**CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER #16**

**ORDER REGARDING PENDING MOTIONS  
FILED AFTER PRELIMINARY APPROVAL**

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:**

On June 20, 2025, the Court granted preliminary approval of a settlement in this matter. (See ECF. No. 298) (hereinafter, “Order”). As part of that approval, the Court ordered that “[a]ll pretrial proceedings in this Action are stayed and suspended until further order of this Court, except such actions as may be necessary to implement the Settlement and this Preliminary Approval Order.” (ECF No. 298, ¶ 21).


Subsequently, there have been multiple motions and related filings addressed to the Court that are not permitted by the Order,<sup>1</sup> and that are covered by the stay currently in place. The Court therefore DENIES WITHOUT PREJUDICE the motions and related filings pending at, (ECF Nos. 309, 318, 319, 320, 322, 323). The Court reminds parties of the stay currently in place and instructs

that no motions or related filings should be made except those “necessary to implement the Settlement and this Preliminary Approval Order.” (ECF No. 298, ¶ 21).
