




MISCELLANEOUS ORDER NO. 6

**MISCELLANEOUS ORDER REFERRING
ARRAIGNMENTS TO UNITED STATES MAGISTRATE JUDGE**

Effective January 15, 2015, all persons who have been indicted or charged by information with a crime and whose cases have been assigned to the docket of the undersigned judge are **ORDERED** to be taken before United States Magistrate Judge Nancy M. Koenig for arraignment within the time required by law. Further, upon a finding by Magistrate Judge Koenig thereafter that any such person desires to plead guilty to the charge or charges against him and that he consents to the hearing of his plea by Magistrate Judge Koenig, such person shall be taken before Magistrate Judge Koenig for that purpose. Magistrate Judge Koenig is hereby authorized to receive such plea pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(3) and in accordance with Rule 11, Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure, subject to the control, final approval, and imposition of sentence by the undersigned judge. Upon the receipt of the guilty plea, Magistrate Judge Koenig shall file appropriate findings of fact and a recommendation to the undersigned judge.
