COURT OPERATIONS UNDER THE EXIGENT CIRCUMSTANCES  
CREATED BY THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC:  
AMENDMENT TO MANDATORY QUARANTINE PERIOD

Any standing order of this court that restricts courthouse access is hereby amended to comply with current CDC guidelines concerning the recommended quarantine period, reducing the minimum number of days from 14 to 10. Any person who has been in quarantine for a minimum of 10 days is, nevertheless, prohibited from entering a courthouse if the person exhibits symptoms of COVID-19 or has been advised by a health agency or health care professional to quarantine for a longer period.
