WHEREAS, on July 27, 2004 and based on the proposal evaluation committee's recommendation, the Purchasing Department briefed the Commissioners Court with the recommendation to render AmCad and LanData susceptible firms for award consideration and authorize staff to proceed to Stage 3 of the approved High Technology procedures established for RFP #2004-064-1485 (Recording, Indexing & Imaging System for the County Clerk); and

WHEREAS, after further consideration, the Commissioners directed staff to render AmCad, ACS, Bearing Point and LanData susceptible firms for award consideration and directed staff to proceed to Stage 3 of the RFP process and authorized the evaluation committee members (6) to schedule and conduct site visits to one designated operational site for each of the four identified firms

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Dallas County Commissioners Court renders AmCad, ACS, Bearing Point and LanData susceptible firms for award consideration with respect to RFP #2004-064-1485 and authorizes staff to proceed to Stage 3 of the RFP process and authorizes the evaluation committee members to conduct site visits to one designated operational site for each of the four identified firms and authorizes all county documents to reflect accordingly.
