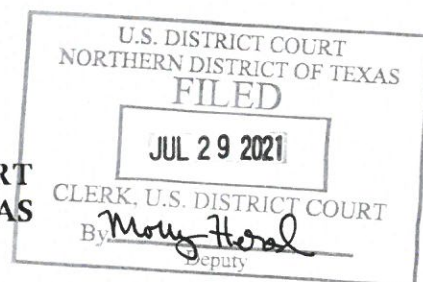

SECOND AMENDED SPECIAL ORDER NO. 13-15

COURT OPERATIONS UNDER THE EXIGENT CIRCUMSTANCES
CREATED BY THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC


This Order amends Special Order No. 13-15 and Amended Special Order No. 13-15, and it applies to the J Marvin Jones Federal Building and Mary Lou Robinson Courthouse in Amarillo, TX.

Effective July 29, 2021, in accordance with recommendations of public health officials and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, all individuals must wear a mask or other face covering while in the building. A person who has not been fully vaccinated is also required to maintain distance from other persons.

Nothing in this Order prevents any tenant agency from establishing and enforcing a different policy within the tenant's own space or any judge from imposing a different policy in a court proceeding

The provisions of this Order will remain in effect until further order of the Court.
