Rick,

DFW asked me to send the following to the landowners. I just wanted you to have a copy in case you get a call. If this doesn't look like it is moving next week, I'd like to be sure that Commissioner Price is aware of two items. First, some of the data we have for the application is getting a little stale. If we can't get this filed during 2006 (which means Dallas County approval by December 5), we are going to have redo some items, which also involves additional effort and cost. Second, we (DFW) are a little concerned about activity in Fort Worth. Ross Perot Jr made some comment to the Fort Worth Chamber earlier this week that the Southern Dallas project was a threat to Alliance. So far, nobody has directly raised a question about approval of the Southern Dallas FTZ, but DFW staff is sensitive to the possibility, and it, too, could cause a delay. Assuming Commissioner Price remains in favor of the project, and ultimately wants to see this approved in a reasonable amount of time, a November resolution would be very helpful. I'm happy to meet with the two of you if you think that would help.

We did get the Wilmer letter, finally, so we are ready to go.

Thanks for the help.



As each of you know, final approval of submission of an application to the Foreign Trade Zones Board has been scheduled for next Thursday's DFW Airport Board meeting, contingent on each of the local taxing authorities approving the project. Dallas County has not yet approved the project, and has not placed the item on its agenda for next week. Consequently, DFW will have to delay approval of the project until its next meeting, on December 7, provided that Dallas County acts on or before December 5. I do not know the reason for the delay by Dallas County. We do have all of the other approvals necessary to submit the application.

I will keep you informed of any developments.


