

SUB: --for example, I will have the papers and I want to go see my family before I do anything else, for your information, if I leave from here to Mexico, I will leave from Dallas. Let us say I left for Pakistan from the location. Now I will not be able to return from Pakistan to Jordan in order to see my family, because it will be, "Where were you?" "I was in America." "How did you--how did you come?" [UI] [GPS giving directions] Even the Jordanian government has... has information, you see?

UCE: Correct.

SUB: Everything.

UCE: The question which will be asked of me, "How long do you want to stay, how long to prepare yourself? How many--how many days, or how many months," Because I... I know you are telling me it depends on the times, and it is possible that it could happen in a matter of one or two weeks, or like you said, it can take two, three or four months. Time does not make a difference with you now. I mean, you stay over for three, four months, it is not a problem for you?

SUB: Not a problem.

UCE: If you decided that you go striking what is in Dallas, er, this means-- [noise] and I am telling you that--

SUB: If you have an idea, an easier idea, tell me about it.

UCE: [OV] I mean, you must...I am telling you, if you are going to stay in Dallas--

SUB: Yes.

UCE: --you tell me what do you think, I mean, according to... You ask me, "What is your opinion? What is your opinion?", and I want you to be, I mean, to be--I am here to just help you. I want you to go to work in the morning, and we do the operation and come back, and you return to work an hour later. You stay and you work very normally. What do you think?

SUB: [OV] [UI] It is that I [UI].

UCE: [OV] This is in order that no one-- I mean, you are--

SUB: [OV] Yes.

UCE: --no one even knows that you are--

SUB: Ok, what do you think--[OV].

UCE: [OV] --left work.

SUB: --about something good?

UCE: Say.

SUB: For instance, we do the operation and I go to work like now.

UCE: It is as if it is your day, I mean.

SUB: As if it is my day, I am coming to work normally.

UCE: You do not want to go, for instance... it is not--er. It is a wonderful idea. Yes. Instead of you going and coming back, you are going to work as if you are-- [OV].

SUB: [OV] Like today, I mean.

UCE: -- *everyday*.

SUB: We will do the operation in the morning and, for instance, I go to work at 2 o'clock.

UCE: Yes.

SUB: I will be at work at 2 o'clock.

UCE: By 1 o'clock.

SUB: By 1 o'clock.

UCE: I came early today, I do not know why.

SUB: Yes.

UCE: By Allah, it is a wonderful idea. It is better than you going and coming back and they ask you, "Where are you going?"

SUB: Yes, of course.

UCE: You went [UI]. That would be good. It is like just a very normal day. "Where were you?" "I was at home."

SUB: Of course, if we have time--er, if you want to come, er, now, how? I do not know how the system will be. Will we have the time the bombing, the time before the bombing, and the time after the bombing.

UCE: On the basis that you come back, you mean?

SUB: On the basis that I return and you are able to...

UCE: I will return you. You must return.

SUB: [UI]

UCE: I-I will not--I will drop you off--

SUB: Uh-huh.

UCE: --you see, and Allah willing, Allah is the One who-- It is possible, it is possible, it is possible, it is possible I will see if I can stay with you a day or two. But, will not, will not, I mean, I will not open the door.

SUB: Fine.

UCE: I mean, it is as if I do not exist at all.

SUB: Rely on Allah.

UCE: Will that cause problems. Will anyone come to you--er?

SUB: I mean, even if someone comes, he will come to me and I am busy at work.

UCE: At least one day, 24 hours.

SUB: Yes.

UCE: Unless the world quiets down a little bit and then I will emerge out.

SUB: Allah willing. Even if someone knows about you, you married from us. You are from my relatives, you know--

UCE: Exactly.

SUB: --no one [UI].

UCE: Exactly.

SUB: There is no problem at all.

UCE: Is it... this is not going to be a problem for you?

SUB: For me, it is not a problem.

UCE: Right.

SUB: You know? I mean, you are one of our elders, as if you are coming to visit me.

UCE: That is good, by the way, this idea; that you are going to work as if you are going any day.

SUB: Yes. And you should stay at home. [UI]

UCE: I mean, we are thinking about it but, at the end, I tell you that your idea is good which is... I you want to stay here, it does not make a difference with you regarding the time.

SUB: The time makes no difference with me. I mean, now or later, it will be the same thing. When I return [UI] so my affairs would be easier in the future? Because, for me to travel or to stay, thank Allah, I would have settled my affairs down [UI] see my family again.

UCE: What you say is right.

SUB: Thank Allah. I would go see my family and then rely on Allah. If I returned, I returned. If I did not return, there no strength or power save in Allah.

UCE: [UI] [pause] An operation, ten operations not just [UI]. Do you know what I am thinking about? I will drop you off as if you are going to work, a normal day, [UI] I will go to the airport and board--board a plane. Everybody will be busy in *downtown* with what is happening. I will board an airplane and leave.

SUB: You see, how for example, I, see, [UI] the operation, they will bring a *list*, reports, names of the people, all those who left the area, like you say, we the Arabs are distinguished by our names [UI].

UCE: Hmm.

SUB: You see? We do not use their technology.

UCE: Then I say I will stay at your place for 24 hours, 48 hours, if possible, I mean, I do not want to--

SUB: No, no.

UCE: I do not want to stay in a hotel because if I stay in a hotel, what will they do? The name.

SUB: Yes. So, that is why I want to talk about it. See what happened in the Indonesian bombings now, if you heard about it--

UCE: Yes. Did you see that one who--

SUB: *Yeah.*

UCE: Who was walking with the bag?

SUB: So, they got him. They got the guy who did the bombing.

UCE: They got the one who bombed?

SUB: They got him. They got him how? They got him from the hotel which was close to, close to the one which he bombed, the hotel which was close to the site of the bombing. And this is in Indonesia. How are the Americans going to do?

UCE: Yes.

SUB: I mean, it should be a clean operation, 100%. They are not to find, not even 1% information.

