ORDER REGARDING PENDING MOTIONS

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. On November 7, 2024, the Court stayed briefing on all pending motions—including those filed at (ECF Nos. 213; 215; 226; 228; 230; 232; 233; and 234)—until further order of the Court by electronic order. (ECF No. 241). The Court further ordered that no additional motions addressed to the pleadings, the merits, or the Court’s jurisdiction should be filed without Court leave. (ECF No. 241).

2. The Court now orders that pending motions—including those pending at (ECF Nos. 213; 215; 226; 228; 230; 232; 233; 234; 238; 239; and 240) are DENIED WITHOUT PREJUDICE, subject to further scheduling.¹

3. All parties whose motions are subject to this Order shall confer with Plaintiffs’ Lead Counsel to coordinate presentation of disputes to the court. At this conference, the movant and Plaintiffs’ Lead Counsel shall discuss how to stage motions to secure the just, speedy, and inexpensive administration of this MDL—including, but not limited to, (i) identification of

disputes that can be deferred pending further pretrial activities; (ii) whether issues can be joined or raised in consolidated motions; and (iii) any other matters they deem appropriate.

4. This Order does not alter the requirement that any motions addressed to the pleadings, the merits, or the Court's jurisdiction require leave of Court. (*See* ECF No. 241). If such leave is obtained, the movant must then confer with Plaintiffs' Lead Counsel regarding the motion, including the scheduling of such motion. The Parties may discuss any such corresponding proposed schedule at the next scheduled status conference before the Court.
