SPECIAL ORDER NO. 2-30

By order dated April 29, 1994, the Supreme Court has amended Rule 32 of the Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure. The order of the Supreme Court provides, in relevant part, that the amendments "shall take effect on December 1, 1994, and shall govern all proceedings in criminal cases thereafter commenced and, insofar as just and practicable, all proceedings in criminal cases then pending." The court has determined that it is "just and practicable" that amended Rule 32 apply in this district to criminal cases filed on or after December 1, 1994, but not to criminal cases filed prior to that date unless the presiding judge expressly so directs.