UCE: Because I will stay at your place. [Pause]

SUB: And I will say that [UI] Dallas. [UI] you, in case someone saw you or something. [UI]

UCE: Not a problem. I do not know, [UI] I mean, [UI] the car [UI]. [Pause] But the road is good now.

SUB: Yes, [UI].

UCE: [UI] [pause] Do you think you can borrow this car from your other friend for a day or something?

SUB: [UI] Allah willing, I will try to get a car, Allah willing, within--

UCE: You will try to buy it or just you will [UI].

SUB: No, Allah willing, I will buy it. [UI] So that nobody, you know, [UI] because it is [UI] new car amidst the *town*.

UCE: Yes.

SUB: I am a stranger. This is the car of the *town*, [UI]. Nobody will say anything to me.

UCE: What type of car does he have?

SUB: Er, he has a *Honda*.

UCE: But, I mean, it is good? Does it run good or--?

SUB: *Yeah*. We will see, Allah willing, I was in a hurry because [UI]. Like you say, I am trying to get papers so that I can buy a clean car [UI]. The *credit card* gives you *freedom* [UI] a good car [UI] Allah willing the papers will be out this week.

UCE: Allah permitting. Allah permitting. [Pause] [UI] And does this friend of yours live close by or--?

SUB: No, in the apartment across from me, my manager.

UCE: Yes.

SUB: He is from Egypt.

UCE: Yes.

SUB: His name is Tariq [UI]. He came here when he was about 11 years. [UI] If [UI] or something [UI] you are married to my maternal cousin, you see? [GPS gives directions]

UCE: [Pause] Allah willing. Take good care of yourself during these two coming weeks. Do not talk to anybody, please. [GPS gives directions]

SUB: This is the normal thing [UI] .

UCE: Allah willing [GPS gives directions] [pause] Look [UI] Allah willing. I will smoke a cigarette--I will smoke a cigarette before the [UI]--

SUB: I smoke *Marlboro Light*.

UCE: *Light?*

SUB: *Yeah, Light* [UI].

UCE: What is that?

SUB: But, it is called *seventy-two* because it is--

UCE: Why is it thinner [laughs]. Is it following a cigarette diet or what?

SUB: It is a cigarette that lost weight.

UCE: [UI] lighter--give me a lighter [UI]. [Pause] This is the first time I try this one.

SUB: First time to try it?

UCE: Yes. Is this a *Marlboro*?

SUB: It is a *Marlboro Light, seventy-two*. [Pause]

UCE: [UI] My car can finish all of that, fine. But you look comfortable, you look--er.

SUB: Yes.

UCE: --self-confident, I feel that you have good--

SUB: No, thank Allah.

UCE: --self-confidence.

SUB: No, thank Allah.

UCE: Thank Allah.

SUB: I mean, like you say, I am not...there are people, like you say, who think a lot about the world, the world, the world. It is not like you say...there are many people who cling to the religion to the point of...very much, very much...there are people who--er, cling very much to the religion and have not done anything for the religion. And there are people who cling very much to the world--

UCE: Correct.

SUB: --like you say, it makes no difference to me.

UCE: See--

SUB: [UI] I mean, that's it, praised be Allah, I mean, it is a divine matter and it is not-- I mean, I have a brother whose thinking was never like mine. It is like inspiration from Almighty Allah, do you know.

UCE: Of course. [Noise] Is that one of your friends or who?

SUB: No, those work with me. All of them know that I am off today.

UCE: Yes.

SUB: Like you say [UI]-- [OV].

UCE: Read the *exit*, which *exit*? which *exit* should I take? I am not, I do not...read this to me from the on the top; what *exit*?

SUB: *Exit 429B--*

UCE: *Okay.*

SUB: *--for Tollway North.*

UCE: Allah willing.

SUB: It is all a mile and a half.

UCE: The cigarette is not bad.

SUB: [UI]

UCE: It is, yes, it is [UI]. [Pause] [GPS gives directions] It is still crowded on the other side of the road.

SUB: Yes.

UCE: We must see the-- the traffic on that day, the *traffic*, what is crowded and what is not and what is not crowded so that-er, adjust the time.

SUB: So that we also adjust [UI].

UCE: Because I want you to be at work.

SUB: The appointments, Allah willing.

UCE: Allah willing. You will be at work at 1:30.

SUB: So we can see what *option* we have also. I mean, until now, like you say, we do not know how the thing is going to be.

UCE: Everything is from our Lord. [GPS gives directions] [pause] Allah willing, I will take you home soon, in half an hour or something. And, did you not tell me...do you want to do anything in English or do you want to wait?

SUB: See, if I am going to do something in English, by voice, because I know some people over here, they will know my accent.

UCE: True.

SUB: Is not that right? Because I know many people who, like you say, recognize my accent when I speak in English, they would recognize my voice. It is possible that--

UCE: But, you know, I mean, you read--you read anything in English. I mean, it is not a problem.

SUB: I read a thing, English and everything. It is possible to happen that I can change my voice.

UCE: Yes. Your thinking is right.

SUB: It is possible when the brothers who are [UI], er, anyone among them can [UI] do, [UI], an audio recording something like they do, even for the Shaykh himself they do, considering that he is the Commander, you know. Also, when we leave this country, will become, we will have--

UCE: Allah willing.

SUB: Good will happen. [UI]

UCE: This is the most important thing; that there is nothing that you leave behind. Allah willing it will all be clean.

SUB: Allah willing, as soon as I bid my family farewell, I mean, will I go to Pakistan?

UCE: No, Allah willing, you will see them a second and third time.

SUB: The father-- the father, I mean, he is not going to object to my path, you know. So, the thing that I want...he will not be able to, er, object to my path. I will tell them over there that I am returning to America that's it. I will not return again to Jordan until [UI] once again. Exiting [UI].

