Request Exempt Status for CJA Attorneys

Criminal Justice Act (CJA) Attorneys are entitled to view documents and docket sheets in cases to which they are appointed for free. With CM/ECF NextGen, panel attorneys will only have one PACER account which will allow them to toggle back and forth between exempt and non-exempt viewing.

Instructions

To request CJA exempt status, you must already have an **Upgraded PACER Account**.

- If you do not have a PACER account, please follow the <u>Register for a New PACER Account</u> instructions.
- If you have a Legacy PACER Account, please follow the <u>Upgrade Your Current PACER Account</u> instructions. Once your account has been upgraded, please return to these instructions, and complete the steps below to request CJA exempt status.

Request Exempt Status

- 1. Contact the PACER Service Center (PSC) by email pacer@psc.uscourts.gov or by phone at 800-676-6856 and provide:
 - a. your name,
 - b. your PACER account username,
 - c. the account number for your upgraded PACER account, and
 - d. your request to have your CJA exempt status for the Northern District of Texas be added to your upgraded PACER account.
- Follow the instructions for linking your new PACER login with your CM/ECF credentials, AFTER September 6, 2022.
