Regarding our conversation at the account review, I just wanted to provide a quick recap of the issues that Commissioner Price had concerns with and current status of each.

1) Kathy Nealy Consulting Contract

Status: Closed, as of 4/28/03 Mrs. Nealy's contract has been extended for a duration of 6 months. John T. has renegotiated the success fee, list of accounts and pay schedule.

2) Kathy Nealy Success Fee

Status: Open (soon to be closed), as of Friday 5/16/03 Mrs. Nealy had not yet received her success fee payment for Lee County in the amount of \$25K. In speaking with Denver accounting on Friday 5/16, they indicated that a check had been mailed out on Tuesday 5/12/03. I would expect that Kathy would receive the check within the next day or so.

4) OC3 (Dallas MBE) regarding Dallas County work

Status: Closed, as of the beginning of May, NIS has readjusted the delivery component of the Dallas County base contract to more adequately reflect our contractually agreed upon run rate of \$300K annually for OC3.

5) Camillia Kennedy hire

Status: Closed, as of 5/5/03, NIS Technical Consulting, with approval from Denver, has extended and offer letter to Ms. Kennedy, daughter of Texas State Representative Hellen Giddings and close personal friend of Commissioner Price.

6) Qnet (Dallas MBE) regarding Lee County Work

Status: Open. Commissioner Price has a perception that we were to award a percentage of our Lee County contract amount to qualified MBE firms, Dallas based or not. Qnet has come to Commissioner Price indicating that SLB made commitments to use them for services at Lee County in the area of Applications and Telecommunication Support, but have not yet done so. Although we have utilized Qnet for transition efforts and are in compliance on MBE commitment, as a percentage of billings to Lee County to date, we have no long term commitment to MBE for the duration of our 5 year contract.

7) Cyberdyne (Dallas MBE) regarding Lee County Work

Status: Open, same as Qnet