[Pause]

UCE: We are getting close. [Pause] I remember the building was on the left. [UI] [GPS gives directions] [UI]

SUB: [UI]

UCE: It doesn't work. Don't you have any *change*? You do not have *cha*...you do not have *change*--you do not have *change, yeah*. [Noise - chime] [UI] [GPS gives directions]

SUB: In whose name is this car registered? [Noise]

UCE: We will pay the first fine, then. [GPS gives directions] Oh, I must go *right*. There is no god but Allah. But, it is not going to work, huh? That is it, may Allah ease it.

SUB: [UI]

UCE: Yes. [GPS gives directions]. It is 7:30 and the sun is still hitting us as if--

SUB: [UI]

UCE: Yes. But, this Ramadan will be good. It will be in August. Therefore, the weather will be a little bit good. [GPS gives directions].

SUB: Allah willing.

UCE: Thank Allah. [GPS gives directions] [noise - beeps] Pay attention that last time as well, we did not enter right. [GPS gives directions] [Pause] [UI] Do you want me to help you with something?

SUB: No.

UCE: Ah, in the name of Allah, the Most Gracious, the Most Merciful. [Noise - doors closing]

[SUB and UCE exit the vehicle at 7:49 p.m. and walk to the hotel room. There is no audio between the vehicle and the hotel room. SUB and UCE enter the hotel room at 7:50 p.m.]

SUB: Yeah, wrap both.

[Noise]

UCE: Take your time. Be comfortable. [Noise]

SUB: Do you think we can make the background... that... we make the background like that.

UCE: Like-- stand right here.

SUB: For instance... er, *yeah*, we put the cam- so that, for instance, the picture would not--

UCE: No one will know anything.

SUB: That one.

UCE: Er, no. Because this one, you know, there are thousands of it. [Noise] You are better like this because I do not want you to stand, then they will know--

SUB: Alright.

UCE: You are better like this. I think that-- I er- and also this picture-- I will tell you something, bring down the picture.

SUB: For your information, the intelligence, in the future--

UCE: Bring down- do you know how to bring it down?

SUB: Yes. Okay, that's it. Leave it, it seems that it will not come down. Or it will come down.

UCE: Or it will come down, there you go.

SUB: Whether it likes it or not...

UCE: It's nothing. This is even better.

SUB: Yeah.

UCE: Do you want to take it with you home?

[Laughter]

SUB: Keep it.

UCE: Oh! There is no god but Allah. [Noise] Take your time and be calm and--

[Noise]

SUB: Here I am ready.

UCE: I see that you are ready, I mean... In the name of Allah, Most Gracious, Most Merciful. [Pause] I know, you know, if you put this, I have another one, if I put it on the...

SUB: Yes. That will work, *yeah*.

UCE: Hang on. I have another one...

SUB: Hmm.

UCE: Wait.

SUB: Bring it. I would have liked to put the flag of the Islamic State. [Noise]

UCE: No, it is not...  
[Noise]

UCE: You think one of them-- put one in the back and one er-- you think that this being like that-- you imagine that it is... if we put that one on top.

SUB: If we put this?

UCE: If we put this one on top, or one of them. Well, first put it and see.

SUB: Alright [UI].

UCE: Do you think it will reach? Step on the *couch*, do not worry.  
[Noise]

SUB: [UI]

UCE: [UI] [mumbling] [noise] Did it reach?

SUB: Yeah.

UCE: That's it, very good. [UI] [noise] in the Name of Allah, Most Gracious, Most Merciful. [Noise] What do you think?

SUB: [OV] [UI]

UCE: What do you think? [UI]

SUB: Of course.

UCE: Let's look and see. [UI] [noise] Praise Allah, praise Allah... [noise] Do you think this will be enough for you? I think it is enough, er--

SUB: Enough.

UCE: Wrap- wrap it this way...show me. Exactly, [UI].

SUB: [UI] wrap it now?

[SUB and UCE exit the hotel room at 8:14 p.m.] [No recorded conversation between the hotel room and the vehicle] [SUB and UCE get into the vehicle at 8:17 p.m.]

UCE: Ah. In the name of Allah, the Most Gracious, the Most Merciful. [Noise -chime] See how close this one is. I am telling you. I am at your service.

SUB: May Allah keep you.

UCE: It is not. I mean, I am telling you, because now, this is the beginning.

SUB: Allah willing.

SUB: Allah willing, after the success, we will go to other places, why not?

UCE: Allah willing.

SUB: Other operations.

UCE: Allah willing. [Noise - chime]

SUB: Like they say, "An eye for an eye and a tooth for a tooth."

UCE: Exactly. Ah, smoke a cigarette [UI].

SUB: Smoke a cigarette.

UCE: Those small one, those.

SUB: These have no blessing. [Laughter] All the cigarettes have no blessing.

UCE: Long time ago, in Egypt--

SUB: Yes.

UCE: --there used to be cigarettes called *Belmont*.

SUB: Yes.

UCE: It was the same system, small like this. [UI] Are you a little comfortable? Do you feel that you are comfortable?

SUB: No, thank Allah, I am comfortable. I am after, just after the success, Allah willing I will be, I will be, I mean, comfortable like I never was before.

UCE: Wait let me see the-- In the day it is going to happen, you must be ready.

SUB: Allah willing.

UCE: So, start to prepare yourself.

SUB: Meaning that the second time it will be--the second time [OV] that we will meet.

UCE: Not, not, if I tell you, "Yes," I will be--I will be... I will not lie to you and, I mean, you are my brother, I will never...

SUB: May God keep you. No, I understand. But, Allah willing, the brothers will inform me. [GPS gives directions]

UCE: And this--this is what I want to tell you.

SUB: We do not want to talk over the phone, you know, much.

UCE: No. This is, this guy went... went... he hit the signal. And then [UI] I feel when I call you, I do not want to be --

SUB: Uh-huh.

UCE: --short in the talk with you. But, I do not want to talk more than, I mean--

SUB: Yes, I know.

