


WHEREAS, it was further recommended that the Commissioners authorize staff proceed with entering into formal contract negotiations with Unisys Corporation


WHEREAS, this action supports Vision 1, Strategy 1.3 of the Strategic Plan by providing a sound, financially responsible and accountable governance


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the Dallas County Commissioners Court does hereby render Unisys Corporation as the susceptible firm for award consideration for RFQ No. 2007-082-2822 Request for Qualifications for Inmate Phone Service Provider and authorizes staff to enter into formal contract negotiations with the inclusion of the installation and maintenance of inmate visitation phones (not recording). It is further recommended that in the event a contract cannot be negotiated with Unisys Corporation within sixty (60) days staff will end negotiations and render Global Tel\*Link as the vendor susceptible for award and contract negotiations.




