**THIRD AMENDED SPECIAL ORDER 3-301**

Effective November 1, 2017, the Clerk of Court will assign each new criminal case filed in the Abilene Division, together with any post-judgment criminal matter, probation or supervised release revocation, transfer of probation jurisdiction, or transfer for plea and sentence under Fed. R. Crim. P. 20 to Judge Sam R. Cummings and designate the case with suffix letter "C."

The Clerk of Court will also assign each new civil case, together with any post-judgment civil matter to Judge Cummings, with the exception of a new motion filed under 28 U.S.C. § 2255 by a defendant who was previously sentenced by Judge Reed O'Connor or Judge Jorge A. Solis.

The Clerk of Court will assign each new motion filed under 28 U.S.C. § 2255 by a defendant who was previously sentenced by Judge O'Connor or Judge Solis to Judge O'Connor and designate the case with suffix letter "O."

As of the date of this order, the Clerk of Court will reassign all criminal felony cases pending in the Abilene Division to Judge Cummings.
