Commissioner Price is holding up the county approval to allow us in to the deal.

City Council of Desoto unanimously voted to authorize the Mayor of Desoto to sign a letter supporting the inclusion of the Hillwood site in the FTZ expansion.

City of Dallas as member city of DFW Airport, which is the grantee of FTZ 39, must also support the inclusion of the Hillwood site.

Bill Blaydes, city of Dallas councilmen and chair of economic development w/ City of Dallas, has told David Newsom that he is opposed to letting the Hillwood site in the deal largely because of Ross' comments in the newspapers of the UP intermodal and surrounding development being a threat to Alliance. David is meeting with Bill at 1:30 on Friday to persuade Bill otherwise and point out Hillwood's investment in the City of Dallas and the southern sector.

Bill Blaydes also told Commissioner Price that he was against Hillwood being in the deal. Commissioner Price's response was: "Well, I guess there won't be a deal then."
