WHEREAS, the Management Information Systems department briefed Commissioners Court on May 6, 2003 concerning an Oracle 11i Upgrade Assessment; and


WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court desires to obtain an analysis of the costs and benefits of upgrading the County's current Oracle Financials; and


WHEREAS, Schlumberger has submitted a proposal to perform the Oracle 11i Upgrade Assessment for a consultant hourly rate of \$140, for a not to exceed consulting total of \$191,700, plus travel expenses of a not to exceed amount of \$19,600, for a not to exceed total project cost of \$211,300;