UCE: --fifty seconds or a min- so that nothing, I mean, it is as if--

SUB: [OV] Yes, I understand you.

UCE: You understand me? So, I do not--I do not mean to be--

SUB: Yes, *okay*.

UCE: --to be anything at all. I just want you to know the... but, I do not know if it is going to be the next time, the one after or I do not--I do not--

SUB: Patience, patience is the key to relief.

UCE: [OV] I will tell you.

SUB: That is it. It is not a problem.

UCE: I will tell you. When it happens, I will tell you, Allah willing.

SUB: Allah willing.

UCE: You are, it is over 20 and something hours of driving. But this is, you see, these 20 and something is nothing at all, thank Allah, thank Allah, thank Allah.

SUB: I came from California, coming down was the same thing. [OV] [UI]--

UCE: You told me, yes. [GPS gives directions]

SUB: --approximately 25 hours, alone.

UCE: Yes [UI].

SUB: Without a driver license or *insurance* or anything. Praise Allah--

UCE: It is the best thing. [GPS gives directions]

SUB: I mean, praise be to Allah, everyday I think about the day I left Jordan--

UCE: Yes.

SUB: --I am, I mean, er, I, I mean, like you say, my intention.

UCE: And they closed it. Good. [whistling] I mean, why is it whistling?

SUB: It whistles because we are crossing the line.... For a ticket or something.

UCE: No, I have 40 *cents*. Do you have [UI]?

SUB: [UI] [Laughs]

UCE: For your information, they often took the money--

UCE: --of our children and the children...the money of our families and the money of our children.

SUB: [UI]

UCE: So now we need 40 cents. Excuse me, I will give it on the shoes.

SUB: All this oil they stole from Iraq.

UCE: Yes, and over here they want 40 cents. We will give them 40 cents, Allah permitting. It will be another thing, Allah permitting. [Pause] Do they stop you here... the belt, the citations?

SUB: Yes. Now, it is a new law. But, I mean, they will not care in the *freeway*, if you stop at a signal or something, a policeman in front of you is watching.

UCE: I know and feel that you know that it will be coming soon--

SUB: Allah willing.

UCE: --and know, Allah willing and I know you will be a little flustered, only at the beginning, er, you were feeling the.

SUB: I was at the beginning [OV] [UI] Thank Allah--

UCE: Because [UI]. Thank Allah. [UI]

SUB: Meaning, I am optimistic, optimistic about what is coming.

UCE: Allah willing.

SUB: I mean, after the success, it will not be...I mean, whatever happens to me, let it happen to me, I will not care. You know how?

UCE: No, Allah willing, it will be every good, Allah permitting.

SUB: Yes.

UCE: We just need to determine the time by the hour and by the second, when, for instance, [UI]--

SUB: Allah willing.

UCE:--[UI] at quarter to twelve, [UI] I will come to you by fourteen minutes before eleven, meaning, I want you to be...when I am leaving, you will be [UI] are you

paying attention? Because [UI] I want to take you, take you to work, Allah permitting, precisely so that you go home by 1:00 or 1:15 at the most.

SUB: Allah willing. We will make time like you say, for [OV]--

UCE: I do not--

SUB: --Emergencies. [UI] *busy* on the road [UI].

UCE: You, what is your opinion? Tell me. Do you think the best thing is to finish by...by the noon prayers, correct.

SUB: Correct.

UCE: Like I am telling you, Allah willing, for emergencies or in case something happened or something, [UI] we will be going in the opposite direction, I mean.

SUB: We are going *south*.

UCE: Correct? [UI] Your idea is great.

SUB: We will drive at our own pace, at our own pace, do not run into the police and there will not be, to *pay attention* or something.

UCE: Allah permitting.

SUB: Allah willing, the brothers would be helping us with something, you know, to make room for us during the detonation, before the detonation and after the detonation...

UCE: Of course.

SUB: ...on the basis that we be there and see the building while it is coming down.

UCE: Are you not... for instance, if you do, if--if--if, the method you told me about is the method... it is the meth--

SUB: If there is... yeah, if we have the technology, for instance, as I imagine, for example, remote detonation or by the telephone, or detonation by timing, to set it on a specific timing, for example, 15 minutes after I exit the building, it would have exploded.

UCE: It must be at least 15 minutes.

SUB: *Yeah*.

UCE: In order to give us time.

SUB: In order to give us time.

UCE: In order for us to go out to--

SUB: [OV] If I exited and someone stopped me and questioned me, I also will not--not explain to him. I will not.... I mean, I will be smart as well. I will not be stopping with someone or do [UI]. That's it, I will keep on going out, "Peace be upon you."

UCE: Do you have a suit?

SUB: Yes. I will get a suit, Allah willing.

UCE: Allah willing.

SUB: I will get a suit special for the--

UCE: Wear a suit and a tie, *yeah*.

SUB: I will fix myself, I will make myself look Mexican, I speak a little bit of *Espanol* when I enter inside, and rely on Allah.

UCE: You look Mexican. You do not need to make yourself look Mexican--

SUB: [Laughs]

UCE: --you are Mexican. Did you take the *computer* with you?

SUB: Yes, [UI] everything [UI].

UCE: Thank Allah. [Pause] You were comfortable when you were at home alone?

SUB: Yes, praise Allah! [Laughs]

UCE: Correct. I mean, I know, I understand, I know that- and, like I told you, I mean, I--

SUB: One gets used to an atmosphere.

UCE: I was comfortable but you were...I mean, a little bit flustered. Sir, this tape will go to the Commander. He will watch it, he will listen to it, he will hear your voice.

SUB: The brothers who are with him will watch it as well.

UCE: Yeah.

SUB: Maybe someone from Jordan will be there, too. And do not forget that in the future I might go... might get martyred one of these days, and this filming is--

UCE: [OV] Allah willing, Allah willing.

SUB: --Er... I executed the operation.

UCE: That would be the greatest thing. But, I mean, I see that you have a long time for us...for you to possibly do things--

SUB: Allah willing.

