For each multiple-defendant criminal case, the clerk's office is instructed to remove one additional card from the assigned judge's available cards in the deck for every five defendants in the case. The clerk will not assign to a senior judge, other than Senior Judge Jane J. Boyle, any patent case; case in which a TRO or preliminary injunction is requested or has been granted in state court prior to removal; bankruptcy appeal that seeks emergency relief, or complaint seeking class action certification under Fed.R.Civ.P. 23.
