**MISCELLANEOUS ORDER REFERRING  
ARRAIGNMENTS TO UNITED STATES MAGISTRATE JUDGE**

Effective immediately, all persons who have been indicted or charged by information with a crime and whose cases have been assigned to the docket of United States District Judge Terry R. Means are **ORDERED** to be taken before United States Magistrate Judge Charles Bleil for arraignment within the time required by law. Further, upon a finding by Magistrate Judge Bleil thereafter that any such person desires to plead guilty to the charge or charges against him and that he consents to the hearing of his plea by Magistrate Judge Bleil, such person shall be taken before Magistrate Judge Bleil for that purpose, Magistrate Judge Bleil being hereby authorized to receive such plea pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(3) and in accordance with Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure 11.
