ORDER

Miscellaneous Order No. 59

United States Probation Officers appointed by this Court may in the performance of their official duties transport non-governmental personnel in General Services Administration vehicles where, in the judgment of the officer, the circumstances justify doing so. The probation officer shall be responsible to make a record of each instance. The chief probation officer or his designee shall be responsible to review the record and assure compliance. In addition, probation officers may in the performance of their official duties transport in their privately owned vehicles persons under supervision where, in the judgment of the officer, the circumstances justify doing so. The probation officer shall be responsible to make a record of each instance required. The chief probation officer or his designee shall be responsible to review the record.
