BE IT REMEMBERED, at a regular meeting of Commissioners Court of Dallas County,Texas, held on the 5th day of February, 2002, on amotion made by John Wiley Price, Commissioner of District No. 3,and seconded by Jim Jackson, Commissioner of District No. 1, the

following Order was adopted:

WHEREAS, on January 22, 2002, the Dallas County Commissioners Court was briefed on the Evaluation Committee's recommendation to continue with the next phase of the RFP process in that all five (5) companies ((1) Science Applications International Corporation; (2) EDS; (3) Xerox Connect, Inc.; (4) ACS; and (5) Schlumberger, Ltd) are all reasonably susceptible of being selected for award in accordance with Dallas County's High Technology Rules and Texas Local Government Code 262.030(e) for RFP No. 2002-011-1007, *Request for Proposals for Information Technology Outsourcing Services for Dallas County*; and

WHEREAS, the recommendation of the Evaluation Committee is advisory only and may be accepted or rejected, in whole or in part, by the Dallas County Commissioners Court; and

WHEREAS, on February 5, 2002, the Commissioners Court received additional information from the Evaluation Committee and consultants to assist in the process of determining which of the five (5) proposing companies should be selected as Finalists in order to proceed to the next phases of the procurement process which includes the Best and Final Offers;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Dallas County Commissioners Court rejects the recommendation of the Evaluation Committee and selects the following four (4) companies as finalists for RFP No. 2002-011-1007 subject to the waiver of any and all fees for due diligence:

Schlumberger Limited
Electronic Data Systems, Inc.
Affiliated Computer Services, Inc.


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