UCE: --wonderful things.

SUB: Allah willing.

UCE: We are proud of you.

SUB: May Allah keep you.

UCE: I mean, you are sure of your capabilities? Are you sure of the suitable time, Allah willing? [UI]

SUB: [UI] *yeah*, and between me and myself, and I will plan for it, I will think about it, what is suitable, and what is... and I will present the idea to them and you tell me if it is suitable. And like you said, "Consultation is the best thing."

UCE: And I tell you something else, this operation, I see that it is an operation-- [GPS gives directions] that is not difficult--

SUB: Very easy.

UCE: --on the contrary, it is easy. You truly found a location... many people and many... but they will not know who, or who is coming, or who is going where.

SUB: [UI]

UCE: Do you see it from here? [OV] Is not that it? Correct, yes.

SUB: This arrow?

UCE: Yes.

SUB: The one like an arrow. Glass [GPS gives directions] This will--will bring down the glass *everywhere* in *downtown*.

UCE: Allah willing. Who knows, may Allah facilitate it for us and we bring down the--

SUB: Allah willing.

UCE: It would be a scene, er...

SUB: A very horrific scene on the news, the entire world will watch it, from Palestine to China.

UCE: I mean, see what happened even in Indo- Indonesia?

SUB: Yes, of course.

UCE: --how many people, er, how many people, er, [OV] died? [GPS gives directions]

SUB: Yes, those who did the detonation in the hotels.

UCE: It was not... It was a small number, I mean. This one will be--

SUB: Not counting the material losses, I mean, for the *bank*, you know? [GPS gives directions]. The *bank* might declare its bankruptcy.

UCE: It will be losses all over.

SUB: The *bank* is at an international level, at America's level. Like you say, it is a strong *bank*, not a weak *bank*. [UI] [GPS gives directions] It is one of the best... one of the most beautiful branches that it owns.

UCE: Exactly.

SUB: One of the main centers. See how, it is a geometric construction. They spent money on it. [GPS gives directions]

UCE: But, I mean... You also know, I do not want to- that there is.... I mean, you know that it is not just the building, and just it? I mean, there are going to be people with it.

SUB: There will be people that will go with it, of course. [GPS gives directions] So, from that aspect, I mean, I say, it is not--not their fault. Because, like you say, I mean, may our Lord forgive us, we have nothing in our hands other than this.

UCE: [UI]

SUB: I mean, if there is something... somebody innocent or something. Among them-- among them are the innocent and not innocent, but always, I mean, [GPS gives directions] like they say, the sacrifice. They are all infidels, they do- they all do

not like Muslims. I mean, it became a war, in front of your eyes, I mean, in front of your eyes, against a child, against a mother, against a daughter, against a son [GPS gives directions], so let it be a war.

UCE: What you say is correct. What you say--

SUB: [GPS gives directions] We, the Arabs, when we left the Arab Peninsula, how many people were riding horses? They conquered the world. They spread Islam, praised be to Allah, I mean. [GPS gives directions]

UCE: Thank Allah. I just want you to know because there will not be any...like I say, you are my brother...

SUB: May Allah keep you.

UCE: ...I mean. I really want you to know everything that is going to happen and the, er, and the results will be, I mean--

SUB: [UI] it is not a problem, rely on Allah. Now Allah is with us, I mean, do you think it is just like this? [UI]

UCE: Thank Allah. Within the coming weeks, be normal as you are. Do not do anything different.

SUB: Not at all.

UCE: See... this whole operation will take...will take less than, er, five minutes.

SUB: Allah willing.

UCE: Allah willing. You know where you are going. You will not be searching, you know what is the goal. The only thing is that you are waiting for someone to come out of the bathroom.

SUB: Of course.

UCE: That is it. But when you enter, I mean, you are in the bathroom alone, there will be nobody else?

SUB: There is nobody else. [Pause] I will put it in the, er, in the foundations, like you say, because the bathroom is located in the foundations of the building.

UCE: And when you--when you pushed that thing like that--

SUB: Yes.

UCE: --what appeared? What--

SUB: What appeared? The building from inside. The building from the inside. Stone.

UCE: Meaning you looked and saw?

SUB: I looked and saw. I mean, I will plant the bomb from inside. If someone behind me entered the bathroom, no one--no one will know, you know? This is what I was thinking of, I put it and boom, I rely on Allah. No one will, er, no one will--will search there, you know?

UCE: And why I say 15 minutes is enough? Because we will be, thank Allah [UI] safe.

SUB: Allah willing. No, Allah willing 15 minutes are... Allah willing. They will still be running to the building. [Laughs]

UCE: Exactly. Your talk is.... Exactly.

SUB: All the *units* will be *north* and we will be *south*.

UCE: But, is it possible that I stay with you a day or two?

SUB: [UI] there is no problem.

UCE: There is no...

[Pause]

SUB: [UI]

UCE: [UI] Allah willing, Allah willing. [GPS gives directions] [Pause] If you are able to go one time--

SUB: Uh-huh.

UCE: --but if you could not, it is not a problem, it is not a problem, I see that you know where it is exactly, where the location is and everything is arranged, and [UI] [GPS gives directions]. I do not even know if it needed that you go to it... I see that you are...

SUB: But I expect, Allah willing, [UI] [GPS gives directions], we rely on Allah another time and we head south [UI] without bringing eye [UI] afraid that the place is under surveillance or something. Like you say, all the streets in *downtown* are under surveillance.

UCE: It has the [UI].

SUB: Of course, sure... that is why I was asking, for instance, that it is possible that they get the car's plate number if it was parked there, of course not in the same day but the following day or something [UI].

UCE: But I am going to ask you a question, you told me that it has a garage underneath?

SUB: *Yeah.*

UCE: If...

SUB: [UI]

UCE: [OV] What is your opinion if... no... if I go and park in the garage underneath...

SUB: *Yeah.*

UCE: ... and I wait for you?

