SPECIAL ORDER NO 13-10

ORDER TO EXTEND TIME TO SELF-REPORT  
TO A BUREAU OF PRISONS FACILITY

In recognition of the serious health risk posed to staff and to those incarcerated in federal correctional institutions by the introduction and spread of COVID-19 into the confines of these institutions, and weighing this significant risk against the minimal risk of delayed self-reporting by non-violent offenders, the Court has determined, and it is hereby ordered, that defendants who have been ordered to voluntarily surrender to a Bureau of Prisons facility before May 1, 2020, are granted an extension of time to report. The new date will be approximately sixty days from the defendant's current voluntary surrender date.

The Clerk of Court is directed to serve a copy of this Order on each affected defendant, along with a notice of the defendant's new voluntary surrender date. The Clerk is also directed to serve the Bureau of Prisons, Marshals Service, United States Attorney's Office, and Probation and Pretrial Services Office for the Northern District of Texas.
