Scope of Work

Summary:

A. The scope of this project is to provide and install the hardware, infrastructure, cabling, and terminations for computer networking in the Lubbock U.S. District Court office.

Project:

A. The project consists of installing 91 cable pulls throughout the clerk's office, chambers, courtroom, and jury room in various locations.

Workstations:

- a. All data cables will consist of a 4-pair Category 6 Plenum Cable (Blue), <u>General</u> 7131800, or equal.
- b. All data cables will terminate on Category 6 Jack Insert (Blue) at the workstation location. Panduit NK688MBU, or equal.
- c. In the office/hardwall location all Category 6 jack inserts will connect to either a 2-port Panduit NK2BXIW-A, or equal, or 4-port surface Panduit NK4BXWH-AY, or equal, mount box. A 20-foot service loop will be left in the ceiling to allow for relocation if needed.
- d. All office area cabling will be supported using <u>Panduit JP2DW-L20</u>, or equal, ceiling hangers.

IDF Closet:

- a. All data cables will terminate in an IDF closet into an APC rack (<u>AR3150B2</u>), provided by the U.S. District Court.
- **b.** (2) 48-port Modular Patch Panel <u>Panduit NKPP48FMY</u>, or equal, mounted on the rack for the data cable terminations.
 - **a.** (91) RJ45 Category 6 Jack Insert (Blue) <u>Panduit NK688MBU</u>, or equal, for the termination of the data cables.
 - **b.** (1) <u>ICC Ladder Rack Cable Runway Rack</u> to wall kit, or equal.

Labeling – Vendor will label both ends of the cable with computer generated self-laminating labels. Labeling shall be attached per TIA-606 standards. Each wall jack shall be labeled with the corresponding patch panel location. Floor plans shall be marked with the corresponding patch panel/jack number. *NOTE: WRAP-ON LABELS WILL BE INSTALLED ON EACH END OF THE CABLE*.

Support – Cabling shall be suspended in the ceiling above air conditioning ducts, sprinkler piping, and electrical conduit where elevations allow. Cable Supports will be installed through which cables shall be routed. Ceiling grid, electrical conduit, and sprinkler pipes will not be used to secure communications cabling.

Category 6 Testing – Contractor shall perform a Category 6 test for each data cable installed. Tests include Line Map (continuity and polarity), Resistance, Near End Crosstalk (NEXT), Far End Cross Talk (ELFEXT), Power Sum ELFEXT, Attenuation, Length, and Delay Skew at rates up to 1GHz for Category 6. Tests shall be conducted with a Fluke VERSIV cable analyzer. A hard copy of the test results will be issued at completion of the work

Documentation – Upon completion of the project, the contractor will provide an installation report containing:

• A hard copy of all cable test reports.

Period of Performance – A start date has not been decided on, but hours of work will be between 8am and 5pm Monday – Friday. A U.S. District Court employee will be onsite to assist and answer any questions the vendor may have during the installation.
