ORDER REGARDING 30(b)(6) DEPOSITIONS

This order supplements the Court's March 4, 2013, Order Regarding Depositions [Dkt. No. 270]. It is anticipated the depositions taken in this Multidistrict Litigation will be used in cases filed in various federal and state courts. The Court enters this Order to resolve differences in the applicable rules and codes in various jurisdictions where the depositions may be subsequently used.

During depositions conducted pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 30(b)(6), the witness may be questioned about topics beyond the scope of the Rule 30(b)(6) notice. If the lawyer presenting the Rule 30(b)(6) witness believes the questioning goes beyond the scope of the notice, an objection to form preserves this objection for later presentation to the applicable court according to its rules as to whether the witness's answers were properly within the Rule 30(b)(6) notice and, therefore, on behalf of the organization who designated the witness.

The Special Master has the power to regulate the conduct during the depositions as set forth in the March 4, 2013, Order.