SUB: And you wait for me, *yeah.*

UCE: And when, when you finish, you come and we leave together out of the garage.

SUB: That is it, on the basis that my car does not remain outside in the--

SUB: I understand.

UCE: --in the street.

SUB: We enter the garage, I enter the garage on the basis that I *just--just*, just left my car and going to the bank--

UCE: Exactly--exactly.

SUB: --and I enter the bathroom in the *transit--*

UCE: Or...

SUB: --and I will put the...

UCE: ... or I drop you off, and I enter garage and you come to me to the garage...you-- you [UI] Are you able to come to me at the garage? Or you are unable?

SUB: I come to you at the garage?

UCE: To the garage from the... from the building. I mean you told me that there is a garage underneath, correct?

SUB: I, *yeah*. You get out of the building from underneath to the garage...

UCE: Straight?

SUB: Straight. I mean will be... We will enter the garage together...

UCE: Yes.

SUB: [UI] and I will get out of the garage, go to the *restroom*, I plant it and I return and we head--

[Pause]

SUB: We will see after that... Maybe our Lord will facilitate it and we do another operation.

UCE: Allah willing, but patience.

SUB: In another location.

UCE: Patience.

SUB: Patience, of course.

UCE: But I assure you that it will not be in Dallas again, I mean [UI], but this is a powerful operation, I mean [UI]

SUB: Allah willing.

UCE: [UI] The whole building is glass, and the whole building is...

SUB: It is a bank.

UCE: The other banks will be frightened.

SUB: Very frightened...

UCE: They will close down.

SUB: Allah willing. Allah willing they will close the schools and even stop everything.

[Pause]

UCE: [UI]

SUB: [UI]

SUB: Do you expect there are brothers like us? I mean to do, for instance, operations, after a while, like us?

UCE: A question... this question is deep, the answer to it--

SUB: [UI] the Shaykh [UI].

UCE: Wait, wait and see.

SUB: That is it.

UCE: What, Allah willing, Allah permitting, our Lord, be He Exalted...

SUB: They will be blessed strikes, Allah willing, [UI].

UCE: [UI] Allah permitting.

[Pause]

UCE: I am sorry I troubled you a little bit because [UI]--

SUB: No, I expect... I am like *off*. Yeah, may Allah keep you.

UCE: --but I do not want to drive fast [UI] I get a *ticket* and then they know who I am.

SUB: There is no--there is no reason to rush or [UI].

UCE: [UI] What are you going to do tonight, Allah willing?

SUB: Er, Allah willing, I will make... make something to eat and when I get back home, eat a little bit of fish. I might go to the store too.

UCE: Normally, just like any other day [OV]--

SUB: Just like [UI].

UCE:--[UI]

SUB: Even after, even on the night of the operation, I will try that, for example, er, leave you at the house so no one comes, and I leave on the basis that I am not home.

UCE: If you want to go with your friends, go ahead and if you want to....

SUB: So I do not bring eyes on me, "Why did not Hosam go out?"

UCE: Exactly, "Where is Hosam today?"

SUB: "Where is Hosam?"

UCE: [UI]

SUB: "Where is this Arab? He is somewhere."

UCE: With them, [OV] "He is with his friends."

SUB: [UI] I will be with my friends. I will be happy about the operation in my heart and they will not know anything.

UCE: The best jihad. [UI] and everybody is saying, "What is happening?" And he is the only one who knows what is happening.

SUB: Allah willing.

UCE: [UI]

[Pause]

SUB: But we ask for the mercy of our Lord, may the Lord give us success, Allah willing [UI] [pause]. On the night of the operation, Allah willing, I will cook an Arabic meal for you. [Laughs]

UCE: [Laughs] Akh, [laughs].

SUB: We will eat Arabic... home made. [Laughs]

UCE: Allah willing, in the midst of the operation we will slaughter a lamb.

SUB: [Laughs] Allah willing.

UCE: A whole lamb, Allah permitting, a calf. Is the owner of the store you work at an Arab or not?

SUB: No, American. But like you say, the store owner is American and the one bigger than him, is a Syrian Arab. They call him Ali Sharaf. I do not know if you heard of him, the richest one in *Texas*, nearly, Syrian, [OV] a Syrian national.

UCE: The richest one—the richest one amongst them?

SUB: The richest one in *Texas*. Do you know what he has? Did you see these gas stations? All of this is for him. The Exxon, Valero, any gas station you see now while we are driving.

UCE: For the Syrian.

SUB: For the Syrian. The Vectro company which sends... it is in charge of the *gas stations* in *Texas*, particularly in the *Dallas area*, he purchased the *gas station* company. *It's called Vectro*. Capital... his capitals, praise be to Allah, are millions. But for what? For nothing. They are selling pork meat. They will be bringing beer soon.

UCE: Muslim?

SUB: Muslim.

UCE: A Shiite or a Sunni?

SUB: I see him at the mosque on Friday. What is his age? I mean, it is not that he is young, in the fifties. I mean, when he first came over here, he was working as a *cashier* [UI] Now, he is buil- doing a house, now, like a palace. He is doing a very big house here in *Texas*. It is like he bought--he bought like half a mountain so he can build on it. Look how people, er. [UI]

UCE: At the end... as well... exactly. At the end...

SUB: I was--

UCE: It does not make a difference.

SUB: It is only these 60 years, on the fingers, one, two, three, four; sixty.

UCE: Exactly. [UI] [clears throat] Did anyone speak to you at all about me or asked you why you are riding this car... truck or such?

SUB: No one saw me till now.

UCE: [UI]

SUB: But it is, I mean, even if someone saw us, I mean, someone saw us, "*it is not your business*." Like this.

UCE: Yeah, I know, but, I mean, I am talking about [UI], I know that it is [OV][UI] *business* [UI]--

SUB: Like you say, my nature with my friends and all the people I know, the, er, like you say, er, I maintain myself by myself; I do not ask about the whole world--

UCE: Correct.

