The attached map identifies the Hillwood industrial tract as "Crossroads Trade Center", which is in DeSoto. I understand that the proposed FTZ area is in Lancaster and Dallas, I believe.

We just found out about this FTZ zone that DFW Airport is establishing in the UPRR intermodal development vicinity and were directed by DFW Airport staff to contact Commissioner Price about our interest to be included. We were told by staff that they were not interested in delaying this action to allow us the opportunity to be included but that we should discuss that with Commissioner Price. We have visited with the DeSoto City Manager. He, likewise, was unaware of this FTZ extension and said that DeSoto also would like the opportunity to consider the inclusion of our parcel in the zone.

We don't have a map of the proposed FTZ area but have been told that the proposed westerly boundary is I-35E, and our parcel is on I-35E but just on the other side of the highway, essentially abutting the proposed zone boundary.

We genuinely are interested in being included in the FTZ and would like the opportunity to consider such with Dallas County and DeSoto, before the zone gets finalized. We're sorry about any delay in this process that this may cause (we would have engaged earlier had we or DeSoto been notified).