SUB: You know? So... but like you say, all of them--all of them respect me, I mean, especially "that's it, it is none of your business, I do not owe you anything." [UI]

if anyone likes to say big words to me or something, like you say, I do not need anyone until now. I am [UI] and I am good with the area, with the people, and such; all the people like me. They do not even think that I am an Arab. [UI] Of course we are all like this, but they, sons of--sons of filth.

UCE: I will ask you a question.

SUB: How many people I know that I also helped and they betrayed me... Americans, you know.

UCE: Did these people betray you?

SUB: They betrayed me.

UCE: Did they betray you with the cars?

SUB: Either with the cars, or with the money, or... There is one--there is one that I brought over, an American... I felt pity for him--

UCE: Yes.

SUB: --I had him live with me for about three months. He was working with me. He had been fired from his job; he used to steal, er. He does not have a mother or a father or anything. I brought over to live with me for about three months. I did not come out good on this after the three months that I had him reside.

UCE: Nothing at all?

SUB: Nothing, not even, not, I mean, not even a good thing, you know? [OV] [UI]

UCE: [UI]

SUB: Not even a *thank you*. I am not asking anything of him, I am helping him for the sake of Allah. What did I do? When I made him leave, I made him leave because I had him for three months; I received my salary, it was 400 dollars, my salary. Three hundred and fifty dollars is the *deposit* for his *rent*.

UCE: Yes.

SUB: The one for his company; I paid it for him for the sake of Allah, be He exalted. I do not know him and did not know me or anything. Why? So he does not sleep on the street--

UCE: Correct.

SUB: --and at the end, I said, "*You know what?*" "*I am not going to do it any more with any American people.*" Because, to begin with, if you help an American, as if you are helping... if you help a dog, the dog will be more loyal to you than the American.

UCE: Correct. At least the dog has loyalty to the human.

SUB: It has loyalty. I mean, like you say, they do not have a religion... even they themselves say that their religion...they believe in the Cross and such, even loyalty to the Cross that they believe in, they do not have loyalty. The one that they are convinced of.

UCE: Your words are correct.

SUB: You know how? So praise Allah I mean.

UCE: There is no loyalty, and there is nothing at all.

SUB: There is nothing, there is no... there is no honor nor blood nor...They are all sons of adulterers.

UCE: By Allah, it is a beautiful word [UI].

SUB: There is not even [UI]. You ask him, "Who is your father?" He will say, "My mother had three boyfriends."

UCE: He tells you, "I do not know," I mean, yes, I do not know.

SUB: [UI]

UCE: He... it is not his fault, I mean... he...

SUB: It is not his fault, of course. But see how the world is going. I mean, your Lord gave you brain to think, also. [UI] Praise be to God.

UCE: [Yawns]. O my Lord, have mercy upon us [UI].

SUB: [UI] [pause]. I have a beautiful idea too. The--the operation, if it is on the 11th day, it will be beautiful, like *11 September*.

UCE: [UI]

SUB: Can even be *11 August*, or *11*, er, [UI].

UCE: Meaning the 11th, and that is it.

SUB: The 11th and that is it, so that it can be in their history.

UCE: Meaning, the month is not important, the day is important.

SUB: The month is not important; what is important is the day. So that other people come and put it *11 May, 11*, er--

UCE: Correct.

SUB: You know how?

UCE: You mean you do not want to do it on 11 *September*? [UI]

SUB: No, it is another thing, it resembles *11 September*. So they know that Al-Qa-- Al-Qa'ida is still alive, and they did not do anything to it.

UCE: [UI]

SUB: [Pause] We will make the *11th* day an unfortunate day for them.

UCE: But, what can we do? [Clears throat] It is going to be a day of unfortunate-- [OV]--

SUB: [UI]

UCE: --the day is not important, but it will be a powerful day.

SUB: Allah willing.

UCE: They were....

SUB: They behaved tyrannically a lot.

UCE: They behaved tyrannically with us. And our Lord will be on top of them.

SUB: Allah willing.

UCE: Who is the powerful! And who is....

SUB: They will have bitter days, [UI], Allah permitting.

UCE: Allah permitting.

SUB: Began [UI].

UCE: [UI]

[Pause]

UCE: You see how our Lord facilitated it for us?

SUB: Yes, praise Allah.

[Pause]

SUB: By Allah, may Allah aid you during the drive back.

UCE: Do you know what I will do?

SUB: No.

UCE: I will go... I will get in... pray... I know that my prayer will be [UI] But at the same time, our Lord, be He Exalted, knows that there are many people who pray a thousand times a day [UI], but at the end, [UI].

SUB: There are people, like you say, pray because prayer is an obligation and not because they want to pray [UI]. This is wrong. This prayer is for Allah. You yourself should feel that you are praying, and offer, what you call it, a worship to Allah, be He exalted, not because he made it obligatory on you. [UI]

UCE: I know now I have to perform the afternoon and evening and night prayer. And I know altogether. At the same time I see [OV] [UI].

SUB: [UI]

UCE: Exactly. [UI] Allah willing [UI].

SUB: [UI]

UCE: You know the circumstances. [OV] [UI]

SUB: Deeds are according to intentions.

UCE: Exactly. [UI]

SUB: So our Lord is the Knower of the Unseen, he is the Knower of the souls, you know.

UCE: Exactly.

[Pause]

UCE: [UI]

SUB: [UI], approximately [UI] *five minutes* [UI] *exit*. [Pause]

UCE: Tsk, O Lord [UI].

SUB: But I want you, I mean, to think also about the, er... I mean, and do not want you to only hear me and that is it. I want you, for example, if there is--if there is something better... a plan, a better plan, for example, on the operation day, for example, for example, we bring a car, we return a car, how do I take this car, how do I... do you know how? So that everything will go fast, fast, so we be ready.

UCE: Allah willing, and for your information. [UI] One hundred percent. [UI] First, we use this car and quickly disappear, and this car will never [UI] I see that this operation as... I mean, of course, it is all--it is all up to our Lord of course [UI].

SUB: Of course.

UCE: [UI] but I see this financial center, er, and the scene it will take place [OV]--

SUB: Yes.

UCE: --is magnificent.

SUB: Of course.

UCE: And at the same time, Allah permitting, Allah permitting, I see that it is an operation that is approximately guaranteed--

SUB: [UI]

UCE: --which is smooth, does not have *complication*. You just get in and get out and that is it.

SUB: Fine, Allah willing.

UCE: Allah permitting. [Pause] You... this car, when are you going to bring this car [UI] [OV]--

SUB: [UI] and everything.

UCE: We can drive it for three, four days, nothing will happen to it.

SUB: Of course. Toyota, it is Japanese. The Japanese are smart.

UCE: Yes.

SUB: The Americans, what did they do? They did not do anything. All their industry did not-- May Allah help you if you buy it.

UCE: Exactly.

SUB: And if you go to the Koreans, they manufacture things better than the Americans. It lasts. I mean go see the Kia, they manufactured the Kia. And did the Americans manufacture? The Ford. It is merely a look, a big *motor* on a--on a big Ford... I mean empty talk.

UCE: Correct.

SUB: You go to the Germans, you find that they manufactured, I mean Praise Allah... they are smart.

UCE: [OV] [UI]

SUB: But what? America, like you say, er, er, is an international Zionist system. It is the system of the Anti Christ. It is, like you say, the eye of the Anti-Christ and the pyramid are on the American Dollar.

UCE: Correct.

SUB: [UI] our Lord does to their system.

UCE: And I know that we spend the dollar and everything, but our Lord will forgive us at the end.

SUB: There is no, no other way.

UCE: There we are, sir, we are going to Italy.

SUB: We are going to Italy.

UCE: Hiding in Italy. [Laughs]

SUB: [Laughs] We hide in Italy.

UCE: For your information, [UI] *smart*.

SUB: In Italy?

UCE: And this place is far, and there is a *highway* and nobody knows anything about us at all, as if you are a ghost.

[Pause]

SUB: Praise be to Allah, I mean, it is possible that Allah facilitated for us all these matters... For example, for me to have these problems in California so that I come here and get to know you. Like you say, as if our Lord has designed the path.

UCE: This is the beginning.

SUB: Each person has his path designed, he will walk in it without him knowing.

UCE: All in its time.

SUB: All in its time. [UI]

UCE: What is written on the forehead, the eye will see it.

SUB: Correct.

UCE: Allah willing we will be organized.

SUB: Allah willing. [Pause] This is closed.

UCE: Look, next time, we will bring glasses with me--

SUB: That is it.

UCE: --so I can see. This way is...Italy? And, what is this? Ennis? And what is this?

SUB: Ennis.

UCE: What is this? Who is this? Is it another city or what?

SUB: Ennis, *yeah*, it's another city. You would continue going about--it is approximately *twenty minutes*--

UCE: And where is this at?

SUB: --*straight*. All there is, you would go on... you would go on the *north, again*. Er... Waxahachie.

UCE: You mean, you can go Dallas that way?

SUB: *Yeah*, it is possible.

UCE: Which is easier?

SUB: Er... of course, the *freeway*.

UCE:           The *freeway*.

SUB:           You can drop me off here and that's it, you would trust in Allah.

UCE:           No, no. [UI]

SUB:           [UI] the problem is it will start raining, and the clouds look like rain.

UCE:           The clouds?

SUB:           The clouds.

UCE:           If it rains, do you hear it at the...? On top of the...? Do you hear the rain strong at your place?

SUB:           Strong rain?

UCE:           Yeah, I mean do you hear it on the, er, er--? On top of yours? Or you do not hear it?

SUB:           By Allah, I mean no. I, like you say--

UCE:           It comes down?

SUB:           It comes down. I mean, like you say, [UI] I mean, it is designed against storms and things like this, and earthquakes.

UCE:           I am sorry, I will not be able to get out of the car--

SUB:           No, it is alright.

UCE:           --to bid you farewell--

SUB:           May Allah keep you.

UCE:           But I mean I will not even bid you farewell, because I will tell you now--

SUB:           I see you another time.

UCE:           Allah willing, you will see me very soon, with Allah's permission.

SUB:           [UI]

UCE:           And... smile.

SUB:           Allah willing.

UCE: And be happy.

SUB: [UI]

UCE: Thank your Lord, and Allah willing...

SUB: Allah willing [UI].

UCE: [UI] A near victory, with Allah's permission.

SUB: Remember that on that day we will be happy and joyful, and [UI], Allah willing.

UCE: What is the time with you?

SUB: The time is *eight fifty four*.

UCE: *Eight fifty four* [UI], I do not know, [UI].

SUB: Rely on Allah.

UCE: Correct.

SUB: [UI] I wanted to see these [UI]

[Pause]

UCE: [UI] that you went to the store [UI]

SUB: When I did not find--I did not find somebody to give me a ride, praise Allah, I walked here on the street, I said that is it... I will finish it walking to there, and someone comes, someone from those whom I know--

UCE: [OV] [UI] I did not know it was far like this.

SUB: It is facilitated.

UCE: I did not know it was far like this.

SUB: And sometimes, like you say, my friend who used to give me his car, er... he had a fight with his girlfriend. She called the police for him and, like you say, they took him to jail. He was Mexican. He used to sign, like you say... they took him away for life, him and his car.

UCE: [UI]

SUB: *Okay*. Well peace be upon you.

UCE: Peace, and Allah's mercy be upon you, my dear, may Allah keep you.

SUB: Take some smoke.

UCE: No--no, take--take--take it, I have some—I have some with me here.

SUB: I do not smoke, by Allah. Smoke on the way.

UCE: Fine, peace and Allah's mercy be upon you.

SUB: Allah be with you.

UCE: With safety.
